The postponement of the meeting of the General Assembly of the United Nations from September until after the national election is generally recognized as a cheap trick to prevent the question of admission of Chinese Communists to that body from causing pre-election embarrassment to American delegates.

Officially the United States is on record as opposed to the admittance of the Chinese bandits into the U. N. but it is no secret that England, France and other countries whose friendship we have paid for but on which we have not received delivery, are putting the pressure on for recognition.

It is the general belief that when this pressure gets too strong, something will give and that "something" will probably be the United States delegation in the United Nations.

"Integrationists" Should Pause and Think This Over

On June 29th the United Press carried a story with a Lancaster, Pennsylvania, dateline which for sheer horror and revulsion tops any recent atrocity act by Negroes which are increasing rapidly since the Supreme Court decision on segregation.

An eight-year-old Negro boy kicked and beat a nine-year-old white girl to death in nearby Columbia, Pennsylvania. Before she died in a hospital the little girl said the Negro boy attacked her when she refused to give him a kiss.

Through the Supreme Court's decision knocking out the sedition laws of the several States, the only conclusion to be reached is that we are left in a position where the States can't prosecute Communists and the Federal government won't. That's tough on American patriots but pretty soft for the Commies.

The American people have become accustomed to having their money taken away from them and their rights and liberties confiscated, one by one, on demand of Social Planners who now exercise complete custody over human welfare. If these tax-ridden citizens figure, however, that every evil thing possible has already been done to them and that they will be called on to make no further contribution to the perfection of a One-World Utopian State, we have a surprise for them. Two thousand political psychiatrists and social psychologists, in solemn conclave assembled, have formulated a macabre program of such gruesome and ghastly proportions as to curl the hair of a Mohawk Indian. It is a plan for mass thought control which reveals that their next grim objective is to take over our minds, cleanse them of all preconceived ideas of right and wrong, debunk them of outmoded moral conceptions and — having mentally castrated us — to turn us back to society with completely remodeled and over-hauled cranial equipment guaranteed to insure our acceptance, without protest, of the One-World Government being prepared for us by the experts. If this sounds like a bad joke or a horror story from a lurid comic book, the reader had best not laugh or shrug it off until he has checked with the same source from which we got our material on the subject — the revered and highly esteemed United Nations World Health Organization located in the City of New York and supported largely by American dollars which the producers and workers of this country sweated to earn but which they were never permitted to hold in their little hot hands.

The average law-abiding, church-going and tax-paying American has become universally recognized as knowing—and caring—less about what is being done to him and to those who come after him, and to be more unconcerned over the manner in which his future destiny is being juggled by a species of vermin known as Social Planners, than any other member of the human race laying claim to citizenship status.

As placid, easy-going and gullible taxpayers have snored away their freedoms, their titles as freeholders of a glorious heritage and their exalted estate as masters of elected public officials, vicious interlopers have been active in reverse proportion to their apathy, inertia and neglect.

While they slumbered, Social Planners have elbowed their way into the three branches and all the various agencies of the American government where they largely dictate domestic and foreign policy and influence the squandering of untold billions of dollars on extraneous activities and projects having no semblance of relation to the functions of an orderly Constitutional government.

These human maggots work in relays around the clock boring away at the foundations of American institutions and it's regarded as an unprofitable and misspent day in their lives when they have failed to set in motion powerful forces whose ultimate objective is to uproot one more revered American custom, topple over additional cherished traditions or sink another shaft in the heart of human decency.

Least publicized but by far the most dangerous of this noxious breed are the political psychiatrists who have perverted the great art of mental healing by using their talents not to cure sick and ailing minds but in attempting to re-mold human personality to make it amenable to existence in a One-World Slave State.

The meeting of the International Commission on Mental Health at which this wide scale brain-washing program was initiated was held in London in 1948 but so thoroughly detailed and all-conclusive were the

Alaska Mental Health Bill Is Still Viewed With Suspicion

Possibly no legislation within recent years has caused so much commotion as the so-called Alaska mental health bill in Congress.

There have been charges, denials and counter-charges all of which succeeded in surrounding the measure with a lot of mysterious implications and suggestions of possible skulduggery on the part of its sponsors which no explanations seemed to dispel.

As for us, we have learned through long experience, as an observer of such things, that the surest way to evaluate legislation is to find out who introduced it and who backs its passage and, on this basis, the measure has been suspect from the first so far as we are concerned.

It passed the House without a record vote which, in itself, is bad business, and in the shape it was presented to the Senate, there is no doubt it was a measure that should have been killed on its face.

However, Senator Barry Goldwater publicly assured the American people that all the potentially dangerous features would be taken out in the Senate Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs which reassured many of those who had bitterly opposed the legislation.

The result was that Senator Goldwater re-wrote the bill eliminating the dangerous seizure and commitment features of the bill as it passed the House but authority to grant Alaska 1,000,000 acres of land was left in. Also the Alaska legislature was given authority to replace present Federal laws governing such matters by whatever legislation might be deemed proper.

The bill passed the Senate with only about fifteen senators present which was highly unethical in view of the extremely controversial nature of the legislation. There are 96 members of the Senate and at least a majority of them should have been present. A quorum call which would have delayed action until at least 49 of them were present, is reported to have been rescinded by Lyndon Johnson, Senate majority leader, with the

consent of his colleagues who were present. This is one way to pass legislation but it is a very unsavory way and reflects no credit on our elected lawmakers.

Now the Honorable Usher Burdick of North Dakota has had reproduced in the Congressional Record of June 11th a lengthy and highly interesting report prepared by George C. and Charles C. Finn, the famous Finn Twins, which presents an angle of the bill which is new and startling.

