Referring to your telegram of January
15th:

I went out to the Houston Negro Hospital
today, and report the following on the work:

Trees, planting	Complete
Hedges, "	"
Cleaning up and grading	"
Fence	30% complete

Mr. Wooding estimates that the balance of
the fence will be up by Wednesday noon. In accord-
ance with your memorandum of January 4th I conferred
with Judge Moore about the type of fence to be used,
the result of which hog and field fencing is being
put up; Mr. Wooding estimated the additional cost
of such as \$75.00.
