To all to whom these Presents shall come, know ye,

I, E. M. Pease, GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid, by virtue of the power vested in me by LAW, and in accordance with the LAWS of said STATE, in such case made and provided, do, by these presents, GRANT to the Heirs of Wm G. Logan, assigns of Jesus Gomez, their heirs or assigns, FOREVER, Three million two hundred and thirty-five thousand four hundred & three sq. varas of LAND, situated and described as follows:

Heirs of Wm G. Logan, decd assigns of Jesus Gomez, 3,235,403 sq. vs.

In Nacogdoches and Shelby Counties, about 19 miles N. 45° E. from the town of Nacogdoches, by virtue of Headright Certificate No. 464, issued by the Board of Land Commissioners of Nacogdoches County, on the 22^d day of March 1838, to W. G. Logan as assignee of the said Jesus Gomez:-- Beginning at the S. corner of a 1/3 league survey made for Bryant Humphrey, a stake, from which a red oak bears S. 83 1/2° E. 7 varas, a hickory 6 in. dia. bs. N. 34 1/2° W. 2 varas. Thence North 70° E. 1315 vs. the N. corner of A. Taylor's survey, a hickory, - bearings an ash and maple mkd A T. Thence South 20° W. 900 varas a red elm and black gum, mkd A T. Thence South 70° E. 1110 vs. Wm Blackburn's S. E. corner. Thence South 10° W. 781 varas the N. E. corner of C. Branch, and N. W. corner of M. Caro. Thence West, 790 vs. Branches N. W. corner, a sweet gum 10 in. dia, mkd x. Thence South, 906 varas along the Atoyac Bayou to a stake, from which a holly 10 in. dia. bears N. 66° W. 5 varas and a Lind bears S. 42° W. 8 vs. Thence West, at 1394 varas the S. E. corner of Wm C. Coshur's survey, a stake, a pine bears N. 73° W. 1 1/10 varas, a post oak bs. N. 31° E. 5 varas. Thence North, 940 varas the N. E. corner of J. C. Pearce's survey, a stake, a red oak bs. S. 53° W. 5 vs, another bears N. 67 1/2° W. 3 varas. Thence East, 804 varas a stake, a sweet gum bs. N. 18° E. 11 varas, and an overcup oak bears E. 12.4 vs. Thence North, 1510 varas Pearce's N. E. corner, a hickory bs. N. 72° W. 6 vs, a white oak bs. S. 65° W. 5 varas. Thence West, 456 varas to the place of beginning.
