J. G. PRATT NAMED TO THE POSITION  
OF ANACORTES REFINERY MANAGER

J. G. Pratt, on special assignment in Head Office and recently Superintendent Houston Refinery, has been named to the position of Manager Anacortes Refinery, to replace Mr. R. C. Barton, who will retire April 1, announced Mr. H. E. Walker, Vice President Manufacturing, on March 19.

John received a B.S. degree in chemical engineering from Tulane University. He joined Shell in 1946 as a Jr. Technologist at Norco Refinery and transferred to Houston Refinery in 1947, becoming Assistant Manager Lubricating Oils in 1950. In 1955 he transferred to Head Office as a Sr. Technologist. After a one-year assignment with a Royal Dutch/Shell Group Company in The Hague, he was named Manager Aromatics at the Wood River Refinery, becoming Process Superintendent in 1960 and Chief Technologist in 1961. After a year as Manager Oil Research and Development with Shell Development Company, Emeryville, he joined Shell Chemical in Head Office in the Plastics and Resins Division. He was named Assistant to the General Manager Refineries in 1966 and became Refinery Superintendent-Expansion at Houston in 1967, and Refinery Superintendent in 1968. Earlier this year he was placed on special assignment in Head Office.
