—To Plead for a Return of Constitutional Government—

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Example of Military Dictatorship Gives Foretaste of What May Come

Unless Conservatives Recapture One of Major Parties We're Sunk

On September 27, David Lawrence said in his column: "The casualties in President Eisenhower's war against the States will be counted for years to come but as of today, the biggest casualty is the Republican Party". He is so right.

Even if there were any doubt about the matter before the Army of Occupation was sent in to Arkansas to enforce the social program of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and to hasten One-World Government, there is all but unanimous agreement now that there is no Republican living who can win the Presidency in 1960.

Not only does this apply to Modern Republicans but, unfortunately, decent Republicans have been so thoroughly discredited by the stupidity, arrogance and ineptitude of the leadership that the party will do well to hang together until it is rescued at some vague future date by men who have a faint conception of the fundamental principles of the American government and the character and political integrity to administer it in accordance with this knowledge.

The tragedy is compounded when it is realized that there is no opposition party to fill the vacuum since it is unthinkable that disillusioned American citizens will swap the devil for the witch and seek redress from the Democratic Party currently dominated by the same international conspirators against the United States who brought the party of Lincoln to such an inglorious end.

If the present state of nation-wide resentment against corruption in Washington does not afford the opportunity for the rescue of the Democratic Party from the same fate and its re-dedication to sound, conservative principles which marked it before its betrayal by Roosevelt, such an opportunity will never be presented and we are sunk. Not only in the South but throughout the country there is a swelling wave of bitterness against continued betrayal of the people by elected representatives in Washington which has now come out into the open for the first time since 1952 when Sherman Adams first became President of the United States.

The recapture of the Democratic party would require bold and courageous action and the exercise of strength, strategy and initiative but if all the outraged conservatives who now find themselves without an anchor for their political allegiance would stand together at the precinct conventions next year, they could take it like Grant took Richmond or Walker took Little Rock.

Also, there are thousands upon thousands of conservative Republicans who are now politically displaced persons, who are smarting under their sell-out to International Communism and who would have nothing to lose by a coalition with real Democrats for the purpose of rehabilitating at least one of the major parties in this country and converting it into an American institution.

The initial job, of course, would be to thoroughly disinfect and fumigate the foul-smelling Democratic organization much on the order of running a sheep through a dipping vat in order to rid it of political vermin and human parasites who have sucked the party of all principle, integrity and vision and reduced it to a pitiable state of anemia, blight and dry-rot.

It is a job for big men with powerful minds but the Republic has always produced them in national crises none of which has ever been greater than the debacle which confronts us at this good hour.

That a higher power than our national government directs domestic and foreign policy of the United States has long been recognized by informed Americans. How far this supreme alien authority exercises control over the sovereign States and private citizens of the American Republic, however, was a matter of speculation until September twenty-fourth. In a dress rehearsal for One-World Government staged at Little Rock, Arkansas, to the fearsome and horrifying accompaniment of marching soldiers with drawn bayonets portraying the military might of a powerful central government, the people of the South were given a frightening foretaste of what awaits them in the totalitarian Super-State which may be just ahead. Today, there is shock, disbelief and stark terror in the hearts of once apathetic Southerners who have always brushed off warnings with the observation that it couldn't happen here. Belatedly, they realize that a ruthless international conspiracy to break down the sovereignty of the individual States of the American Republic in preparation for One-World Government may be near to fulfillment. Meantime as a prelude and possibly to test the reaction of the citizens to total Dictatorship, the pages of history have been turned back to the dark days of 1865 as Dixie is once again being placed under Carpetbag Rule.

In this hour of tragedy to which the South is no stranger, thoughtful citizens from all sections of the Republic must keep one fact firmly in mind if the invasion of the sovereign State of Arkansas by the armed forces of the United States is to be understood.

That fact is that the sovereignty of the forty-eight States, and especially that of the Southern States, has heretofore been the one insuperable barrier against One-World Government or International Communism—which are one and the same thing.

It was, therefore, inevitable that sooner or later extraordinary and superhuman attempts must be made to break this sovereignty down to insure that States Rights no longer exist. The principles of International Communism are firmly rooted in Washington and in many of the nation's great cities but the stubborn South has refused to surrender.

While integration of the schools is, of course, the evil offspring of International Communism, it was incidental in the armed invasion of Arkansas by Federal troops. The local difficulty there merely provided the opportunity for an attempt to forcibly disorganize the South and quell sectional opposition to the overall objective of a One-World Government.

It was obviously figured that if the elected officials of the sovereign State of Arkansas could be subdued and its citizens intimidated by the awesome spectacle of marching troops, flashing bayonets and arrogant, strutting Generals, then the people of the other States of Dixie where memory of Federal oppression following the Civil War is still green, could be brought to their knees in quick surrender.

