of LAND, situated and described as follows: In Cooke County on the waters of Spring Creek, a tributary of the Clear Fork of the Brazos, about 54 miles South 80 West of Fort Belknap and known as Survey No. 36, by virtue of Duplicate Certificate No. 2191 issued by S. Crosby Commissioner of the General Land Office in lieu of Original Certificate No. 2174 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners of Jasper County.
