J. H. MORTON TRANSFERS TO HOUSTON DATA CENTER;  
T. J. VILLARS NAMED TREASURY REPRESENTATIVE

J. H. Morton, Treasury Manager at the Houston Refinery since February of this year, has been named to the new position of Manager, Accounting, at the Houston Data Service Center and is scheduled to assume his new duties June 1.

In making the announcement, Refinery Manager L. T. Wilson named T. J. Villars, Jr., presently Chief Accountant at the Houston Refinery, to the newly created position of Treasury Representative, assuming the responsibility for the Treasury Department here at the Refinery.

The Treasury Department's organization relationships and responsibilities will remain essentially unchanged except for certain accounting and reporting functions which will be phased into the Data Service Center, Wilson said. In addition, Villars assumes the liaison responsibility between the Refinery and the Service Center, and Head Office financial management.

A graduate of L. S. U., Villars joined Shell at the