Informed Americans have long been keenly alert to plans to commit the American Republic to One-World Government and have figured that this undertaking would be successfully completed by 1960. But few, if any, were prepared for the turn of events which made a Southern State the locale for the initial step toward this end.

come involved in a war which would provide for a virtual Dictatorship in Washington thereby facilitating and hastening the take-over by the forces for One-World Government. To bolster this belief, we have been repeatedly warned that without "our allies" this great Republic which won every war until we became embroiled in the United Nations, could not survive.

Why somebody suddenly jumped the gun and decided to conduct preliminary operations and make a test case in Arkansas is not clear and can only be explained on the ground that the Little Rock difficulty apparently presented an irresistible opportunity for armed Federal forces with drawn bayonets to provide a sample of the treatment which dissenters may expect in the great International Super-State to come. Stern discipline is a vital and necessary concomitant of any powerful governing body where military might is the only force holding it together and where the last forlorn hope of freedom must be squeezed from human hearts.

At any rate, the sovereign State of Arkansas, and potentially the entire South, is now under siege and it is costing the taxpayers of the United States an estimated \$105,000 per day to provide armed escorts to nine young Negro men and women and compel them to attend white Central High School in Little Rock instead of letting them go to their own million-dollar structure in another part of the city.

Any group of citizens who may entertain the idea of going to Washington to protest this outrage should be warned in advance that they will, in such event, not be dealing with their own national government alone which they are Constitutionally authorized to petition for the redress of grievances.

Instead, they will be going up against eighty-two national governments including some from behind the Iron Curtain, in the form of the United Nations whose clever and diabolically-worded Charter—as well as that of NATO—provides for the very type of brute force and tyrannical subjugation of the people in the interest of "human rights" which was exerted against the State of Arkansas in the name of "integration". And make no mistake about it; these Charters have superseded the American Constitution as the supreme governing instruments under which the three branches of our Federal government now operate.

Thus, any collection or group of patriots who may seek at long last to thwart the International Conspiracy against the United States and restore Constitutional Government to the people may hope for the best but they had also better be prepared for the worst. We can only pray that it's not "too little and too late".

Just on the off-chance that there may yet actually be a determined and organized effort by the American people acting in unison to recapture the Republic from its domestic and foreign enemies, and before the nation is irretrievably plunged over the brink into a Communist-dominated One-World Government, they had better, as individuals, learn some fundamental facts of life.

First, it cannot be stressed too often that State Sovereignty is paramount and supreme to that of the Federal government and a study of the basic structure of the Republic is proof of this irrefutable fact.

The States formed and set up the Federal government and specified its limited powers in the Constitution, and not the other way round. They set up checks and balances which they confidently believed would prevent one branch of the Federal government from usurping authority belonging to another, as the Executive and Judicial branches have repeatedly done in recent years.

The States, therefore, are the creators of the Federal government and the Federal government is their creature. To assume that the creature is superior to, or may exercise control over, its creator is to say that human beings are superior to God and is contrary to every law of the universe since the birth of mankind on earth. Under the proper conception of the American governing process, therefore, Sherman Adams and Herbert Brownell had no more legal authority nor moral right to send armed troops into Little Rock to intimidate the citizens with guns and bayonets than Khrushchev and Bulganin had to send armored tanks into Hungary to crush the patriots who dared make a break for liberty and to assert their God-given right to establish a free government.

Also, it must not be forgotten that the armed invasion of the

sovereign State of Arkansas, was not to put down an insurrection or uprising against the United States in which case the Federal government is authorized to act. Nor was it in response to a call of the government of that State for reinforcements in an emergency.

Armed invasion by Federal troops of that sovereign State in our opinion was, first, to prepare the people for similar punishment under One-World Government; second, to appease the National Association for Advancement of Colored People; and third, to influence the Negroes of Harlem, Detroit and the Chicago black belt to vote for Modern Republicanism's candidate for President in 1960. It was a three-base hit in which Constitutional Government was knocked out.

The whole premise on which this armed invasion of a sovereign State was based is evil, immoral and un-Constitutional. It was allegedly to uphold a "law" passed by the Supreme Court although the Supreme Court, of course, has no authority to legislate. And even if it had possessed this authority, the "law" which the Supreme Court "passed", and which Federal troops paid by taxpayers' money sought to enforce, was not based on legal considerations but on the demand of International Communists who were determined to stir up racial bitterness in the South and who have done just that to the extent that hatred and animosity between the black and white population has reached a stage where anything can happen. No action by Hitler, Stalin or Mussolini represented the brute force of total dictatorship any more effectively than did that of the present national administration in sending the armed forces into Little Rock to nullify the authority of the State of Arkansas.

In the final analysis, the total breakdown of Constitutional Government, as demonstrated by the disgraceful fiasco at Little Rock, cannot be blamed altogether on corrupt and power-mad politicians in Washington but on the American people who have tolerated them instead of demanding that they be impeached and removed from office. Under the American governing system, the voters are the Court of Last Resort and the custodians of the priceless document which the founding fathers bequeathed us.

