Acknowledging yours of November 5th, I note the results of your conference with the Mayor.

As to your "THIRD", it was (as indicated in my letter of November 12, 1924) my understanding that estimate would include beds and linen. I now feel that dining room, kitchen and porch furniture should be added but nothing in the way of hospital equipment or supplies. It was my further understanding from Dr. Slaughter that practically all of the above was available in storage and could be acquired at a nominal price.

If the estimate submitted by Mr. Sullivan does not include the above, after conferring with Dr. Slaughter he should prepare a separate estimate covering this.
