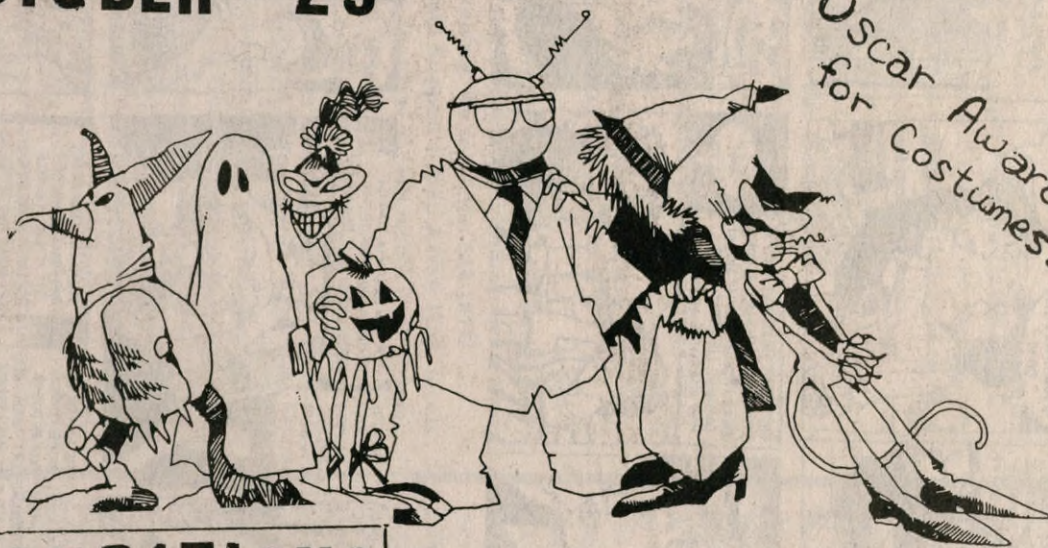

Her topic for the LiB meeting will be coming out.

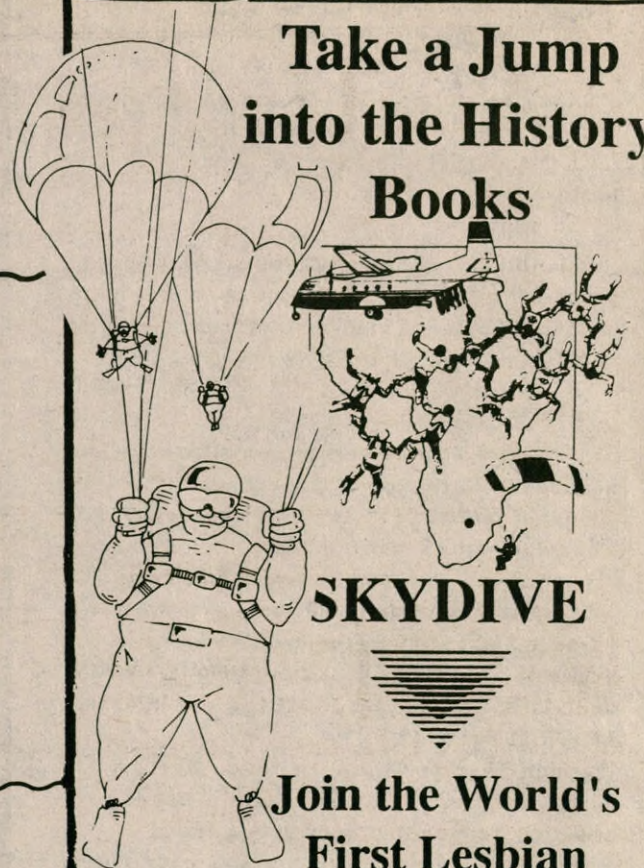

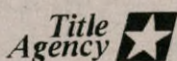

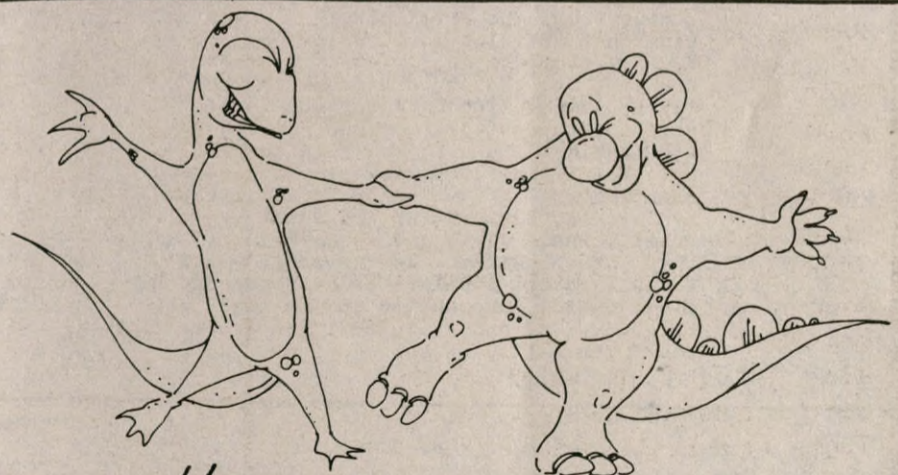