That this document has been violated, dishonored and repudiated by those sworn to protect and uphold it is, therefore, the fault of the electorate as well as of the elected. And among those who must bear the blame and the shame are thousands of educators and ministers in the churches who had the God-given opportunity to inspire and guide the youth of the land toward the lofty American ideals of love of God, patriotic devotion to country and pride of race but who, instead, chose to debase and indoctrinate these plastic minds with the filthy doctrines of Karl Marx including atheism, disloyalty and mongrelization of the white and black races.

There are no more futile and pointless words in the English language than the expression "I told you so" but the fact remains that the Southern Conservative has, for eight long years, harped on the subject of States Rights, in season and out; has pointed out their paramount and supreme authority in the American governing system and has urged the desperate need to keep and preserve them. We have warned time and time again that they were being destroyed one by one and have tried to hammer home the inescapable truth that their annihilation could only mean the end of Constitutional Government in the United States.

The Police State at Little Rock has put a period to our observations on the subject.

As shocked and disillusioned Americans view the tragic wreckage of the once greatest Constitutional Republic in human history and realize that the last government in the world "of the people, by the people and for the people" may soon perish from the earth and lose its identity in a One-World State, we remind them once again that the inevitable penalty which the citizen must pay for apathy, indifference and unconcern in the affairs of government is corruption, flagrant abuse of power and, finally, ruthless tyranny on the part of those who govern him.

This is the changeless and irrevocable law of the ages which no human agency can veto or repeal.

We Know Now That Almost Anything Can Happen Here

There are said to be 4,000,000 Negroes in the South who are eligible to vote but who have never heretofore registered, not because they were "intimidated" but because they had no interest in the matter.

The NAACP and administration advisers in Washington are making attempts to get this potential voting bloc registered and lined up in order to bring Negro Roy Wilkinson's prediction of Colored Congressmen from the South nearer to fulfillment.

It is going to require money — bushels of it — to get this vote lined up for the general purpose of electing Negro Congressmen in the future and for the specific purpose of electing Richard Nixon as President in 1960 and taxpayers had better be on guard against some trickily maneuvered plan to shift the cost of this mammoth project to their shoulders.

In Imagination We Build A Library To Actually Serve American People

Reading about all the to-do in connection with the Rayburn Library at Bonham has inspired in us a wish that we could establish one of our own some day.

We would not have any important personal documents to put in it and tin-horn celebrities like Tom Clark and Harry Truman probably would not attend our opening festivities. But we have in mind plenty of material for the library which would really be informative and educational and which might contribute toward better citizenship in the future.

First, we would include the complete records of the House Un-American Activities Committee from its beginning including the out-of-print and impossible-to-get Appendix IX of the Dies Committee listing the thousands of American traitors who have operated within and without the government to destroy the Republic.

It would include the unexpurgated Yalta Papers before the State Department emasculated them and removed all damaging reference to Roosevelt's sell-out to Stalin; it would include the complete series of reports by the Committee on the Judiciary of the United States Senate called "Scope of Soviet Activity in the United States" showing how a hard core of determined Communists are undermining the internal security of the United States, in collaboration with scores of highly-placed American traitors; it would include the complete Senate Judiciary report on the Institute of Pacific Relations, financed largely by the large Foundations, which exposes the betrayal of China to the Communists by diplomats in the American State Department; it would contain the official report of the Sub-Committee of the Senate Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs composed of thousands of pages showing how, through the manipulation of GATT and the transfer of our tariff-making policy to a

Earlier President Had Proper Conception of His High Office

When James Madison made his first inaugural address on becoming President, March 4, 1809, he expressed confidence in the principles "which I bring with me into this arduous service" and which the current Chief Executive could emulate with great profit to the nation.

"To cherish peace and friendly intercourse with all nations having corresponding dispositions; to maintain sincere neutrality toward belligerent nations; to prefer in all cases amicable discussion and reasonable accommodation of differences to a decision of them by an appeal to arms; to exclude foreign intrigues and foreign partialities, so degrading to all countries and so baneful to free ones; to foster a spirit of independence too just to invade the rights of others, too proud to surrender our own . . . to hold the Union of States as the basis of their peace and happiness; to support the Constitution which is the cement of the Union, as well in its limitations as in its authorities; to respect the rights and authorities reserved to the States and to the people as equally incorporated with and essential to the success of the general system . . ."

Because this ethical and Constitutional procedure has not been observed, the State of the Union is at the lowest ebb in history.

Because we have failed to "maintain sincere neutrality" or "to exclude foreign intrigues and partialities" and have interfered in the affairs of each and every nation we have lost the respect of the rest of the world as well as running up a national indebtedness greater than that of all the rest of the nations of the earth combined; and our lack of "respect for the rights and authorities reserved to the States" has divided and embittered the American people, weakened confidence of the citizens in their leadership and made a mockery of our Republican form of government.

Perhaps the reason Nero fiddled while Rome burned was because there were no golf courses in Italy at the time where he could while away his time as his country toppled.

