"We guarantee the goods in this shipment to be of perfect design, workmanship and materials, and that they will be found exactly as represented by us in all our advertisements, circulars and printed matter. We further agree that we will make good any defects in workmanship or materials within one year from date of purchase, at our own expense, and we will cheerfully refund full purchase price and **Freight Charges** if you are not satisfied with your transaction, and that you have value received for your money."

Our Prices—Our prices are *Net* and f. o. b. (packed, free on board cars) Ann Arbor. Prices do not include freight charges and we make no discount for quantity. A Net Extra Charge of five per cent will be made on orders boxed for foreign shipment except to Canada and Mexico. Any order will be shipped completely assembled and ready for use (except dining tables) for five per cent extra to cover additional cost of packing. All Come-Packt Furniture will be shipped in sections, completely stained and finished unless otherwise ordered.

Prices in this catalog supersede all previous catalogs (A-B-C-D-E-F and G).


Our Terms—Our terms are cash in advance, or 25 per cent when the order is placed and the balance to be collected by draft attached to Bill of Lading. On orders amounting to \$10.00 or less, cash in full should accompany the order, or collection charges must be assumed by the Purchaser. We sell in no other way. This means that we cannot carry accounts on our books regardless of the rating or financial responsibility of the purchaser. We have no installment or partial payment plan.

Our References—We refer you to the Ann Arbor Banks, 2d Nat'l Bank, Toledo, or to the Commercial Agencies as to our responsibility and financial standing.

Our Selling Plan—The diagram on the opposite page shows clearly our method of selling goods and shipping direct from the factory to user. It explains graphically what you are paying for when you buy of the local dealer, and while these profits and expenses add full fifty per cent to the purchase price, they do not increase the actual VALUE of the goods to the user. We state to you frankly that we make a profit on every article we sell (we are in business to make money), but there is only one profit and not one penny has been added that increases only the price and not the value of the goods. We want your business, if we can save you money, and suggest that you make up a list of the furniture that you are interested in and let us quote you a price, with freight added to your city. We will also send samples of our different cushion coverings and stains for your guidance in placing a definite order. The delivered price will give you a definite basis for making comparisons with the cost of the completed furniture in your local stores. We know that you will be delighted with the quality of our workmanship and materials.





TOPS FOR SOME OF OUR TABLES

To go into details: We manufacture a high grade of quarter-sawn white oak furniture of the Mission and Arts and Crafts and Bungalow Styles. The machining, joiner work, fitting, sanding, etc., up to the assembling stage is carried on the same as in other factories where high grade furniture is made, but here our processes diverge—the other factories assemble the pieces into completed articles and send them to the finishing rooms. We assemble the pieces into sections, or completed units, and send them to the packing or finishing rooms to be inspected and boxed for shipment.

In the greater number of our designs, the sections are put together with screws, or patent fasteners. There is no sanding, fitting or other tool work for you to do before putting the sections together. When the sections are together, the furniture is substantial, solid, durable, and except in a very few cases cannot be taken apart for re-shipment.

Illustration No. 12B 328 shows the sections of one of our Library Tables, one of the handsomest of our tables, and also one of the easiest to assemble. The sectional view of dining table 12B 319 shows the ease with which it can be assembled, just twenty-four screws to put into the holes which are already bored and table is ready for the stain. 12B 24 shows the sections of one of our rockers. These few pieces, selected at random, show the ease and simplicity of putting the assembled sections together. No skill or mechanical knowledge is necessary—a few minutes work will assemble our largest pieces. The life of a piece of furniture depends, first, on the materials used, and second, on the way the different pieces or parts are put together.

Whenever a joint is to be made that from its nature cannot be satisfactorily held together with patent fasteners or screws, we use the "Mortise and Tenon" joint (see illustration No. 1), and make

the tenons the full width of the materials used and at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch long—this gives ample surface for holding the glue; we know that these joints cannot shrink and work loose after hard service—they cost considerably more to make than the "dowel" joint (see illustration No. 2), which we DO NOT USE, but they are well worth the extra cost in the satisfaction of knowing that we have not "skipped" in our construction details.

Note the small surface afforded by the "dowel" joint, which has only the strength of the pins shown, yet the dowel joint is used in nine-tenths of the furniture made by other manufacturers.

