Referring to yours of November 22nd with enclosure from Houston & Tyler, Union National Bank Building, Houston:

I see nothing to do but follow Dr. Slaughter's judgment as reflected in the first paragraph of the letter mentioned above. However, before doing so, as Chairman of the Advisory Committee it might be well to discuss it with Dr. Slaughter and secure confirmation, particularly on the point of renewing on a three-year rather than a one-year basis the policy expiring on December 17th, as it is possible that since the agent talked with Dr. Slaughter the financial position may have improved to such extent as would justify now paying out the additional cash to obtain the benefit of the saving indicated.
