Acknowledging yours of the 4th:

Looking to the future possibility of an adverse administration, I am of the opinion that we must adhere to the original plan of incorporating the corporation entering into the arrangements with the City. This will not interfere with making engagement and discussing the matter with the Mayor and Commissioners and with this in mind I have undertaken to revise the agreement which may be presented as a tentative form for discussion or further revised as your judgment dictates. Later on it may again be revised in a more formal and final way and be executed.

Meantime, I can see no reason why (after reaching preliminary agreement) the specifications should not be placed with contractors for bids.
