My Dear Mrs. Guerard:

Doubtless you think I am remiss in not earlier answering your letter of September eleventh, but as usual I am just returned to the office from a strenuous time in the field, and even now I may be too late to get this letter to you in San Antonio as you may have removed from there; you did not say what your permanent plans were. If still in the Alamo City, do go out and call on our Honorary President, Miss Brackenridge; I know she would be delighted to see you, and, as she is both elderly and frail, being over eighty years of age, would probably not be able to go call on you. But she is always so glad to meet the Suffragists from over the state who visit San Antonio. The other officers of the organization there, I believe have been away most of the summer. It is a very discouraging condition that confronts us in most of our leagues because we insist on electing our officers from among the class of women who are financially able to go away during the summer and who regularly refuse to make the sacrifice of staying and devoting that time and money to the cause. It is a matter that yearly depresses me because we no sooner get a campaign well under way than I begin receiving letters announcing immediate departures for the east or west, or perhaps the north, and many stating that because of the necessary sewing and other preliminaries of the trip, they must fail to carry out their share of this campaign; and when they return in October, of course there is a month or six weeks at least of settling down and starting up; and then Christmas; so we really hardly get under way before January; and then the exodus in May. Small wonder we have not yet gotten Suffrage in Texas and that it will be by way of the Federal Amendment that we do get it. But Heaven send that this Federal Amendment come soon or some of us who do work the summers through will not have strength enough left to cast our first ballot. However, I do look forward with great hope to have the Federal Amendment passed the first of our next year, and toward that end I mean to brace up and beg, and implore, and entreat the heads of our various leagues to do their level best work this fall.

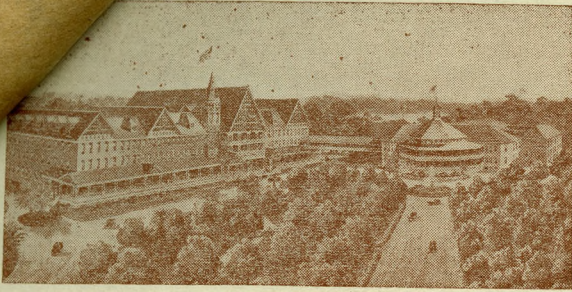

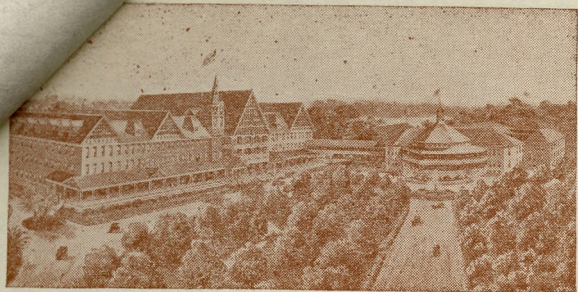
