THIS IS A MEMBERSHIP ORGANIZATION GOVERNED BY BEHAVIOR AND SAFETY RULES AND OTHER REGULATIONS. OUR GUIDELINES AND RULES ARE FOR YOUR BENEFIT. 1. ALL CONVENTION ACTIVITIES ARE ON THE GROUND FLOOR LEVEL; HOTEL SERVICE AREAS (STAIRS, ELEVATORS, ETC.) AND THE ROOF ARE "OFF LIMITS."
2. PLEASE COOPERATE BY LETTING US KNOW IF YOU SEE SOME ONE DAMAGING PROPERTY IN ANY MANNER; VANDALS WILL BE TURNED OVER TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES FOR POSSIBLE PROSECUTION.
3. CONVENTION BADGES MUST BE WORN, AT ALL TIMES, IN A CLEARLY VISIBLE PLACE ON THE UPPER BODY. BADGES REMAIN THE CONVENTION'S PROPERTY UNTIL THE END OF THE CONVENTION.

6. RUNNING OF ANY KIND AND RUNNING GAMES (OR "RUNS") ARE NOT PERMITTED.
7. THE HOTEL REQUIRES THAT SHOES BE WORN IN ALL PUBLIC AREAS.
8. PLEASE REMEMBER SOME GUESTS ARE SLEEPING, SO NO LOUD TALKING, SINGING, OR OTHER NOISE IN THE PATIO AREA AFTER 10:30 P.M.
9. OCCASIONALLY WE SHOW A FILM THAT REQUIRES PROOF OF AGE (PHOTO I.D.)