In carefully documented information and reproductions of official papers, they bring out that the granting of 1,000,000 acres of land for a project that would have required perhaps only 50 or 75 at most, is in line with an effort to turn over mineral-rich Alaska land to private parties much in the manner that the Teapot Dome was handled some years ago.

The Guardians of Our American Heritage, 1028 Connecticut Avenue, Washington, D.C., have reproduced a photostatic copy of this Finn document in the Congressional Record which may be had for ten cents per copy, 12 copies for one dollar or one hundred for five dollars. We suggest that every American who is concerned in the matter should get copies of it.

Meantime the bill is in Conference Committee composed of members of both the Senate and House who will attempt to reconcile the House and Senate bills. If this Committee changes the form and language of the bill, it must be sent back to the House and Senate for further consideration. If not, it will be sent to the President for approval.

Those who are not sure about it, or those who oppose it, should wire their Senators and representatives asking them to see that it is rejected. It will then be time enough to pass a measure, even if it must wait until next session, which is above suspicion.

It is far better that it be delayed than that it be adopted in the questionable form as passed both by the House and Senate.

State Officials Went Haywire On the Supreme Court Ruling

The only places in the South where we have integration is where local Reds have jumped the gun and used the Supreme Court decision of 1954 as an excuse for doing something they wanted to do any way.

The ruling had reference only to one school in Kansas, one school in South Carolina, one school in Virginia, one in Delaware and one in the District of Columbia.

The greatest mistake in connection with the whole rotten deal was when other State authorities took notice of it. They should have ignored it and several of them did, including Mississippi and Georgia and there is no integration there. They should have left it to those four States and the District of Columbia to fight back and these five should have fought it to a finish.

But, instead, fluttering and fidgety officials who had no understanding of the rights of the sovereign States sent officials to Washington to "plead" with the court when they were not even involved in the decision.

Texas, for instance, has a law against integration and the State Constitution also provides for separate schools and this law and the Constitutional provision are still in effect, as the Supreme Court does not happen to possess the authority to repeal them.

Every school in Texas whose officials ordered segregation is violating the law and the Constitution of this State by so doing. They should be prosecuted and would be if we still had government by law and officials who would enforce it.

fine points of the plan and so much preliminary organization work was necessary that it is only now that it is getting up steam. It is the way of Social Planners to act first in comparative secrecy and to correlate and integrate their plans so thoroughly and have them so far advanced that it is difficult, if not impossible, for them to be arrested when those who are potential victims of such social planning are let in on the deal.

Millions of tracts, pamphlets, brochures and books are flooding the United States now misleadingly designated as authentic data on mental health but much of it stems from the World Health Organization of the United Nations and the over-all plan for a One-World Government is stressed in each.

A program which has required the efforts of two thousand persons six years to complete and launch cannot be described in limited space and billions of words in documents embodying this diabolic and Satanic blueprint for universal thought control cannot be briefed for casual comprehension. We can only touch on a few of the points that were brought out at the London meeting by these fiends in human form who plan to tame and subdue the thought processes of such individualists as may stand in the way of the plan to level off the people of the United States and the world into one conglomerate mass of unified humanity.

Primarily "Mental Health" was impressed on the London meeting as being synonymous with One-World government and none of the psychiatrists' valuable time was wasted in considering treatment of individual cases. Only mass treatment of vast segments of people to induce a proper attitude toward the establishment of a totalitarian One-World State claimed the attention of these international brain-washers who urged the mobilization of every available social, economic and political agency in the campaign to mold and direct the thought processes of the people of all ages toward this end.

Delegates were assured that not only individuals but entire social systems may be changed and human thinking directed into desired channels by organized psychiatric effort led by those thoroughly trained in such mass alteration of the human mind. They were remembering, perhaps, that in the subjugation of the Satellite Countries by the Communists and the forcing of false confessions of guilt by hapless victims, political psychiatrists played a major role in preliminary mass brain-washing of the people.

Another interesting disclosure of the London conference was that average parents are totally unfit to raise their own children without aid and supervision by psychiatrists, social workers, school teachers and others who have been trained in directing human brains into proper channels of thinking. It was even predicted that the day is not far distant when parents will be compelled to follow prescribed rules in bringing up their offspring presumably in the manner of a farmer who follows Federal Department of Agriculture bulletins for the successful production of pigs.

In the brochure titled "Mental Health and World Citizenship" which embodies the proceedings and conclusions of the London conference, it is frankly pointed out that: "We are concerned with the attitudes of groups of men in relation to one another, and with the principles and practices of mental health in relation to a world community" and if that is not plain enough listen to this: "The ultimate goal of mental health is to help men live with their fellows in One World."

Neuroses and mental disorders were defined by these psychiatric screwballs as being expressed in patriotism and love for one's own country rather than in a type of world loyalty which recognizes no frontiers. Other evidence of mental illness was described as a strong feeling of Nationalism, race prejudice, respect for family and familiar traditions; in short any pattern of living that is based on recognized conceptions of decency in a civilized society marks one as a psychopathic case and a fit subject for the experts in mental rejuvenation. Only those holding a firm belief in complete racial mixing and agreeable to existence in a controlled slave state in which all persons look alike, act alike and think alike and are willing to perform merely as cogs in a vast universal machine may be given a clean bill of mental health in the viewpoint of these depraved and low-lived specimens of human depravity.

To achieve the frightening state of mental and moral degeneracy to which they aspire, these putrid brain prostitutes are asking concerted and cooperative action by all social, educational, religious, political and related agencies with an international viewpoint such as UNESCO, labor unions, International Labor Organization, State and national health departments, social workers, psychologists, school teachers and college professors, political and professional groups of liberal leanings and all others whose interests are world-wide and unrestricted by national boundaries or narrow concern for the survival of the countries of their birth, with psychiatrists, of course, leading and directing this mass movement toward mental, moral and physical slavery for the people of the United States and the world.

