Dear Mr. Wallace:

Your letter of June 18 addressed to The Registrar, College of Optometry, has been referred to me for reply in the absence of Dr. Clanton W. Williams, our academic vice president.

I must report to you that the matter of desegregation is currently a subject of serious study on the part of the University and its Board of Regents.

To assist you in your planning, the following information appears to be pertinent:

1. To date no Negro has been admitted to the University of Houston.
2. It appears likely that desegregation at the graduate level will be preliminary to admission of undergraduate Negro students.
3. Our Board of Regents will not meet again until the Fall, which means that no action can be taken which might affect enrollment in the Fall, 1956. When a final decision has been reached, you will doubtless see press notices as to how desegregation will be approached.
