

Kenneth Dionell Moore, affectionately known to his fans and the music world as "Big Moe", was born on August 20, 1974 in Houston, Texas to proud parents, Kenneth Cooper and Terry Moore.

He accepted Christ at a very early age at Ark of Restitution Baptist Church. He attended Thompson Elementary, Cullen Middle School and Jack Yates High School, where he graduated on August 20, 1994.

Kenneth started singing at as a young child. He sang in the church choir and at Jack Yates High School. He became a professional singer/rapper and became well known in the music industry with his hit song "Purple Stuff," which reached No. 3 on the Billboard's Top R&B/Hip Hop Albums Chart in 2002. He recorded several other songs with many local artists and had other albums as a solo artist.

On October 14, 2007, Kenneth answered his call to come home. He was preceded in death by his father, Kenneth Cooper.

Kenneth's memories lives through his mother, Terry; brother, Kerrick; sister, Tisha; niece, Jessica; nephews, DeErick, Chris and Christian; grandparents, Mildred Jenkins (Freddie) and Thelma Battiste (David - deceased); aunt, Odessa Thomas; uncle, Gregory Moore (Anita) and daughters, cousins, Sabrina and Shirley, and Phillip Williams (Theresa, deceased) and son, Jordan; a host of aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