If this proposal were merely the wild-eyed suggestion of a few psychiatric perverts, there would be no particular cause for alarm because every age produces its quota of quacks, charlatans and crackpots offering panaceas for all the social, economic and political ills of humanity.

But this is a plan for the mass conquest of the minds of men approved and sponsored by the United Nations, a One-World organization of which the United States is a part, thanks to the stupidity of the United States Senate, thereby stamping it as an official program for making mental captives of the American people.

If this bold proposal of the forces of Satan does not arouse sleeping Americans to the danger inherent in the vile international institution which we call the United Nations, then perhaps the sooner we are taken over the better, and the quicker we will adjust to the status of human slavery which we will have stupidly brought on ourselves.

Communist Racial Agitation Reaches Down Into Florida

Florida, like all other States in the South, is having its share of trouble as a result of the Communist agitation which has been going on for years in regard to racial segregation and which reached full flower with the Supreme Court's Marxist-inspired decision on the subject.

In addition to the bus strike in Tallahassee which has resulted in discontinuance of service in certain sections of that city, Negroes flocked to the fashionable Del Ray Beach and demanded that they be permitted to swim in water formerly restricted to the use of white citizens of the area.

Carloads of black hoodlums armed with switch-blade knives were sent in there to add to the dangerous situation which finally became so bad that the beach was closed for a time. Finally it was re-opened on the same segregated basis as before and at last report was operating in that manner.

Responsible citizens of that State who tried hard to elect a governor at the last election who had full understanding of the Rights of the States and would have taken a firm hand in warding off the unfortunate situation which has arisen, blame the present violence on the lack of leadership in the State Capital at Tallahassee.

General Sumter L. Lowry, who had the backing of Conservative citizens of Florida in his recent campaign for Governor, was defeated by the incumbent, LeRoy Collins classed as the "darling of the Claude Pepper machine" and a dedicated New Dealer of the Pepper type.

Plans to hoist the American flag over a proposed new insurance building ran into an aesthetic snag in fashionable Coral Gables.

The board of supervisory architects reported to the city commission yesterday—with concurrence of the zoning board—that flying the flag over the projected one-story building would not fit in with surrounding architecture.

"We've just never had a flag on a one-story building," said Coral Gables Zoning Director H. Clay Anderson. He said "the right to fly a flag never entered into (the decision)."

Representatives of the Peninsular Life Insurance Co. said they would query their Jacksonville home office on whether an appeal would be made to the city commission. The commission took no action pending receipt of such an appeal.

According to information in the Washington Post and letters from subscribers there, we learn that swimming pools in the nation's capital which formerly were so crowded that they had to be operated on a shift basis, are now operating with less than a 33 per cent attendance. Government health statistics have frequently been released there by patriotic individuals and organizations and the danger of mixed racial bathing in pools is pretty well understood in Washington. The Only Commission We've Really Ever Needed Has Been Completely Overlooked

We wonder if it does not seem more than passing strange to thoughtful Americans that, although Communism and its encroachment on our institutions, is the most deadly menace to the peace and freedom of the United States which we have ever had to face, there is no official organized force to combat it.

What we mean is that not one of the last three Presidents of the United States, all of whom were noted for setting up new boards, commissions and bureaus has ever once taken any steps to set up a bonafide Commission composed of recognized non-political experts on World Communism and its methods of operation, to advise the American people and the various agencies of government, including the Armed Forces, of the devious ways by which these vermin insinuate themselves into the schools, churches, the government, State and National, and into all local groups where Americans are banded together in any form of human activity.

Incidentally, some way would have to be worked out to by-pass White House advisers in the matter of appointing members of the Commission or we'd get a Stassen, a Hoffman or a Sobeloff for sure.

How Mixed Up and Confused Can Billionaire Socialists Get?

The Ford Foundation granted \$400,000 and later \$1,000,000 to the University of Chicago to "advance human welfare" and especially to do research on "law and the behavioral sciences." If the reader does not know what this means, neither do we. Neither, for that matter, does the University of Illinois nor the Ford Foundation. It was merely an excuse to turn over a lot of tax-exempt money to a bunch of educated nuts in order that they might go browsing around in things that do not concern them.

Their first venture into "research on the behavioral sciences" was to rig up some kind of contraption so they could listen in on secret jury hearings which was and is a strict violation of law. As a result, the whole transaction was investigated by the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee of which Senator James O. Eastland is chairman. The "bugging" of the jury by these Chicago University screwballs has been fully investigated by the subcommittee and the Department of Justice, asked to take action against them.

"Today 1.5 millions of American troops are stationed in 900 places, in few of which they are secure, in none of which they are popular" — Dorothy Thompson.

In attempting to justify the whole silly and unwarranted proceedings, the Ford Foundation issued a statement saying that it was simply an attempt "to gain a factual basis for understanding the behavior of juries and their place in American legal structure."

Well, the place of juries in the American legal structure was pretty well defined in the American Constitution long before the Ford Foundation and its stable of subsidized college professors was ever heard of.

About the only thing that the Ford, Rockefeller and similar tax-exempt organizations are doing is to give stature to the Marxist claim that the possession of great wealth is an evil.

When we see daily how the Socialist descendants of Ford, Rockefeller and others are using the money that they had no hand in amassing, it almost makes us realize that old Lenin and Engels had something when they implied that wealth should be taken out of the hands of those who do not know how to use it.

According to the Religious News-weekly put out by the National Council of Churches' Public Relations Department on May 14, 1400 men and women from all walks of life "will gather for one week in six different Ashrams during July and August in different parts of the country".