The exodus of white people from Washington, D. C. continues and the integrated schools there which are the cause of the white persons' flight from the Capital are now 70 per cent colored. The Dallas News suggests that if this flight continues, the Supreme Court will have to send bench warrants to Virginia and Maryland to arrest white children and compel them to go to Washington schools so that Negroes may have the "psychological advantages" of their company.

The Carnegie Endowment for International Peace has made a grant for a UN-sponsored inquiry into the possibility of setting up a World Police Force in the United Nations. We already have one at Little Rock, but it's just not called by that name.

Commission of foreigners in Geneva, strategic and critical war materials have been made all but inaccessible to this country in national emergency; it would include the documented proof of the Communist conspiracy to infiltrate the schools and churches of the United States, including the Moscow-inspired campaign for integration of American schools; the true story of Pearl Harbor and events that led up to World War II and the Korean War and the origin of the order to fire MacArthur.

In brief, it would contain the documented story of the betrayal of America and the World Conspiracy to break down American sovereignty and betray the American Republic into a Communist-dominated One-World Government which has all but succeeded.

There would not be any personal glory in such a library for us but it would render an undying service to the people for all time to come in the Republic which we love.

Georgia Has A Governor Who Knows His Business

We heartily commend Governor Marvin Griffin of Georgia for refusing to go to Washington to consult with the President on matters which strictly relate to his State and to the South.

We think that the mistake Governor Orval Faubus of Arkansas made was in going to Newport and interrupting the President's golf game to talk about the situation in Little Rock which was strictly the affair of Arkansas officials and Arkansas citizens.

Since the President apparently has as little knowledge as any one in the nation concerning the proper functions of State and Federal government in this country, and the limited authority of the latter, and only knows what he reads in the paper or what his advisers tell him, he would naturally get the impression, when Southern governors come to consult with him, that he is all-powerful in the situation and has a right to send his storm troopers out to handle matters.

Governor Griffin was exactly right in taking the position that State sovereignty takes precedence over Federal authority in matters relating solely to the States and Georgia is extremely fortunate in having a Chief Executive who acts like one.

1,000 Riot in Philadelphia as Troops March on Little Rock

Although only two newspapers in the nation carried the story, one thousand White and Negro students were rioting in the streets of Philadelphia on September 24th as heavily armed Federal troops marched into Little Rock to "prevent disorder" in connection with the schools.

In a 7-column report of the mob action in the city of Brotherly Love, the Philadelphia Inquirer on September 25 told how more than one thousand white and black students of the South Philadelphia High school battled each other from three o'clock in the afternoon until midnight as 20 police cars, 60 policemen and a special unit of 12 highway patrolmen tried vainly to put down the riot.

The mob action broke out as a result of an attack by six young Negroes on a white girl the previous week when the black thugs seized the 17-year old white student and dragged her into the school yard at Alcorn Elementary at 32nd and Dickinson Streets.

According to the Inquirer, home and shop owners were forced to close their doors and bar themselves inside as the rioters fought up and down the streets in various sections of the city. Girl students returning from school ran screaming into stores for protection.

A Texas newspaper man, Carl Estes, of Longview, happened to

be a visitor in Philadelphia at the time and gave a full report of the affair in his newspaper, the Longview Journal.

Apparently the Inquirer and the Journal were the only two newspapers in the nation which considered the Philadelphia mob action participated in by 1000 students of sufficient importance to write about it, although the Arkansas disturbance has had millions of words in publications throughout the country.

"The smoldering embers of hate between the Negro and White students has been covered only by a thin gray ash since school started in early September" Estes wrote in the Journal. "Tuesday's full-fledged riot was finally fanned to flame, in the words of Police Captain Harry Wilhare of the 24th and Wolf Streets Police Station, as the aftermath of an attack by six young Negroes on a white girl last Wednesday night.

"Strangely enough not a newspaper or wire service in the city got a single picture of Tuesday's riot . . . One wonders if those Northern newsmen and photographers are either asleep, covering up or are short-handed because of the dispatch of the great hordes of newsmen and photographers to Little Rock, Arkansas, from whence they are sending out a veritable flood of pictures and news releases of that strife-torn city . . ."

One of its principal objectives was the abolition of segregation in the public schools.

Crouch knew what he was talking about because at the time the SCHW was being set up, he was a top Communist official himself and helped to set up the outfit along with such other Communists as Robert Fowler Hall, James W. Ford, William Weiner, M. L. Edwards, Theresa Cantor and a half dozen others.

One of the "honest liberals" taken in by the Communist officials of the Conference at its first meeting was none other than the Honorable Brooks Hays of Arkansas. He was vice chairman of the Conference and a member of the Sponsorship and Participation Committee.

On September 23, Newsweek Magazine referred to Southerners who oppose the mixing of Negro and White students in the public schools in various derogatory terms including "rabble rousers" "riffraff" and the "sweepings of mankind."

On September 25, the Christian Century referred to opponents of forced racial mixing of the races in the public schools as "foul-mouthed juveniles of the South" and insisted that they are an "increasingly evil stench in the world's nostrils."

