The undersigned contractor with office at Houston, Texas, having carefully examined the plans and specifications for your Negro Hospital Building, all as prepared by Maurice J. Sullivan, Architect, and having visited and examined the site, herewith proposes to do all the work called for on the plans and in the specifications for the sum of \$ 52,300.

ALTERNATES

- A. If composition floors are used where indicated add to any bid \$ 1850.
- B. If Terrazzo floors are used where indicated add \$ 1000.
- C. If Black Bangor #1 Clear slate 20" to 24" long by random width with gal. iron nails are used in place of tile deduct \$ 350.
- D. If 6" x 12" hollow tile is used in place of interlocking tile, layed flat-ways deduct \$ 100.

I do not include cost of surety bond.

I do not include any gravel road work except drives and walks on the hospital property.

If awarded the contract, I agree to complete the same in 90 calendar days.
