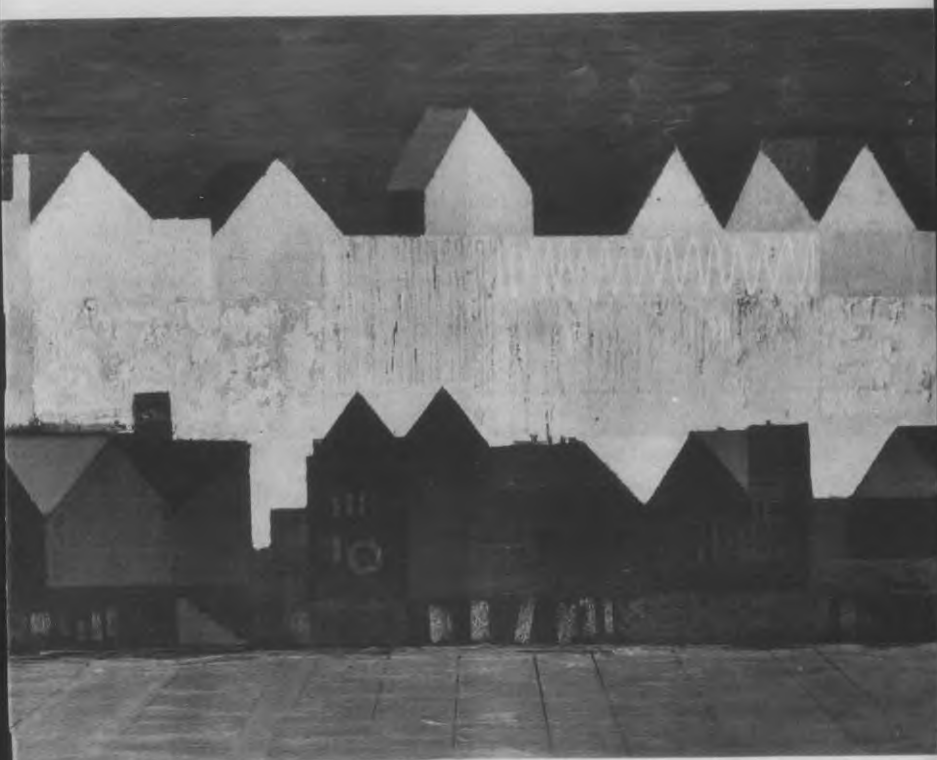

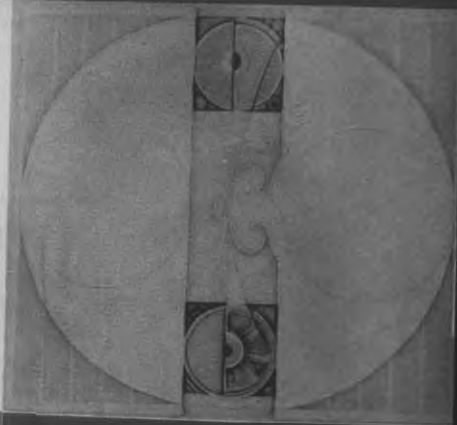

Mary McIntyre

Artist Has One-Man Show at TRACOR

A one-man show of recent paintings by Austin artist Mary McIntyre is currently on exhibit in the Executive Office Building of TRACOR, Inc., 6500 Tracor Lane.

Mrs. McIntyre, wife of Dr. Francis McIntyre, local physician, is a cum laude graduate of Radcliffe College, where she majored in history of art. She also studied with Cape Cod portrait painter Jerry Farnsworth at Maine's Skowhegan School of Painting, with Max Beckman and Robert Hale in New York, and with William Lester, Loren Mozley, and Kenneth Fiske at The University of Texas.

Galleries now handling her work include Townley Gallery, Austin; Wilds and Cannon Design, Houston; and Oxford House, Longview. Her paintings have been exhibited in numerous shows in Indiana and Texas.

The paintings currently on exhibit at TRACOR were done during the last three years, Mrs. McIntyre says.

"I'm interested, especially, in color — in making color stronger than life, but in forcing it to be believable," she points out. "For example, I want to represent depth in a picture with the most brilliant possible colors — without graying the colors — and still have it express floor, wall, or space. The pictures convey, I hope, a feeling of fantasy based on realistic scenes."

Mrs. McIntyre says that the theme of her TRACOR paintings is, largely, "We live in a beautiful garden of our own choosing, but it is caged. The picture which most obviously expresses this is the one called 'The Letter,' in which a girl in a somewhat tense pose gazes at a birdcage. Is she choosing to enter a cage or does she

feel caged right now?" Nearly all the other pictures embody the same idea in some form.

"I have borrowed some color ideas from the Post-Impressionists, but these paintings are actually more brilliant than Impressionist paintings," Mrs. McIntyre adds.

The artist is Educational Director of the Laguna Gloria Art Museum and is in charge of the Museum Art School program there.

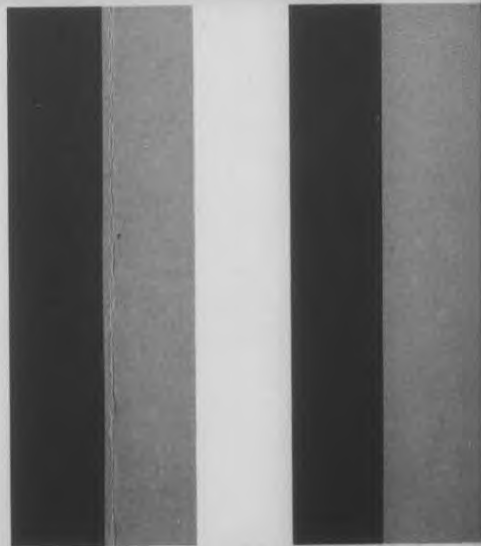

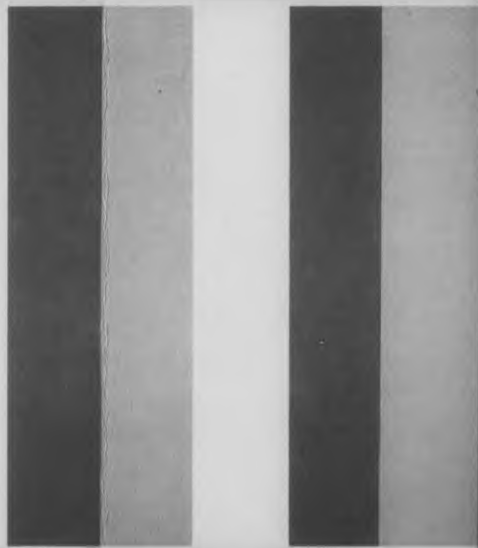

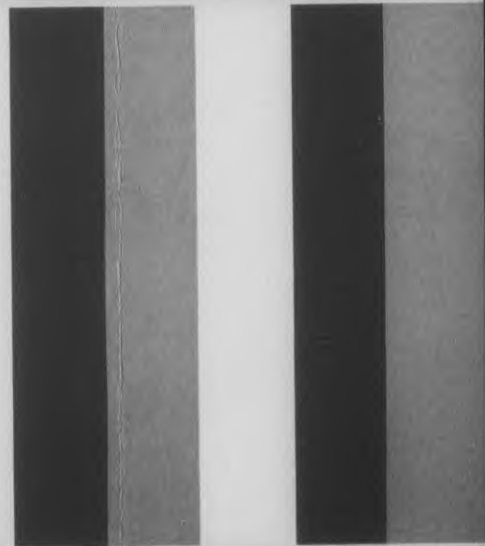
