## Suffrage Law Held Unconstitutional By 79th District Judge

CORPUS CHRISTI, Sept. 27.—The law enacted by the last session of the Texas Legislature granting women the right to vote in primaries and conventions was declared unconstitutional at Sinton, Texas, yesterday by Judge Voll M. Taylor in Seventy-ninth District Court when he overruled a general demurrer in the contested judgeship election for the Thirty-sixth District Court. The contest was filed by Judge F. G. Chambliss of Beeville, who was defeated for renomination as judge of the Thirty-sixth District at the Democratic primaries. Judge M. A. Childers of Sinton, according to the returns, was nominated by a majority of 250. Judge Chambliss in his contest charged the nomination of Judge Childers resulted illegally from the vote of women.

Judge Taylor yesterday ruled the woman vote could not be counted and ordered a canvass of the male vote in the Thirty-sixth District.