On October 1, in his broadcast, concerning integration in Little Rock, Mr. Fulton Lewis, Jr. classified Southerners who are fighting to protect their children from the vileness, obscenity and sex depravity which, as a result of integration, prevails in Mr. Lewis' own city of Washington, as "poor white trash."

Newsweek's vituperation and abuse of the decent elements of society in the South and elsewhere in the nation, is strictly in character for a publication edited by jaded and worn-out literary hacks who have never pretended to adhere to ethical practices of honorable and responsible journalism and whose parroting of the pronouncements of left-wing Washington officials is dished up to the public as profound and original editorial thinking.

The Christian Century is widely recognized as the clerical edition of the Daily Worker and its editorial policy in behalf of anti-American principles is concrete proof of the successful campaign of the Soviet to corrupt certain religious forces of the United States.

were up to certainly would seem to disqualify him as a mediator in any difficulty concerning integration.

We leave it to other Southern States to make their own defense but we propose to give some facts and figures relating to Texas for the information of Newsweek, Christian Century and Mr. Fulton Lewis, Jr.

On July 28, 1956 a primary election was held in Texas and segregation was placed on the ballot in order that the sentiment of the people of the State on the subject might be determined.

There are 254 counties in Texas.

At the polls, 22 of these counties voted in favor of segregation by more than 90%; 82 by 80-90%; 77 by 70-80%; 52 by 60-70%; 16 by 50-60% and in only 2 counties the voters disapproved segregation. In 3 counties segregation was not on the ballot and the people did not have an opportunity to vote on the matter. In the counties having a heavy Negro population, the people voted above 80% in favor of segregation while the counties voting less than 70% in favor of segregation have a very small Negro population.

So, out of a State with 254 counties, 251 of which voted on the subject of whether or not the people preferred segregated schools, all but 2 of them voted by heavy majorities in favor of this practice.

A total of 1,125,015 Texans voted in that election on the subject of segregation and of this number 872,030 voted in favor of continuing this policy in the public schools of the State, and 252,985 voted against it, and in favor of integration.

This means that, according to Newsweek, the Christian Century and Mr. Fulton Lewis, Jr., 872,030 Texans, or 78 per cent of the voting population of the Lone Star State are "rabble rousers" "riffraff" "sweepings of mankind," "foul-mouthed juveniles" or "poor white trash."

We submit that these are the most reckless, irresponsible and juvenile charges against a respectable element of the American population ever given utterance through human tongue or pen and mark those who made them as utterly incapable of truthfully reporting the facts in a situation they undertake to discuss.

It's an ill wind that blows nobody good and the trouble in Arkansas has awakened the American people as nothing else could to the fact that States Rights is not an issue that belongs solely to the South but concerns every State in the Union. Almost three-fourths of the letters we have received in condemnation of Federal intervention in the situation have come from other sections than the South.

Rishikesh Shaha, Ambassador from Nepal to the United Nations was attacked and seriously wounded while walking in Central Park in New York and was taken to the hospital with stab wounds in the chest and head. According to the New York Daily News the Ambassador's attackers were two young Negroes who robbed him of \$95 before beating him up. If the attackers had been white men, the affair would probably have been taken up in the United Nations.

We have unbounded admiration for John Prather of New Mexico who recently gave the American people an illustration of Americanism in action.

Washington politicians decided they wanted his land in that State for some purpose or other having to do with atom bombs. In the manner of bureaucrats and with no consideration whatever for the wishes of the individual, they announced to Mr. Prather that they would pay him \$100,000 for his ranch. Prather refused to sell and since he was an old man whose family had lived on the land in question for generations, he wanted to die there.

Americanism Is Pronounced 'Subversive' in Florida City

Working for the preservation of the American Constitution, the protection of States Rights and for a real two-party system of government in this country is now a subversive activity in Broward County, Florida, according to the Fort Lauderdale, Florida, News.

The News bases its opinion on action by the County Commission there which ordered the sheriff to break up any attempt by the local States Rights group to hold a meeting at the Courthouse.

Two weeks earlier one of the local banks in Fort Lauderdale refused further use of its meeting room to the States Rights group on the ground that they were "controversial". The group then secured permission to use the Courthouse and then the City Commission rescinded that permission by a 4-1 vote. One of the Commissioners is declared to have expressed the opinion that the group might be a "Communist-front organization".

Denial of a building in which to meet and discuss the vital issue of States Rights — right now the one thing that may mean survival of the Republic — followed the appearance of a local citizen there before the Commission who charged that the States Righters were "in favor of segregation", against "immigration", against the United Nations and the "Federal income tax".

The protesting citizen's name was Mr. Paul L. Epstein.

And so, as the News further states "like brainwashed puppets four members of the County Commission in Fort Lauderdale promptly agreed with Mr. Epstein and ordered the sheriff not to let this supposedly 'distardly' group hold its planned meeting in the courthouse".

