



STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION SENATE JOURNAL

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The sixth meeting of the Twentieth Session of the UHSA Senate was called to order on 6 June 1983 in the Atlantic Room of the University Center by Senate Speaker Pat Condon at 7:10 p.m.

Absent of the summer session Senators were : Berry, Caillouet, Napoli, and Swingle.

The minutes from the last meeting were presented, corrected, and passed.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

S. A. secretary Carol has been promoted and Senator Lisa Hollis has been hired for the summer in her place.

There is currently an S.A. brochure in the works. A proto-type will be prepared for review next week.

Senators should abide by rules pertaining to use of the senate refrigerator.

Budget was reviewed by SSFPAC. \$88,000 was asked and \$85,000 received. The committee seemed excited by S.A. proposed programs.

President Parker presented current State legislation in-process for information to the Senate.

Technology School issue still under review.

Proposed appointments of George Dealey and Michael Woodridge.

Proposed new student positions in the Senate for those students who wish to be involved but not elected.

S.A. currently looking into the purchase of bike lockers for students.

OLD BUSINESS

Senate Resolution 29002 A UHSA SENATE RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE NEED TO IMPROVE THE CONDITION OF WHEELER STREET BETWEEN CULLEN AND CALHOUN. No recommendation from Committee at this time due to absence of Committee Chairman.

Correction of wording of bill and presented to the floor.

Bill passes unanimously.

Senate Resolution 29003 A UHSA SNATE RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE NEED FOR A DRINKING FOUNTAIN ON THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE UNIVERSITY CENTER. No Committee at this time due to the absence of the Committee Chairman.

Amended to delete specific location.

Passed with one abstention.

NEW BUSINESS

The appointment of Michael Waldridge to the Activities Funding Board was bypassed for

committee and unanimously appointed.

The appointment of George Dealey to S.A. College of Business Position #2 was bypassed for committee and unanimously appointed. Dealey was then sworn in by President Parker.

COMMENTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Senatro Ranade poised two points for Senate consideration. One being that the left margin on Senate minutes needs to be larger to insertion into Senate binders. This recommendation was taken into consideration by the Senate Secretary. The second point being the problem presented to 12-week Summer Semester registrants who need I.D. validation. Senator Ranade will investigate and make a recommendation at a later date.

Senator/secretary Hollis distributed S.A. calenders to each Senator for their contributions.

President Parker announced that there are two Senate positions still open - - one in the College of Education and one in Social Work.

Senator Magruder announced that he had not been appointed to a Senate Committee as yet.

Senator Cunningham requested an adjournment at 8:05 p.m. which was seconded by Condon.