Until furniture has been used for a year or more, you may not appreciate just what it means to the life of a piece to have not only the best materials used, but to have all joints perfectly made and of sufficient strength to stand constant and hard service, and possibly some abuse, without necessitating a trip to the furniture hospital.

Whenever necessary, we send liquid glue to spread on the tenons before inserting them in the mortises—we use the best quality of glue and know that the joint will be perfect and give lasting satisfaction to the user. In all other parts of the construction, we use just as great care as in making the mortise and tenon joints.

Materials—The quality of our workmanship and materials is undisputed—our immense business is built on the only foundation that will stand the test of time and service and that is QUALITY. There can never be any permanent economy in buying inferior quality, no matter how low the price and we have never made an effort to attract orders purely on the question of price. We emphasize first, "QUALITY" and then the saving that can be made by buying direct from our factory with all the useless expenses and profits of the ordinary way of doing business eliminated. Unscrupulous salesmen and others will attempt to deceive you by glossing over the real quality of the materials offered, they will say that their furniture is made of "solid oak" (which is a clever subterfuge and really means nothing at all, so far as furniture quality is concerned). Quarter-sawn white oak is used only in the best of the high grade furniture. Plain-sawn oak, or a mixture of plain red and white oak is an advertisement of its own inferiority. The difference of fifty per cent in the cost of the raw materials does not represent the real difference in the appearance of the completed furniture. You have a right to know the quality of the goods you buy and we specifically say in all of our advertisements and printed matter that we use quarter-sawn white oak and we do not attempt any deception, nor play on your possible lack of information as to quality by saying that our furniture is made of "solid oak." The small illustrations in the catalog cannot bring out all the richness of the actual wood, the mellow softness and lustre that is imparted to the grain and flake by the stains and wax finish. In shipping our goods out unstained, we cannot substitute red oak or other inferior materials, or patch up defects as can be done when the furniture is finished, colored and varnished and sold to you under an artificial light in a store. No other wood is just "as good" as quarter-sawn white oak for our styles of furniture.


On account of our method of shipping furniture in sections we make use of a laminated five-ply top for some of our tables, each top being made up of five thicknesses wood with grain of each layer running in a different direction. These tops cost considerably more than solid tops but we know they will never warp or get out of shape.

The mirrors used with our furniture are the best quality heavy genuine French bevel plate and are free from imperfections of any kind.

Workmanship—In order to back up our guarantee to the letter, it is needless to state that the best machines procurable and intelligent men to run them are essential parts of our equipment and organization.

All machining, sanding, joiner work, fitting, etc., is done by skilled workmen and they have at their service the best machinery obtainable.

Our Selling Plan



OUR SELLING PLAN—Sectional Furniture, direct from Factory to User, means **ECONOMY** in manufacturing, selling, shipping and finishing. Our whole effort is directed towards producing and marketing the highest grade of Furniture for the least money. The continuous patronage of our customers is the life blood of our business. We aim to conduct our business so that every purchaser becomes a permanent customer and an effective and willing advertiser of our goods. Study the diagram and our selling plan above.

Stains—We have found it impossible to reproduce in a color photograph, all the soft, lustrous tones which are imparted to the quartered white oak by our oil stains, and therefore suggest that you ask us for samples of the actual colors (we will gladly mail them to you together with actual samples of our cushion coverings). The samples will show you actual colors of our stains and the color and grade of the cushion materials. We furnish the following spirit stains: dark weathered (a brownish black), Early English (a greenish black), Flemish (black or brown, as ordered) Green Weathered (a pronounced green), Nut Brown, (a pronounced tobacco brown), Fumed (a medium brown), Golden Oak (light golden brown), English Oak (a reddish brown). When ordered "in the white" a sufficient quantity of stain will be sent with each order to complete the piece, together with sufficient furniture wax to form a hard, permanent and satisfactory outer finish, in fact the finish will be identical with the best of the completed furniture. However, all furniture will be shipped completely finished unless you plainly specify "unstained" or "in the white."