(Editor's note: We learn that such strong pressure was exerted against the Commission that they later changed their mind again and allowed the patriots to meet in the Court House).

Rockefeller Puts In His Two Cents

No dignity or wisdom was contributed to the Little Rock situation by reason of the fact that Winthrop Rockefeller decided to get into the act.

"It will be six months before we can actually estimate the damage that has been done," the multimillionaire advocate of racial mongrelization said in a press interview. Thus he credits to the Supreme Court, the right to "pass laws" a function belonging to the Congress and the Congress alone according to the Constitution.

When a former President of the United States is so ignorant of Constitutional Government that he ascribes to one branch of the Federal government the duties and responsibilities belonging to another branch, it is no wonder that the people likewise are so ill-informed in this regard.

As racial bitterness flared at Little Rock and armed soldiers cowed the citizens with guns and bayonets, the nine old men who started it all by taking dictation from a Swedish Marxist, were on vacation in various sections of the world. One of them, Hugo Black of Alabama, former Klansman who doffed his bedsheets to don a judicial robe was even enjoying a honeymoon, having married his secretary before leaving Washington, following her divorce from her husband.

Speaking of members of the Supreme Court, possibly the most discredited and unpopular body of men in the world outside of the Kremlin, John O'Donnell one of the nation's outstanding newspaper columnists said in the New York Daily News, September 24: "... From Chief Justice Warren down to the junior member, the Eisenhower Democratic appointee, William J. Brennan, Jr., the Justices have forgotten one vital issue in their deliberations on the admixture of the races in public schools. It is this: not one of them had ever been permitted by their parents to go to a mixed school. Not one has ever permitted his children to go to a public school with Negroes, and none today permits his children to attend private schools which in recent months here in Washington have been pressured to bow to the political demand for desegregation ... The important point is that the offspring of the Supreme Court Justices, Senators and other tax-supported politicians who beat their breasts in public in favor of ... desegregation ... won't send their own children to a public school here in Washington unless they are privately assured that it is definitely all white ..."

Senate Committee Finds Union Handling Communications Is Red Riots Don't Require Federal Troops Except in the South

Those Americans who want to feel secure and to sleep well at night had best not read the series of publications being put out by the Committee on the Judiciary of the United States Senate titled "Scope of Soviet Activity in the United States."

So far there have been 54 of these pamphlets issued and we are not advised of the number which will be put out before the investigation of the subject is complete.

As to the information which the Committee, headed by Senator James O. Eastland of Mississippi, is developing, Series 44 is typical. This deals with the American Communications Association which is the bargaining agent, certified by the National Labor Relations Board, for approximately 5,000 employes of Western Union Telegraph Company, 200 employes of the Western Union Cable Company, for RCA Communications on the East and West Coasts and for employes in broadcasting stations in New York and Philadelphia.

Telegraph messages of all kinds are handled by these employes and many of them are government messages. This includes messages from the Defense Department, U. S. Naval Air Station, U. S. Naval Shipyards, U. S. Navy Communications and many other Divisions of the Federal government.

Three years ago an investigation of the ACA by this same committee resulted in the unanimous con-

clusion that this labor union was Communist controlled. Recently the Committee re-examined the situation to find if the same situation still continues after the expiration of three years. In 1950 the ACA was kicked out of the CIO for following the Communist Party Line and for "disloyalty to American trade union principles".

Witnesses before the Committee from communications systems testified that there have been no change and that the same Communist control over the association exists at this time. One witness said under oath that Communists reply when charged with Communist domination that the organization has official certification from the United States government. They are referring to certification from the National Labor Relations Board.

When it is realized how vital the communications systems of a nation are, and how demoralizing it can be when they are disrupted by the enemy who may attack, this situation is indefensible. One would think the administration, or the Congress or the Supreme Court would have taken the strongest possible measures in the past three years to correct this menace to the internal security of the United States.

But of course they were busy on other matters — Civil Rights and school integration, for instance.

Dr. H. A. Bullock, a professor at the Texas Southern University in Houston, a Negro school, is engaged in a commendable undertaking which should be emulated by white and black alike. He is organizing young Negroes into groups to make a classroom to classroom, door-to-door, tavern-to-tavern drive asking Negroes to police themselves. He pointed out that although the Negroes of Houston comprise only 20 per cent of Houston's population, the colored race is responsible for 65 per cent of the murders which occur there. This is what we call "social service" of a high order to the colored race. It is a service, however, which Northern do-gooders would never understand this side of eternity.

Red press reporters, most of whom have been so indoctrinated in their schools and churches that they never had a chance to understand what Americanism means, had a field day in Little Rock. One AP writer, an Arden Cooper, held up one of the Negro girls involved as the "Star of the Show." To this racial deviate that was what the fiasco meant—a "show".

