

I James Cronican do solemnly swear that I will faithfully and impartially discharge and perform all the duties incumbent on me as Assessor and Collector of Taxes in and for the County of Galveston, according to the best of my skill and ability, agreeably to the Constitution and Laws of the United States, and of this State And I do further solemnly swear that since the adoption of this Constitution by the Congress of the United States, I being a citizen of this State, have not fought a duel with deadly weapons within this State, or out of it; nor have I sent or accepted a challenge to fight a duel with deadly weapons; nor have I acted as second in carrying a challenge, or aided, advised or assisted any person thus offending - so help me God