Cushions and Cushion Materials—The price of each piece includes, where necessary, complete "pillow" cushions as shown in the different illustrations, covered with the best grade of "Imperial Leather." We furnish the pillow cushions in response to an almost universal demand for that particular style, although we will, on request, furnish the spring box cushions at the same price. The seat cushions and back pillows will be stuffed with thoroughly cleaned and sanitary cotton and of sufficient thickness to give the maximum of elasticity and comfort. The seat cushions will not be made reversible unless specially ordered and at an extra cost. Prices quoted on application.

"Imperial" leather is a soft and durable substitute that is hardly to be distinguished from the genuine leathers. We especially recommend it as being preferable to any-

thing but the best grade of the genuine leathers. The Imperial leather will be furnished in red, brown, green or black and in all colors, except black, a choice is offered between the "Natural grain" (a fine figured effect with small irregular markings) or the "Spanish grain" (a large figured effect with large irregular markings). The black can be furnished only in a pebbled grain. The Imperial or Imitation leather samples may be distinguished from the cow hide from the fact that it has a cloth or sateen backing. We will be glad to send samples on request.

For the benefit of those who are not familiar with the different grades of leathers, we will say that every whole hide (cow hide) is split into three separate and distinct hides. The best hide, of course, is the outer, or grain hide, which we use exclusively. The "middle" and "flesh" splits are worked up into clever imitations of the outer hide, but they do not stand the test of time. These split leathers can be bought for the same price as the "Imperial" leathers, but we would not guarantee them to last six months in actual service.

The Cow Hides can be furnished in red, brown, green or black and in either the "smooth" or "Spanish" Grain. (See prices of Genuine Leather Covers under the description of each piece.)

The Genuine Morocco Roan Skins are an imported goat hide. They are soft, durable and guaranteed to wear for years. The Roan skins can be furnished in red, brown or green, but only in the pebbled grain.

The so-called Roan Skins that are usually sold to those who are not familiar with leathers, are nothing more or less than sheep skins. They will not wear well and we do not handle them. We use nothing but the best grade of "Imperial" leather, which we do guarantee to wear, and the best grade of Genuine Roan Skins and Cow Hides.

Our Selling Plan---Continued

When Ordering—Give the catalog number of each piece and state the color of stain, cushions, etc., desired; also specify whether furniture is to be "stained" or "in the white," also how much money is enclosed and in what form—post office money order, which you secure at the postoffice; express money order, which you secure at the express office; bank draft, which you secure at your bank, or send us personal check. We recommend the Post-office and Express orders as being perhaps, the safest and most convenient way to send money. Always register a letter that contains currency or stamps. Our order sheet is a convenience—not a necessity. Write all in a letter if you prefer.

New Designs—We originate our own designs and all furniture listed by us is made in our own factory. In designing a piece we keep in mind several points—it must have refinement of outline, utility, durability and correct proportions. It must be so designed that it can be put together easily and without the aid of clamps, wedges and the usual cabinet-maker's tools. The assembling of the sections must be made so simple that it will be IMPOSSIBLE for a person to put the sections together in any way but the right way. Nothing is left to guess work. We will send you cuts of new designs as we get them out.

Special Work—We do not do special work, or make alterations in our regular designs. We receive so many requests for special cushions, special designs in furniture, or requests for alterations of designs or dimensions that we find it necessary to particularly emphasize that we cannot make any exceptions to this rule.

How Goods are Shipped—Shipping by freight is usually the cheapest way to forward goods weighing over twenty pounds. The railroads have what is called a "minimum charge," which means the least amount of money they will haul a shipment for, no matter how little it weighs. The minimum charge is usually figured on the basis of one hundred pounds at either the first or second class rate. It is on account of the minimum charge that we recommend that your order be for one or more pieces weighing over 100 pounds. All shipments weighing over 100 pounds are charged for at actual weight.

Shipments by freight are safe and reliable, and the freight never amounts to much compared with the saving you make on every purchase. Remember that the Dealer has to pay four or five times as much freight on the completed furniture and the freight charges are always added to his selling prices.

The freight agent at your station will notify you when goods arrive and the freight charges are paid when you take the goods from the station. There is no difference in rates whether freight is paid here or at destination.

Prepaying Freight Charges—We do not prepay freight charges on our furniture for the reason that where a delivered price is made, the freight charges are always added to the selling price, and our prices would have to be raised to cover the freight charges all over the United States.