We hope others don't make the mistake we did when we first glanced at it. We thought it said "ash cans"—we knew what they were but we had never heard of "Ashrams."

But after reading further we discovered that an "Ashram" is an old Hindoo custom which was imported to the United States by that old tried and true Socialist, one-worlder and Communist frontier, E. Stanley Jones who will address these "Ashrams" twice daily while they are being held.

As if it were necessary to say so, the bulletin added that "the Ashrams are inter-racial and inter-denominational."

We hope the performances are successful and profitable to these good people who take part in them but we feel compelled to remind them that it gets mighty hot in some places in the United States in July and August and they may find it a little uncomfortable with blacks and whites all jammed up together in one Ashram.

Two Things This Country So Desperately Needs

There is utter consternation in many areas because the administration insists on sending aid to Tito even though that old reprobate has stated frankly that in the event of war between East and West, he would stand with Russia.

However, there is little difference in giving money to Yugoslavia and giving it to any other country than our own. It is not only indefensible but un-Constitutional for Washington to levy a tax against American citizens for the benefit of any foreign nation and there is little moral difference between a transaction like this and a private act of robbery committed with the aid of a gun.

What this country needs more than anything else on earth is, first, a few impeachments and, second a good, two-fisted, nationwide tax revolt participated in by every citizen in protest against forced support of Marxist states of Europe.

It is to our everlasting shame that only a handful of American citizens including Governor J. Freedom School Is Being Established in Colorado

On the very sound theory that the proper education of the youth of the country is one of the most pressing problems this nation faces, a group of Colorado citizens are in the process of establishing the Freedom School, Inc., which it is claimed will be the only libertarian school in the United States.

A three hundred acre site nestling in the Colorado Rampart Range half way between Colorado Springs and Denver has already been purchased and some of the buildings have been constructed. It is planned to have the School in readiness for the first classes in the Spring of 1957.

It is planned to conduct the School more as a pleasant vacation than as an academic institution, where young men and women sixteen years of age and over may have an indoctrination in the philosophy of Americanism within the period of two weeks usually allotted to their summer vacation.

Students who register at the school will be charged \$75 per week which will pay for their room, board, books, recreation and instruction.

In this way, young people may arrange their vacation in such manner that the two weeks will not only afford them a period of recreation in scenic surroundings but will give them a course of instruction in fundamental American philosophy not always available in their regular academic instruction.

In other words this Freedom School would seem to offer them a chance to cleanse from their minds during their summer vacation all the marxian ideology acquired during the entire nine months of a regular school year.

Supreme Insult to the American People Offered in Three Appointments to U. N.

The selection of Paul G. Hoffman to represent the United States as a member of the American delegation to the United Nations is perhaps the baldest insult so far offered the American people by the White House which has become noted for slapping the public in the face through its un savory appointments.

Even the naming of Earl Warren to the Supreme Court did not provoke the general revulsion which Hoffman's selection has inspired. Warren's ideological leaning was not a matter of public knowledge outside of California until after he was safely installed in a lifetime job in Washington.

Hoffman's pro-Communist sympathies, his defense of the right of the American Communist Party to enjoy the same status as a legitimate political party and his association with groups identified with subversive propaganda movements is common knowledge to practically everybody who can read.

If an intensive effort had been made to dredge up a nominee for this post who was more offensive from the standpoint of political morals and ethics, than Hoffman, it would have met with abject failure.

The appointment of Hubert Humphrey, loud-mouthed darling of Americans for Democratic Action and one of the most obnoxious personalities which the New and Fair Deal philosophy of government ever projected onto the Washington stage, is an almost equal affront to responsible American citizens.

Still another named to the United States delegation to the United Nations was Ellsworth Bunker who, while he is an important figure in certain circles, has had little publicity and is not known to the general public.

Who's Who lists Mr. Bunker as a member of the Institute of International Education, Inc. For information about the Institute of International Education, Inc., the answer may be found in Union Calendar No. 838 of the House of Representatives, Report No. 2244 entitled "The Communist Conspiracy" with a sub-title of "Strategy and Tactics of World Communism." On page 4 of this document under the heading of "American Branches of the Communist Internationale" is listed the "Institute of International Education, Inc.—American Summer School in Moscow."

These three appointments, like most of those emanating from the White House, and in all of which the fine Italian hand of the Palace Guard is plainly visible, appear to be a continuation of the little game being played in this connection in which the objective is to see how far they can go in offering up ideologically suspect characters for high appointive office without inspiring open revolt by responsible Americans who helped vote the present administration to power.

The responsibility of White House advisers is to bolster and give a steady hand to a confused or faltering Chief Executive and to prevent, whenever possible, grievous errors of judgment or the display of official bad taste while, at the same time, keeping the security of the Republic paramount in all executive actions.

The current stable of Presidential counsellors, however, rather than serving as a brake on the President's unfortunate propensity for choosing his appointive material from the Reddest pattern available, are reported to take a sort of ghoulish glee in egging him on in his shocking choice of nominees.

Economists From "Backward Countries" Had Better Let Well Enough Alone

It is announced that a "unique educational experiment" has been undertaken by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, with headquarters in Washington and branch offices in New York and Paris.

Reference to this experiment as "unique" is probably the understatement of all time. "Preposterous, ridiculous and unbelievable" would probably be more fitting expressions for describing it.

The plan is to bring key economic officials from backward and under-privileged countries to Washington and give them an "intensive course in sound economic policies and administration of government" in order that they may go back to their respective countries and "properly administer their governments" and "constructively spend" the millions of dollars we hand over to them.

Ye gods and little fishes! Imagine any official of any government from any country, no matter how backward, having his "administrative skill" in operating his government improved by adopting Washington methods.