The President's attitude toward the sovereign State of Arkansas was completely different from his attitude toward Communist Russia, the Houston Chronicle says and adds: "With Russia he has been willing to negotiate endlessly and compromise on every issue. In Little Rock he seemed unwilling to spend a little time trying to persuade the people to accept the Federal court decision before smashing down with the mailed fist."

Oh, No! Surely not A Race Riot in Boston

When one thousand White people and Negroes in the city of Boston pushed, pummelled and punched each other in the streets of Boston for hours on October 4, the Associated Press actually referred to it as a "race fight." They could not quite bring themselves to describe it as a "race riot." That term is reserved exclusively for similar activities which occur below the Mason-Dixon line.

It required forty policemen to quell the "race fight" and 23 persons were charged with "inciting a riot."

Police officials said the brawl started in a dance hall and spread out in the street, from which we assume that both Negroes and Whites must have been attending the same dance. Quite an exclusive affair, no doubt?

We never dreamed that the day would come when we would be able to look back and, in comparison, to regard Roosevelt and Truman as patriotic American statesmen.

Labor union activities have been attended by violence of all types up to and including murder for the past quarter of a century and nothing has been done about it, so why get virtuous about its leadership now?

Cowardly members of Congress have coddled them and exempted them from the provisions of law which others have to comply with or go to the pen and naturally labor leaders consider themselves above the law, which, actually they are.

They have tied up industry by vicious strikes, have clubbed and beaten those who tried to work and have destroyed property in the amount of millions of dollars while officers of the law looked the other way on orders from higher-up.

Until we get enough members of both Houses of Congress with sufficient maturity, judgment and Americanism to pass laws which will make labor unions toe the mark, and not merely in handling their own funds but in making them amenable to the anti-trust laws which govern other organizations and groups, and prevent them from using blackjacks to enforce their will, then—until that time—we think it natural and appropriate that gangsters head them up.

Apparently the military brass in the Pentagon thinks that riots don't require the mailed fist of federal intervention unless they occur in the South.

The Pentagon order to federal troops stationed in the South to start special training for riot duty was rescinded quickly, but it still showed the thinking which must prevail there. It is unlikely that one official would issue such an order, unless there was a lot of sentiment in that direction.

In recent years there have been riots on various issues in Chicago, Detroit, Levittown, Pa., Philadelphia, New York and in Wisconsin. No federal troops were specially trained and rushed into those places. In fact, the federal government didn't even acknowledge knowing about the riots.

But those occurred in the North. It isn't popular politically to intervene there. The vote-getting technique of the moment is to clobber the South on every occasion.

Knowing this, the official in the Pentagon who issued the special training order probably had visions of getting a big promotion. He may even have designed already a special medal to be awarded the federal shock troops in the South. An appropriate medal would show a husky paratrooper in full battle dress chasing teen-agers at bayonet point. Members of the Second A.E.F. (Arkansas Expeditionary Force) surely deserve recognition like that given the forces under Pershing who went into Mexico after Pancho Villa.

News releases from the UP correspondent in London inform us that the British, who used to pop off concerning our "treatment" of Negroes have been strangely silent about the Little Rock fiasco and that the press there is unusually restrained in discussing the subject. The reason is that a veritable army of unemployed Negroes from the West Indies is descending on England daily. And it serves them right.

The American taxpayers are entitled to a public statement from the Defense Department giving them the exact amount which it cost them to have a heavy contingent of armed soldiers sent to Little Rock, Arkansas, for the purpose of conducting nine Negro boys and girls to classes in a White school and for appeasing the Negro woman who is head of the NAACP in that city. The taxpayers must pay the bill and are entitled to have an itemized statement of the expense.

Governor Price Daniel of Texas issued a strong statement in denunciation of Federal troops being sent into Arkansas to enforce integration. Lyndon Johnson issued a long statement too but said nothing. It was one of those typical middle-of-the-road utterances which mean nothing and offend no one.

General Commended for Misinforming Students

In his column September 17, Bob Considine had high praise for Edwin A. Walker, the military general who heads the Army of Occupation in Arkansas, because of a talk that officer made to students of Central High School in that city when Federal troops took over.

Considine commended the general for explaining the 14th amendment to the Constitution to the students and for telling them that "the decision by the Supreme Court was of course an authoritative interpretation of the Constitution".

Neither Considine nor Walker knew what they were talking about because the information Walker gave to the students was erroneous in the first place and certainly it is unethical for a newspaper man to applaud the spreading of incorrect information among students of the nation.

If Walker felt that it was in good taste for a military man to address a student body under the circumstances, he should at least have told them the truth and informed them that the 14th amendment to the Constitution was never legally adopted and that its acceptance was forced at the point of a bayonet just as integration is being temporarily enforced in Little Rock. Also, he might have added, that the 14th amendment says nothing at all about schools or integration nor anything that can be construed as having any reference to either.

Walker, of course, was merely repeating statements prepared for him by propagandists in Washington who are concerned, not in the Constitution, but in the Negro vote. Probably he could not evade doing what he was ordered to do but it was atrocious taste for a reputable newspaper man to commend him for the sorry performance.

