Flag Pole

This will own receipt of your letter of February 10th in further reference to the flag pole. I find that the crown of the main building roof is 45' 6" above the grade of the center of the walk through the grounds. I presume a flag for this Institution would be not less than 8' long and this when draped would fall approximately 9' down the pole. It would, therefore, take a pole projecting above the walk 55' to have the draped flag clear the crown of the roof. Such a pole complete and set 5' into the ground in a concrete foundation is priced by the contractors at \$186.00.

Please let me know if this is the proper interpretation of your wishes in the matter.
