Further referring to my letter of June 1st to Judge Moore, I think it would be desirable not only for present needs, but for future record to have photographs made of the above probably the day before the ceremonies and during the ceremonies as well. As to the former, it would seem desirable to have at least five views taken, that is one from each side of the building from a suitable distance to best bring out the architectural lines of the building, the fifth to be taken near the Negro School at the south end of the property. As to the second, I assume that a number of photographs will be taken from the front that would show the setting, speakers and the audience, etc.

After discussing this with Judge Moore, it may be thought desirable to talk it over with Mr. Maurice Sullivan, who should and no doubt will have definite ideas of values.
