On this Twenty fifth day of Sep-
tember in the year of our Lord
One thousand eight hundred
and thirty five before me Philip-
A. Hubbert, Primary Judge in the
second instance of the Municipi-
ality of San-Augustine on account
of Augustus Hotchkiss being in-
terested, and three instrumental
witnesses who were appointed for
that purpose besides the existing
witnesses with whom I officiate
for want of a Notary public
according to law—personally—
Came and appeared before me
Augustus Hotchkiss and Elizabeth
= Groce both of the Municipality
of San-Augustine and the afo-
resaid Groce declared that for
and in consideration of the sum
of one hundred and twenty
dollars, cash in hand paid,
the receipt whereof is hereby—

acknowledged renouncing the
Exceptions of iron numera pecunia
She has bargained, sold and
delivered and does by these
presents bargain, sell and deli-
ver, a certain tract or parcel
of land lying and being sit-
uated in Burness Grant on
the waters of the river Stiches
Eleven or twelve miles from the
Kickapoo Village - it being the
South half of a League of
land which the said Elizabeth-
Grove obtained a Title to from
the Commissioner George Anty =
Struon on the eighth day of July
of this present Year, a Duplicate
copy of which is prefixed to
this sale for greater surety unto
Augustus Hatchkins of the said
Municipality of San-Augustin
and his heirs and assigns.