We hate to disillusion these old boys from backward countries, but if they know what is good for them, they will stay where they are. All they could learn in Wash-

ington about administration of government would be how to borrow money and give it away to some other country, while going steadily in debt themselves.

After they got thoroughly "educated" they would probably go back home and start taking the millions of dollars we give them and give them to some other country which they regarded as even more backward and under-privileged.

They'd better let well enough alone and stay on the catching side instead of lining up with the pitching team.

"Members of the Supreme Court just don't understand what they are doing. We made a mistake in confirming as Chief Justice a man who had no judicial experience. His only experience is as a politician. It's not that they are knowingly helping the Communist cause. It's just that they don't understand the function of the Court. They apparently feel that the Court should make laws and not interpret them" — Senator Joseph R. McCarthy.

Act of Southern Chivalry Engaged in by Northerner

An alleged slur on Southern womanhood by the Kraft Cheese Company in a television show sponsored by that firm on July 4, was promptly challenged by a Chicago business man, Lloyd E. Whitney who wrote officials of that company:

"I watched with mixed emotions the television broadcast your firm sponsored on Channel 7 last evening in which the political intrigue of Washington, D.C. was fairly portrayed.

"But there was one portion of the play that was so obviously an attempt to portray a woman clerk as a stupid, asinine creature, that I was offended in the emphasis which was placed on her all too obvious Southern accent.

"If the purpose of this character was to heap ridicule and disrepute upon the womanhood of the South, the part truly accomplished its purpose, but surely you do not expect folks of the South to accept your effort to sell them foods when you turn their stomachs and offend their minds with such obviously slanted propaganda.

"You may probably disclaim all intent to accomplish the purpose I condemn, but did you carefully screen all those connected with the play to discover who among them might desire to hold Southern womanhood up to such ridicule?

"You surely are aware of the efforts of certain Red fronts to bring disrepute upon the South, and an attack upon its womanhood would strike the deepest in accomplishing such purpose.

"I treasure a kindly acquaintance with several Southern people to whom I am sending copy of this letter."

We thank Mr. Whitney heartily for calling the hand of the Kraft officials for their lack of taste. We didn't see the play referred to as we almost never view anything in the way of "entertainment" presented on television, not having the stomach for the constant propaganda beamed at the American people through this medium. We would remind our Chicago friend, however, that Kraft is not alone in the commission of this offense. The theatrical world is noted for its cute little practice of selecting only lug-heads to play the part of Southerners in their productions, who have never been South of Hoboken. It's an old Spanish custom which is widely prevalent, especially in Hollywood, and on the New York stage. We are used to it.

Incidentally, Mr. Phil Tyrrell, chairman of the Americanism Committee of the American Legion has done some interesting research which shows that there is scarcely a production on stage, screen or television now being presented in which there is not at least one Communist Party member, Communist sympathizer or fellow traveller in some manner connected with such production, either as actor, producer or writer.

Assistant District Attorney Rorke of New York as far back as 1919, following a lawsuit in which a Red teacher was dismissed from the New York City Public School System, said: "The public and private schools, academies, colleges and universities have practically thrown out the teaching of the truth itself and have put into the schools the doctrines of Marx, Engels, Trotsky, Lenin and Trotsky." That was 37 years ago and the inroads made by the Reds into American educational institutions during that time is one of the most discouraging factors in the fight against Communism."

Donovan Book Tells Little That Informed Americans Didn't Know

We can't understand all the controversy over Robert J. Donovan's book titled "Eisenhower the Inside Story," the satisfaction it is alleged to be giving the Democrats and the consternation said to be prevalent in Republican circles because of its revelations.

From what advance information we have had on the book, it contains nothing that is new in the way of the President's views and ideological beliefs to such observing and intelligent Americans as have watched and kept record of his official statements and performances during the past three years.

That he leans further to the left than his two immediate predecessors and any of the currently proposed candidates for the Democratic nomination certainly should be obvious to all who make any pretense whatever of keeping the record straight.

Claiming that his "confidential source material" was provided him by close associates of the President, Donovan tells of the contempt of the Chief Executive for Conservative or right-wing Republicans which reached such proportions in the summer of 1953 that Mr. Eisenhower seriously considered the idea of setting up his own new liberal party. Only a complete moron would not have already figured this out for himself, as he watched the President adopt one New Deal and Fair Deal policy after another. Dumb as we are, we have not only made this charge time and again in the pages of the Southern Conservative but have even pointed out that Socialists are now in total control of the Republican Party even as they now absolutely dominate the Democratic Party.

That Senator Joseph R. McCarthy's attempts to get Communists out of the government, the Army and defense plants "disgusted and infuriated" the President, as Donovan charges, certainly was obvious during the Army-McCarthy hearings when the White House threw every possible obstacle in the Wisconsin senator's way to prevent the accomplishment of his objectives.

Donovan further quotes the President as saying "it might be a good idea for the Kremlin to put McCarthy on its payroll." There are several million Americans who are firmly convinced that there are many in high echelons in Washington who are covertly and deliberately giving aid and comfort to the Communists in their attempts to destroy the American form of government, but Joe McCarthy is definitely not one of the suspects. We hope the President was misquoted on this.

Donovan was a little more subtle in telling of the President's approval of the admission of Red China to the United Nations. "Eisenhower was not convinced that the vital interests of the United States would be best served by prolonged non-recognition of Red China," he wrote. Donovan could even get bets that as soon as the election is over, Red China will be admitted to the United Nations at a session of the outfit which was to have met in September but, on White House request, was postponed until after the election.

Nothing new there, either.

