

Dec. 12, 1962

The meeting was called to order by speaker Charles La Monte. The Invocation was given by George Harris. The minutes were read and approved as read.

Committee Reports

Certification and Installation - Barri Bodden: She read three new members names and they were sworn in.

Old Business

There was a motion made to table all old business. It failed 12 to 45.

House bill No. 8 was read for the second time by George Harris and there was a motion by Miss Ham Ann to table it. It passed 41 to 14.

House bill No. 9 was read for the second time by W. E. Harris. It passed 44 to 10.

Speaker Charles La Monte then reread the by-laws on the letters of intent for conventions. He advised everyone to get them in immediately.

New Business

Lewis Berry - Law School then made the following motion:

That the first order of business following the normal committee reports and following a report on the financial situation of Student Government by the treasurer of the Student Body if available, be the consideration of a Student Government Budget. And that the House of Representatives shall, at that time, constitute itself a committee of the whole in order to conduct inquiry into this matter.

In order to facilitate the House members in their consideration of this matter, the Speaker shall supply copies of the budget passed by last years House of Representatives and Senate, to each member of the House of Representatives.

The motion passed 56 to 1.

Bobby Bills read House Bill No. 10 for the first time.

Since there was no further new business, Bo E Evans made a motion to adjourn and it was seconded and passed.
