- 4 Meyerland Plaza and Target** - Starts at Cullen Blvd @ University of Houston D Route 068 - Brays Bayou/Fonmeadow/Via Meyerland - Westbound. Arrives at Meyerland Plaza. 57 minute trip.
- 5 Rice Village** - Starts at Cullen Blvd @ University of Houston E Route 068 - Brays Bayou/Fonmeadow/Via Meyerland - Westbound. Arrives at Kirby and Holcombe.
- 6 Toyota Center** - Starts at Wheeler St. @ Cullen Blvd Route F 080 Lyons/Via Waco/Via Kelley - Northbound. Arrives at Bell St. & LaBranch St. 17 minute trip.
- 7 Walmart** - Starts at Cullen Blvd @ Elgin St. G Route 088 - Hobby Airport - Southbound. Arrives at Almeda Shopping Center. 45 minute trip.



- 15 Montrose** - Starts Cullen Blvd @ University of Houston O Route 042 - Holman/Montrose/Eastwood TC Westbound. Arrives at Westheimer Rd @ Montrose.
- 16 Museum of Fine Arts** - Starts at Calhoun Rd. @ Wheeler P Route 077 - Liberty/Martin Luther King. Transfer at Downtown TC to 700 - METRORail - Fannin South. Arrives at Museum District STN SB. 25 minute trip.
- 17 Reliant Center** - Starts at Cullen Blvd @ University of Houston Q Route 068 - Brays Bayou/Fonmeadow/Via Meyerland - Westbound. Transfer at the Texas Medical Center Transit Center to Route 700 METRORail - Fannin South. Arrives at Fannin South STN NB. 41 minute trip.
- 18 Wortham Center** - Starts at Cullen Blvd @ Wheeler St. R Route 030 - Clinton/Denver Harbor Northbound. Transfer at St. Joseph Pkwy @ San Jacinto St. to 088 - Downtown - St. Joseph Pkwy @ San Jacinto St. - Arrives at Preston St. @ Smith St. (MB). 26 minute trip.
- 19 Minute Maid Park** - Starts at Cullen Blvd @ Wheeler St. S Route 030 - Clinton/Denver Harbor Northbound. Arrives at Franklin St. @ Chenevert St. 27 minute trip.

- 20 George Bush Intercontinental Airport** - Starts at Calhoun Rd. @ Wheeler T Route 077 - Liberty/Martin Luther King. Transfer at the Downtown Transit Center to Route 102 - Bush IAH Limited/Wright Road/Via Terminal C - Outbound. Arrives at Bush IAH Terminal C WS.

If you live in the suburbs of the Houston metropolitan area and would like to be a green commuter, the METRO routes on this map show you how to commute by public transportation to the University of Houston. These METRO routes arrive at either the Downtown or Eastwood Transit Centers and require only one transfer prior to arrival at the University of Houston.

To get to UH from the Downtown Transit Center, take any of these routes:

- Route 30 - Clinton/Cullen
- Route 52 - Scott/Hirsch
- Route 77 - Liberty/MLK
- Route 80 - Dowling/Lyons

To get to UH from the Eastwood Transit Center, take any of these routes:

- Route 77 - Liberty/MLK
- UH Cougar Line Tan Route

UH students receive half-price fares when using the METRO student Q Card. To obtain your student Q Card or re-load your full-fare or student Q Card, please visit Parking and Transportation Services in the Welcome Center at the University of Houston. METRO service to and from campus is available throughout the day and even after evening classes. 