The information that the President realized that he was setting up "a different pattern of life in the South" by his Supreme Court decision on segregation, even though warned by his Chief of Staff of the FBI, J. Edgar Hoover, of the Communists interest in accomplishing this, will hardly be expected to raise any eyebrows. Informed Americans have known from the first where the agitation for integration originated.

All in all, we consider Donovan's book strictly "old hat" to all but the dullest, most stupid and obtuse of Americans.

A candidate for Governor of Texas calls for a "Mental Health Program." Of course what he refers to is a legitimate program under the auspices of ethical doctors and psychiatrists. What he does not realize is that such a program these days is hard to come by since the whole mental health program is largely a political racket sponsored by one-worlders who see in the science of mental healing a chance to put over their nefarious internationalist scheme.

"In 1908, President Theodore Roosevelt accepted an invitation to speak at the laying of the cornerstone of the Young Colored Men's Christian Association. Booker T. Washington had called on the President the day before and there was quite a bit of curiosity as to what the President would say in his remarks to the colored group. Later, the President, in conversation with an aide said: 'They wanted me to say something about the 14th and 15th amendments, but I refused emphatically to do so, or to advocate standing the Pyramid on its apex, or inverting the Washington monument.' — Burton A. There was a rumor over the air and through the press that Fred Seaton the new White House appointee as Secretary of the Interior was a conservative which seemed too good to be true, if not actually unbelievable. Sure enough, the rumor was baseless. We now find out that when he was a senator from Nebraska for a short period following the death of the Honorable Kenneth Wherry, his vote on measures approved by the ADA was almost one hundred per cent and only Wayne Morse had a better ADA voting record. We knew there was a catch to it because no one but extreme left-wingers are appointed to any post. But at least we could hope for a little while.

According to press reports, one of the State Department's symphony orchestras has been held up and will not be permitted to continue on tour until an investigation is made into the alleged Communist affiliation of some of its members. This is only a temporary arrangement, however, and that agency of government will continue to book all sorts of entertainers to foreign countries in the interest of promoting "culture." In view of the permanent Rock 'N Roll policy which that department seems to have adopted, we suggest that it might be more practical for the President to remove Dulles and appoint Elvis Presley as Secretary of State.

Fearless Congresswoman Speaks Her Mind On Mutual Security Program

One of the most disgraceful performances ever staged by either House of Congress concerns their handling of the so-called foreign aid bill. Overwhelming sentiment of the country is for the discontinuance of this give-away program which is not only un-Constitutional but immoral since members of Congress who support it are not only giving away money that does not belong to them, but they are giving away money the Federal government does not have and has to borrow.

So they cut billions out of the bill in the House, then restore it; then cut it down again and send it to the Senate which goes through the same silly procedure, and it will probably wind up with the same outrageous figure of more than 4 billion dollars when it is finally passed, including a big slice for Tito's Yugoslavia.

The most sane, sound and sensible speech made on the whole affair was that of Congresswoman Iris Blitch of Georgia who told her colleagues in the House what she thought about foreign aid and she didn't stutter when she said it.

Under consideration in the House was an amendment to restore the amounts that had been slashed from the iniquitous give-away program when Mrs. Blitch laid it on the line.

"First, let me pay my respects to the President of the United States, to the speaker, to the majority leader and the minority leader of this House and, most especially to the beloved Southern gentleman (James P. Richards of South Carolina) who is chairman of the Foreign Affairs Committee," the lady from Georgia said.

"Next, I would like to say that, lest there be any misunderstanding as to why I have taken the floor, I should like to state clearly I am rising in opposition to this amendment. I shall vote against any amendment that provides an increase in this misnamed mutual security program. I shall vote for every amendment that provides a decrease. And, at the end, I shall vote against the bill. I did so last year.

"This is the first time I have ever engaged in general debate on this floor. I feel very deeply about what I am talking about. I come from a rural region, but the people there are good people, and they are right-thinking.

"Let me tell you, they have been thinking very, very seriously about what the Congress of the United States has been doing to pull down and destroy this country from within.

"I am not afraid of Russia and her might; I am not afraid of Yugoslavia; I am not afraid of India; I am not afraid of any enemy outside the borders of this country. I am afraid of what we will do to ourselves.

"Mr. Chairman, this country will never be destroyed unless Socialism first takes hold of the country. That is the pattern; that is what has happened in so many countries and that is what Communism is aiming to do to our United States. We are the only stronghold left that will keep Communism from enslaving the world. Enemies from within are working day and night to accomplish this purpose.

"When the war was over, my heart was deeply touched. I would have done anything on earth to restore the ruins left in war's wake in so many countries. To help these people recover from their wounds was a good thing to do, and a thing that the American people cooperated in heartily.

"To the Foreign Affairs Committee whose members have travelled so much all over the world, let me say I have not seen the world. I do not know what it looks like, but I can read and I can study; and I know that this program has come to be wrong.

"This Congress is going to be turned upside down and every person who votes for this program that is presented here is going to have to face the people of his district when he goes home. The most refreshing thing that has happened to me since I have been privileged to sit with you here is the debate that has gone on today.

"Why are you men and women rising to speak? Why are you questioning? Because your people back home are letting you know that they are distressed about this program.

"Why was it last year that we could not reduce the income tax of the lower middle-class people of this country to the tune of even \$100? Are we trying to destroy them with wastage and throwing away the great inheritance that we have; that came to us by blood, sweat and tears through the years?

"Mr. Chairman, I appreciate your listening to me. I do not have anything more to say except that if this House has not felt the deep stirrings in the hearts of the American people all over this country you will feel them soon because, God helping me, I can stand here and testify that the spirit of independence, the goodness and the common sense of the ordinary American citizen is not dead. Thank you."

