The ninth meeting of the fifth session of the Student Senate was called to order by President RICHARD POSTON at 8:00 in the Federal Room of the University Center.

Senators CISCEL and SVENDSEN were present. Senators KOHLER, SHEHORN, and TAQVI were visitors.

REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT

The President announced that Senators KOHLER and LOMBARDINO had submitted their resignations. Senator LOMBARDINO'S resignation will result in a vacancy in the Summer Senate which the President stated could be filled in two ways: (1) The Senate could elect someone new; or (2) The Senate could take the individual who is fourth in the election of summer senators.

The President reported that he had gone to Austin to testify before a Senate Committee regarding the tuition increase. He said that the President of the Student Association from the University of Texas was also there. He announced that they had been able to talk to enough Senators to kill the bill.

OLD BUSINESS

Senator CISCEL moved to accept the appointments of Mark Garcia, Joaquin Reyne, and Dave Hamblin. Senator SVENDSEN seconded. There was no debate, and the motion was voted on and passed.

The Senate moved to accept the appointment of Don Johnson for the Orientation Steering Committee. There was no debate. The motion failed.

NEW BUSINESS

Senators CISCEL and SVENDSEN introduced Senate Bill No. 19, A BILL TO TRANSFER RESPONSIBILITY FOR PRODUCING COUGAR CAPERS TO THE PROGRAM COUNCIL. The President stated that the purpose of the Program Council was to take over programming from the Student Association. He added that the financing would not come from our budget. There was no further debate. The bill was voted on and passed.

Senator CISCEL asked that the names of all Senators present be included in the report each week.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

President POSTON announced that a special meeting would be held Monday, July 15, for the purpose of electing a new Summer Senator and approving appointments to the Orientation Steering Committee.

The President announced that he had appointed Dave Kohler to Legislative Assistant.

The President announced that the President of the Student Association at Michigan Tech, Tom Vlier, was visiting tonight.

There was no further business, and the Senate adjourned at 8:45.