If there is no freight agent at your station, enclose enough money to prepay freight charges, or we will send the goods to the nearest station where there is an agent. (Send too much money rather than too little. We will immediately refund the difference).

Prompt Shipments—We aim to keep a large stock on hand at all times and make immediate shipment of all orders coming to us.

Delayed Shipments—If, for any reason we cannot make shipment of your order immediately, we will notify you to this effect, and either ship when the goods are ready to go forward or refund the money in full.

Tracing Shipments—Wait a reasonable length of time before requesting our Traffic Department to trace a shipment; give the goods time to reach destination. However, if a shipment is unreasonably delayed, we will spare no effort to trace the shipment for you and will consider it a favor to have you call on us for all the assistance necessary.

Damaged Goods—It is very seldom that goods packed by us reach destination in damaged condition; but, if they are damaged, in any way, see that the Freight Agent makes a notation on the freight bill that you pay, stating what the damage consists of, and you then have the basis for a claim for damages. Unless these facts are plainly written across the face of the freight receipt, you cannot enter a claim for damage or shortage. We will not be responsible for glass, or other parts, broken or damaged while in transit, unless the paid freight bill is sent to us with the Agent's notation showing the nature of the damage, or if this cannot be obtained, an affidavit sworn to before a Notary, as to the nature of the damage, will be accepted in its stead, both by us and the Railroad Companies when filing a claim.

City Delivery—May be simplified by mentioning in your order the name of some local cartage, drayage or transfer company. We will then ship to you in care of that company and they will deliver the furniture immediately upon arrival and collect from you for freight charge (if not prepaid), and their small charge for cartage from the depot to your home.

Goods to be Returned—We will give full shipping instructions on all goods that are to be returned to us for any reason whatsoever. **DO NOT RETURN GOODS WITHOUT FIRST COMMUNICATING WITH US**, as we can frequently adjust matters satisfactorily to you without the delay of returning them. Always see that your name and address are plainly written or stamped on packages which are to be returned to us.

Claims—Our Claim Department will, if desired, enter all claims for lost or damaged goods, when the freight receipt (expense bill) is returned to us with proper notation on same, showing the goods to have been damaged in transit. All money paid on claim will be immediately returned to you.

Flanders, Bungalow and Mission Designs—The enormous popularity enjoyed by the purely Mission furniture, with its severely plain lines, has given rise to a steadily increasing demand for furniture of the same sturdy construction but with some ornamentation to relieve its severity without detracting from its quiet dignity, symmetry and perfect proportions. The modern Flemish Renaissance or "Flanders" designs (now quite commonly called "Bungalow" Furniture) with its bulbous turnings, cleverly balanced with plain surfaces satisfies these requirements, but there is nothing over-ornate to offend good taste and a combination of the Flanders and Mission may be used indiscriminately in the same room.

Piano Player Action

Our piano player actions are mechanically perfect, the mechanism is "built-in" and a few simple movements will convert either of our pianos into a piano player. The controlling devices afford a wide latitude of interpretation and responsiveness, only equalled by the most expensive player actions, and the untrained music lover has at his command the whole range of music from the popular ballad to the serious works of the Masters. The piano player is a perpetual delight to the whole household, and an appreciation of music may be attained in a short space of time that would otherwise require years of attendance at the opera or concert hall.

The player mechanism requires no sacrifice of the tone quality or appearance of the regulation piano, and when not in use as a player the piano gives little hint of its dual role. The player may be installed in any one of our pianos at the prices shown under the description of the pianos.

SUCTION CLEANING

The merits of suction cleaning as against the drudgery of the unsanitary broom hardly calls for argument—every one acknowledges the desirability and unquestioned cleaning power of an efficient suction cleaner. The whole "milk of the cocoanut" is summed up in the one word "efficient." There are various types of cleaners on the market, some of unquestioned merit and multitudes of others that are made, designed and intended solely to "sell" and without sufficient power to do the actual work that is required of a cleaner.

To do efficient work a cleaner must displace a certain volume of air and do it under service conditions in a certain length of time. Ordinarily speaking a cleaner should be able to displace 32 cubic feet of air per minute when the cleaning tool is held against a heavy fabric like a close woven rug or carpet. Our cleaner will displace 45 to 50 feet of air per minute and do it under the most severe tests, not merely for a short space of time, but the machine is built to do this work regularly, hour after hour and day after day.