While this was the first time the lady from Georgia arose to speak on the floor of the House, we hope it will not be the last for in this brief discussion, she performed in a manner that reflects distinction and honor on her sex which is not always true in the case of women elected to high office.

Recently, we were informed that the water in Washington, D.C. is fluoridated but we have been unable to confirm the information. Not enough that you could notice it. On the other hand, let any patriotic American rise up in Washington to fight this deadly menace and warn against it and highly-placed leaders get out the tarbucket and go to work.

All of which means that there is something fundamentally wrong and corrupt in the manner in which the American government is currently being administered and unless there are some mighty changes made, it is not inconceivable that the Iron Curtain will close around "the land of the free and the home of the brave."

Occupants of A Booby Hatch Could Have Done the Job Just as Well

Practically every country to which we have been sending "aid" in amounts running into the billions are reported to be in excellent financial condition as a result of our misplaced generosity.

Canada is reported to have been able to cut its income tax rate five times since the end of World War II. England, France and virtually all the other countries to which we have played the sucker have also cut their rates.

Candidate Who Omits Double Talk Creates Sensation in Texas Race

A political phenomenon has been brought to light in the six-man gubernatorial campaign in Texas. One of them has bowled over the electorate by refusing to play the game according to the modern formula of evasion, equivocation and double-talk. Instead, this candidate comes out flat-footed and says exactly what he thinks.

His name is J. Evetts Haley, historian, lecturer and ranchman from deep West Texas.

Possibly because this species of politician is practically extinct in Texas as in all other sections of the country, this West Texas cowman is proving something of a sensation in a field where frank and forthright expression of opinion has come to be largely regarded as a sign of political naivete, if not downright heresy.

When, for instance, a CIO member of a large Dallas audience sought to heckle him by asking him his attitude on union labor, Haley replied that he believed labor had a right to organize, to collectively bargain and that union members had a right to quit when they want to. "But" he quickly added "If after you do quit, you think you have the right to keep somebody else off that job let me tell you this: If, on my ranch, a bunch of my hands quit and you fellows came up there trying to interfere with the fellows I then hire to flank a bunch of yearlings on my land, I'll meet you at the fence with a .32 and, if necessary, I'll draw a bead on you and rim a shell and leave you lying on the fence line."

And those who have known him as professor of history at the University of Texas, as a lecturer and later as a successful rancher, insist that he would do just that.

A South Texas audience arose in a body and cheered wildly when he responded in this manner to a question as to how he would handle the matter of segregation: "I would handle it as it has always been handled in Texas. Texas would stay segregated. And if any Federal agent came into the State to enforce integration, I would put him in jail and keep him there until he agreed to get out of the State."

Reaction to this unusual attitude of a man seeking public office resulted, at least in the case of one big city, in lifting Haley's name from last to first place almost overnight in a newspaper poll.

The Southern Conservative endorses no candidate for public office at any time and does not intend to do so in this instance. Neither do we venture any prediction on the outcome of this race where the odds favor those bolstered by large voting blocs or special groups.

It is our intention merely to remark on the apparent appreciation of the average American voter for frankness and honesty on the part of candidates for public office and to express the hope that all those making such bids may some day adopt the forthright policy of this plain Texas cowman who calmly walks into the forum and says what he thinks, letting the chips fall where they may.

There was a time when most candidates were like that. God speed the day when they are that way again.

Justice Shows Abysmal Ignorance Of Meaning of the Constitution

On the 17th of April, 1930, the New York Times quoted Felix Frankfurter as saying: "The Constitution is what the Supreme Court Judges say it is."

No more misleading, fallacious and dangerous sentiment was ever given voice than this utterance by a foreign-born Marxist who, through some malicious streak of malice on the part of the gods, was one day to sit on that same Supreme Court and function in accordance with the belief he had expressed on that Spring day in 1930.

To admit that Frankfurter's contention is true and that the greatest document ever written is nothing more than the casual interpretation of a political appointee to a soft berth, is to defame the patriots who wrote it with the sole purpose of protecting the fundamental rights of the people and perpetuating Constitutional government in the United States.

If we concede that the Constitution is only what the Supreme Court Judges say it is, then we must also grant that if the day comes when the appointees to that bench are outright Marxists, instead of extreme liberals and Communist sympathizers, we will then be without protection or safeguard for the freedoms so specifically set down in its every provision.

Stork Makes 100 Visits to Schools Held Up as 'Example to the Nation'

Long-suffering authorities of the District of Columbia public school system who are trying bravely to live up to their touted position as an "example to the nation" are up to their neck in trouble.

When two Negro girls, 13 and 16, recently turned up in juvenile court in connection with attempts to compel two 20-year-old Negro boys to contribute to the support of their unborn babies, other information concerning conditions in the schools there which have largely been suppressed, started spilling over into the columns of the press.

In answer to inquiries it was finally revealed that around one hundred girls in junior high school had to be excused during the school term last year because of impending visits from the stork.

According to the Washington Daily News two members of the school board have publicly appealed for help from individuals and organizations in an effort to arrive at some solution for a situation in the schools there that threatens to become a national scandal.

One board member even suggested that the schools include a course in sex education although it is obvious that too many of the students are already highly educated in the subject.

Since a majority of the cases involved were colored, the authorities will get further when they recognize the well established fact that Negroes

are practically born with a sex instinct which is not manifest in normal members of the white race until many years later.

There is no longer any doubt that those who boasted that the Washington schools would prove an "example to the nation" in integrated schools will have many sad occasions to regret their ill-advised predictions.

The safety of any nation depends primarily upon the soundness and moral integrity of its religious and educational institutions. When these molders of public thought trail off after alien ideology and corrupt the ideals of youth, civilization crumbles. The tragic fact is that if the religious and educational leaders who have gone overboard for Marxism could be whipped back into line, the fight against Communism could be won in short order.

