Dear Sir:

In viewing the print of the grounds
just submitted by Mr. Bringhurst, I note the
following:

Main Building	57.1
School of Nursing	56.05
Utility Building	53.6

As this print shows sidewalk elevation
at southwest corner at 52.6, I am wondering if
the floor level of the Utility Building is not
too low and if it would not be better to raise
such by filling to 53.5, or at least to 53.0,
to take care of a possible flood, that section
of the City as we know being comparatively flat
and as we further know, water covering the
floor of the Utility Building would not only
be very objectionable but might cause consider-
able damage and annoyance.

Please give this your consideration
before the work proceeds, advising Mr. Bringhurst
of your conclusions.