"Policemen in Detroit are studying human relations," the AP article said. "Police Commissioner Edward S. Piggins said the eight-hour course on Civil Rights, racial tensions, personal prejudices and attitudes was set up on the theory that policemen don't know enough about the subject."

With Schools Integrated by Bayonet Churches Now Prodded to Get Busy

Perhaps the reason that so many churches are devoting three-fourths of their time to attempts to socially mix the black and white races, is because they got such a late start.

For over two thousand years, they did nothing about it and suddenly discovered that it was "Christian Brotherhood" to mix and mingle socially with Negroes only after a campaign was started in Moscow to bring this about. While giving high praise to United Nations, UNESCO and other One-World activities, her pet project was obviously mongrelization of the races and to this end she was promoting the use of a book for discussion among religious groups titled "The Kingdom Beyond Caste."

This book is written by one Liston Pope, minister of the Congregational Church and Dean of the Yale Divinity school and it really is a honey of a volume from the standpoint of pleading for the social mixing of the races all the way from the school-room to the bedroom, and all levels in between. Like all books of its type,

He is listed as having been a member of the National Citizens' Political Action Committee and the Report of the Special Committee on Un-American Activities, 1944, says that: "It has been clearly established by overwhelming evidence that the National Citizens' Political Action Committee is the major Communist front organization of the moment."

Pope is also listed as a sponsor of the notorious "People's Institute of Applied Religion," page 1464, Appendix IX. According to the Report of the Special Committee on Un-American Activities, 1944, this "Institute of Applied Religion" is "one of the most vicious Communist organizations ever set up in this country." Its director was Claude C. Williams, an admitted member of the Communist Party who carried a card under the name of John Galey, according to the same Report, which also discloses that the "Institute" was once located in Little Rock, Arkansas where its State Director was one Robert D. Shumpert.

Pope was also listed as having been a member of the American Round Table on India, page 1772, Appendix IX. This organization was cited as a "Communist front headed by Robert Norton, a well-known member of the Communist Party" by the California Committee on Un-American Activities, 1949.

But why go on? The pattern is too familiar to need repetition.

Some of the good church people refused to use Pope's book in their studies presumably because of its advocacy of immoral racial practices but some others followed without question the female lecturer's suggestions and listed it as authority on the subject and recommended it as proper reading by their missionaries and others.

For going on three years labor union goons have violated law and order in Wisconsin in connection with the strike against the Kohler plant. Innocent citizens have been beaten, property damaged, and a state bordering on anarchy has prevailed in the strike-torn city of Kohler where the plant is located. Why have not Brownell and Adams sent Federal troops there to put down mob rule? The answer is that labor unions constitute a minority group which is highly organized and is supposed to be able to deliver a large bloc vote. That's why.

Some Facts of Life People Of the South Must Learn

In order that those who live in the conquered South may have no illusions concerning the honesty, truthfulness and future intent of their rulers in Washington who exercise supreme authority over their lives, they should consider these facts and be prepared for anything that may happen.

When the Civil Rights bill was before Congress, the President was asked the direct question as to whether or not he believed that Federal troops should be sent into a State to enforce school segregation. His answer, which is of record, lulled the citizens into a feeling of security on this point. He gave assurance that he could not imagine any situation in which he would take such action and left no doubt in the minds of the American people that he considered such procedure abhorrent in a free country. Less than sixty days later, his armed forces were in Little Rock, Arkansas, for the purpose of enforcing school segregation at the point of bayonets.

When Senator Richard Russell of Georgia questioned Attorney General Brownell about an old law of Reconstruction days permitting Federal troops to invade a State to enforce Federal law—reference to which had been eliminated from the Civil Rights bill—he specifically asked the attorney general if it was the intention of the administration at any time to invoke this statute for enforcing the proposed Civil Rights bill.

The attorney general made this reply:

"I am rather disturbed by you even raising these points, because, as I said so many times, public statements made by persons who intimate that there is any such thought in the minds of anyone here in Washington to use the militia in such cases does not represent the true state of facts, and I frankly think that the only reason it can be brought into the discussion at all is to confuse the issue.

"I do not know of any responsible public official of any part of any branch of the government that has made any statement that would even lead to an inference that there is any such thought in the minds of the Congress or the courts of the executive branch of the government."

Less than sixty days later, Brownell was standing at the side of the President urging him to send armed troops into Little Rock, Arkansas, for the purpose of integrating nine Negroes into the all-White high school of that city.

This official behavior is either frank, forthright and honest or it isn't.

The sooner the people of the South decide the matter, the better prepared they will be for whatever may be in store for them in the future.

One of the most inexcusable and indefensible things about the seizure of Little Rock by Federal troops was the "federalization" of the Arkansas National Guard thereby leaving that State without protection in the event of an emergency. We are unable to find out by what authority this phase of the invasion was accomplished but since the bringing of the troops in was unauthorized by the Constitution in the first place, perhaps the other question becomes academic.