Hand operated machines and machines that are designed to be moved from room to room are simply out of the question—the first type is clearly impractical to operate successfully and the second type rarely has sufficient power to do the work required, and if by any chance the motive power and pump or fan should be of sufficient power to do the work, imagine a woman trying to carry the equipment about from room to room or attempting to carry it up and down stairs.

The logical equipment is one that has sufficient power to do work required, and this means that the equipment must be more than a toy—it should be placed where most convenient, in the basement or cellar, and a pipe should run from the machine to the different floors of the house, and a light suction hose may be carried from floor to floor by a child, and the different rooms absolutely renovated. This does not mean merely to take up the surface dirt like a carpet sweeper but to draw the air in large volumes through the carpet or fabric being cleaned, and the dirt deposited in the dust separator of the machine in the basement or cellar. The pipes may be put in an old house as easily as one in process of construction. They may be put in your own house or in a rented house and removed again without injury to the property.

Our equipment consists of: 1st—A light weight but powerful motor rated at one-half horse power, but capable of carrying a fifty per cent overload without injury during constant service (1750 R. P. M.)

Illustration "G" 439 shows the complete electrical equipment, motor, rotary pump, relief valve, belt between motor and pump and the dust separator box.

2nd—Our pump is a positively rotary frictionless vacuum pump of the type that is used in foundries and forges where high pressure or suction is required. It is powerful, efficient, reliable and built for service. It is not a toy or delicate piece of mechanism that will get out of order easily.

Illustration "B" shows a cross section of the equipment and the interior parts of the positive rotary pump, showing both the gear connections and the frictionless action of the pump itself.

3rd—The other part of the equipment shown in illustration is the dust collector or separating device. It is a large enclosed bag made of specially woven canvas and attached to a galvanized shell inside of the separator box. The bag is so large that it will need emptying but once every three or four weeks. All air before passing through the pump is thoroughly cleaned and free from dust, insuring long life to the pump. Our machine gets all the dust quickly and without endless labor to the operator. It requires volume and tension to do this and the right pump and strong enough motor to develop such volume and tension. It is built for people who want a real cleaner and who can tell the difference between such a one and the ones that are merely to sell.

Our suction regulator situated above the pump renders possible the cleaning of the finest fabrics as well as the heaviest carpets by the mere turning of a screw to regulate the tension of a spring. We call especial attention to this device as it is found in no other cleaner that we know of.

Installation—Illustration "C" on opposite page shows one method of installing the equipment. This shows the cleaner with concealed "house" pipe between the walls. In an old house where an equipment is to be installed, the house pipe is run up through the floors in an inconspicuous corner, near the steam pipes, or if ordered it may be run through clothes closets or clothes chutes. The work and cost of installation, including cost of pipes and connections, should not exceed ten to twelve dollars at the outside.

(Drain pipe connections should always be used with suction cleaning apparatus so that there will be no projecting lip or obstruction to the free passage of the dust or other particles taken up from the carpets.)

Illustration "A" shows the 9 inch carpet tool, 3 inch upholstery tool, button tool or nipple and a slip nipple for connecting the suction hose to the house pipe.

The power equipment is placed in the basement or cellar. No special foundation required, as the plant is complete in itself. One single 1½ inch pipe runs from a point near the machine up to the floors above. Only a single straight pipe is required and no skill is necessary to install the outfit. We furnish absolutely every part, fastening and fitting except the pipe and tees running from floor to floor. It should not cost to exceed ten or fifteen dollars to equip a two or three story home with the necessary piping, and including the labor of putting the pipes in.

Motor—We furnish either direct or alternating current motor (your local electric lighting company will advise you the voltage of the current and the number of cycles, if an alternating current is used), no starting box required. The pump may be used as a suction device or the operation may be reversed and a powerful blast of air blown through the house by attaching the discharge blower to pump. The cost of operating the motor should not exceed fifteen cents on a ten hour run. The belt may be slipped from the motor and pump, and the motor used as power to operate household machinery, such as washing machines, wringer, mangle, lathe, etc. This feature alone is well worth your consideration.

