Heavy Ends claim SCORA basketball crown

The Heavy Ends won the 1982 SCORA Basketball Tournament with a close 52-47 victory over the league champion Jay Hawks last week in Pasadena.

The Heavy Ends, with an 8-2 record, found themselves the underdogs in the championship game against the undefeated Jay Hawks, who had finished atop the league standings with a perfect 9-0 record.

The Jay Hawks pushed their record to 10 straight with a semi-final victory over the Off-Specs, a game that sent them into the finals with confidence and momentum. The Heavy Ends edged the Roadrunners 36-32 in their semi-final to earn the right to face the league champs for the tournament crown.

The Jay Hawks jumped to an early 12-2 lead, but the Heavy Ends battled back and led at halftime 24-19. The Jay Hawks came out with a bang in the second half and led 31-29 with 10 minutes to go. But the Heavy Ends scored eight of the next 10 points and held on to end the Jay Hawks undefeated streak.

Will Cunningham of the Hawks was the game's high scorer with 14 points; J.W. Scott and J. Boudreaux added 10 apiece for the Jay Hawks. Sam Maller and Mark Parris each scored 12 for the winners, and coach Steve Markland added 10.

In the consolation game, the Roadrunners beat the Off-Specs 44-42 to clinch third place in the tournament.

Time running out to add new GLI benefits

Time is running out to sign up for the new options in the Supplemental Group Life Insurance (GLI) plans, including a new post-retirement benefit that provides lifetime coverage.

To introduce the changes in the plan, an open enrollment period is available now through April 12. During this time, you can increase your rate of participation in the supplemental plan without providing proof of good health, or join Supplemental GLI if you are just a member of the basic plan.

The plan also offers reduced premiums for Complex policy-holders who elect not to take the post-retirement benefit. The Supplemental GLI premium without the post-retirement benefit will be reduced from .8 percent of base pay to .65
