



REJECTED

At a meeting held Thursday afternoon, January 24th, leaders of OCAW Local 4-367 formally rejected the company's third offer that had been put forth the previous day. Again, the union did not offer any counterproposals, nor did it attempt to define what was meant by a "substantial" wage increase. The federal mediator in attendance recessed discussions with both parties agreeing to be subject to call.