Equipment—All necessary fittings for installing the outfit and one carpet tool, one upholstery tool, one button tool, 25 feet of wire inserted suction hose and six feet of hose to connect the 1½ inch pipe with the dust separator are included with the equipment. Extra suction hose furnished at 25c per foot.





Export Orders—Come-Packt furniture is specially adapted for export shipment and receives expert attention in our Foreign Department. Freight rates given to all points upon application. An extra charge of 5 per cent is made to cover packing charges on all export shipments routed via steamer. This does not apply to all rail shipments to Canada or Mexico.

Freight Rates—The above rates per Hundred Pounds apply on our Sectional Furniture from Ann Arbor, Mich., and Toledo O. to points named. If your own city is not in the table, take the freight rate to the nearest point named and multiply it by the shipping weight (given under the description of each piece,) and the result will be the approximate charge to your station.

The minimum freight charge is the least amount that railroads accept for transporting freight to a given point regardless of its weight or classification. (See minimum charge column in rate table.)

The list in opposite column gives the classification of the different articles we are listing. For instance, if you live in Mobile, Ala., and you wish to get the freight charges on a davenport to your city, the shipping weight will be found under the description of the piece, and by looking down the classification list you will see that the davenports go under class "F", and in the freight rate table class "F" takes a rate of \$1.16 per hundred pounds. In other words, if the shipping weight was 200 pounds, the total freight charge would be \$2.32.

By referring to the group or classification letter, and the corresponding letter in the freight rate table, the rate may be obtained to various shipping points.

These freight rates were in effect on the date this catalogue was published (January 1st, 1912,) and are subject to change by the Transportation Companies without notice. All delivered prices are quoted for immediate acceptance only.



Stains and Cushion Materials

The plates on the reverse side of this page (specimens are one-half actual size) reproduce the colors of our Stains and Cushion Materials as faithfully as is possible by color photography. We will, however, gladly furnish actual specimens of our cushion materials and the finished wood on request.

COME-PACKT stains are deep penetrating, quick drying spirit stains that produce a *brilliant, permanent color* that *will not fade, wear off, or raise the grain of the wood*. The shellac and wax finish are applied over the stain, giving a lustrous beauty and depth to the satiny finish that can be produced in no other way. Our method of finishing enhances the beauty and brings to full life the exquisite markings of the *Quartered White Oak* used in Come-Packt Furniture.

There is no difference in price whether the furniture is shipped "*in the white*" or *completely finished*. All goods will be shipped in the completed sections *and finished* ready for assembling unless your order plainly states "*do not finish*." Specify carefully the color of stain wanted and the kind and color of cushion materials for upholstered pieces; otherwise *dark weathered* stain and *brown* cushions will be furnished. When goods are ordered "in the white" sufficient stain and finishing materials will be included with the shipment to complete the pieces.

In selecting cushion materials and stains, individual preference and home surroundings, color of walls, floor coverings and interior woodwork should decide the issue in each case. There is no choice as regards permanency of color or excellence of finish.

The *Roan* skins are imported goat hides, remarkably soft and flexible, and are tanned and dyed in beautifully brilliant colors. These skins are furnished in the "*pebbled grain*" only.

Our *Cow-hides* are the best quality of leather obtainable, commercially known as the *outside* or *grain* hides. We use only these *grain* hides wherever our catalog specifies *Genuine Leather*, in both the "*Smooth*" and the "*Spanish Grains*."


NOTE: The "middle" and "flesh" splits, which we never use, are worked up into clever imitations of the outside grain hides, and when new can hardly be distinguished from them, except by an expert. These inner "splits" do not have the fibre or toughness to withstand continual usage and in a short time become shabby in appearance and unfit for use. They cost more than a good grade of imitation leather, but are inferior to it both in appearance and in wearing qualities.

Our *Imperial leathers* are the best and most carefully made imitation leather on the market. The backing is a heavy sateen and the surface coating is hand buffed. This Imperial leather is far superior to anything except the genuine grain leathers which we use, and as we have stated, is much better than the inside split leathers, which cost more money but do not give the service. We guarantee our Imperial leather, not only to be satisfactory in point of service, but in appearance as well. We offer a choice between the large markings or "Spanish grain" and the small or "Natural grain," and there are a number of colors shown.


