fully bound unto Daniel J. Goler, Judge of the probate
Court in and for the County aforesaid for the time being,
and his Successors, in Office in the penal sum of Two Thou-
sand Dollars; To which payment well and truly to be made
and done, we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors,
Administrators, or assigns, jointly, severally, and jointly by
this presents.

The condition of the above Obliga-
tion is such, that whereas the above bound E. Rodcliff has
been appointed Curator to represent the absent heirs of Patrick
Allison Dec^d. Now if the said Rodcliff shall pay over to said
heirs when they present themselves legally identified as the heirs
of said of Patrick Allison after twenty days notice all such
monies, and other properties may come to his hands, or pos-
session as Curator of said absent heirs, abide by, and perform, all
such orders, and Decrees that the competent Executors may
make in the premises, and in all things appertaining to said
trust demean, and govern himself according to law; then
and in that case, the above Obligation to be null and void
else to remain in full force and virtue.
