To the President:

The new amalgamated paper under title of "The Woman Citizen" is now an established institution. Its chief weakness as you will agree is the lack of State news. There will be none from your State unless it is furnished. I suggest that your Press Chairman be urged either to send in news from your State with regularity or that some one else be appointed to do so. A state association which doesn't create news is asleep or dead and a state association which doesn't report the news it creates minifies its own importance in the eyes of the world at large and even in the estimate of its own workers. Is it not so?

It is intended to make The Woman Citizen a fighting organ of a fighting army inspired by the certain knowledge that victory is ahead. Help furnish the spirit of victory by your activities and the news of them.

Help get the Citizen into the hands of every suffragist in your State active or inactive. If the paper is full of inspiration its readers will imbibe some of it and be lifted to new desire for service. Therefore it is to the benefit of the work in your state (1) that every suffragist have the Citizen in hand (2) that it be full of the records of big things doing, great unconquerable armies of women moving onward towards their goal (3) that among the spirited things being done are many in your State.