How the Supreme Court of the United States Got That Way

The downgrading of Supreme Court justices was begun by Franklin D. Roosevelt who seemed to take a sadistic delight in defying the age-old tradition that only the nation's ablest jurists, void of all political bias or ambition and possessed of unquestioned personal integrity, should hold these high posts. He named instead, such undistinguished and ill-equipped members of the legal profession as could be counted on to inject his New Deal social theories into judicial rulings which had, immemorably, rested solely on the Constitution and the law.

Four of his appointees are still on the Bench and have contributed their full share in bringing the Court down to the low estate to which it has fallen.

His first appointment to that high tribunal was generally regarded as having been offered as a whimsical jest in which he apparently sought to shock and insult convention by naming a Southern Police Court judge whose only experience in upholding the majesty of the law was in the trial of drunks, crapshooters and traffic law violators and who, in order to don the black robe of the highest Court in the land, had to lay aside the symbolic white sheet of the Ku Klux Klan.

His second appointment to the Court was a professional New Dealer whose legal experience was largely limited to Socialistic alphabetical agencies like RFC, FFB and others which had sprung up in the national Capital like toadstools in a swamp.

His third appointment was a foreign-born Socialist who was deeply steeped in Harvard theories of government, a pal and sponsor of Alger Hiss and who enjoyed the confidence of notorious Marxists from all over the world, including Sidney and Beatrice Webb of England.

His fourth and last appointment is a sort of elfin personality who goes off on mysterious trips into the wilds of Asiatic countries ever so often and holds communion with members of half-civilized tribes for what he calls a "renewal of his spirit" and the "uplift of his soul." He is highly experienced in mountain-climbing, hiking and horseback riding. Since becoming a member of the Court he is reported in the press to have accepted a \$1,500 cash award from the CIO in recognition of his highly developed "social conscience," but if he has ever been acclaimed for his legal learning, there is no record of it.

With a change in administration, the calibre of those appointed to the Court got no better fast as Truman reached down and picked up a couple of Roosevelt New Dealers for elevation to these high posts and when he named a shyster lawyer from Texas who skipped, hopped and jumped from County Court practice to the Attorney Generalship and then to the Supreme Court bench, most people thought we had had it and that the bottom had been touched, but later they were to learn how wrong they were. The worst was yet to come.

Everybody knows by this time what turned up on the Court when Eisenhower came to power and went clear out to the Pacific Coast for an experienced, seasoned, dyed-in-the-wool Socialist and turned him loose to do a job on the Constitution and the Sovereign States. This specimen, together with a professional integrationist from New York constitute Mr. Eisenhower's gift to the American Court of Last Resort.

Composed of four Roosevelt appointees, three Truman offerings and two Eisenhower selections, the Supreme Court of the United States, as presently constituted, is perhaps the only high tribunal in the world composed of nine men whose combined ability and understanding of ethics and the law would be insufficient to fit them for judging the fine points in a case involving the robbery of a chicken coop.

The Court will be long remembered, as it now stands, as a judicial wrecking crew which has concentrated and unified its efforts to raze established American institutions through un-precedented and un-Constitutional decisions which, while commanding the unstinted approval of pro-Communists, Negroes and other minority groups, have rendered responsible Americans speechless, bewildered and alarmed for the future of Constitutional government in the United States.

Communist - Owned Schools Receiving Federal Funds for Educating GI's

All Americans should be vitally interested in a report just made public by the subcommittee of the Committee on Government Operations of the Senate of which Senator John L. McLellan of Arkansas, is chairman.

This is the same committee which was known as the McCarthy Committee when Republicans controlled the Senate. It was when the Committee delved into the unpalatable situation at Fort Monmouth and was getting red hot on some information that would have led to big names in high places, that a couple of old goats in the Senate cooked up the resolution to "censure" the Wisconsin senator.

The same committee under Senator McLellan is bringing out some appalling information which gets little or no publicity in the regular press and it will be interesting to see if Flanders of Vermont and Watkins of Utah come galloping onto the Senate floor some fine day with another censure resolution against the present head of the committee.

The report referred to above released by the Committee showed by sworn testimony of thirteen witnesses that, under the GI bill, returned Korean veterans have attended schools that were not only owned and operated by Communists but were on the Attorney General's list of subversives.

It seems that the GI bill passed following World War II and the Korean War are so worded that the Veterans Administration has no discretion in the schools to which GI's are sent and if these ex-soldiers happen to select a Communist school, as many of them have done, the VA has no recourse. Approval of the schools is left to State Agencies such as State Commissioner of Education or whatever title the head of a state educational bureau may carry.

Unfortunately many of the State agencies are dominated by the National Education Association which is extremely "liberal" or left-wing, to describe them charitably, and would be more than likely to approve Communist - dominated schools.

This means that the taxpayers are putting up the funds to educate American ex-GI's in the Communist philosophy because the money that pays these Communist schools is appropriated by Congress to the Veterans Administration out of money taken from taxpayers.

There are four sections of the report put out by the committee so far covering the investigation into this sordid situation, but the information contained in Part 1 of these reports gives a fair illustration of what has been, and in some cases still is, going on.

Four schools are discussed in this first report—The Cartoonists and Illustrators School, Inc., of New York City; the Radio and Television Technical School of Allentown, Pennsylvania; The Robert Louis Stevenson School of New York City, and the California Labor School of San Francisco, California.

The Robert Louis Stevenson School was duly approved under the GI laws in September, 1946 and was under the ownership of a Dr. Annette T. Rubenstein, identified by witnesses under oath as a

member of the James Connelly Branch of the Communist Party. A Mr. John Huber who joined the Communist Party on request in order to get information for the FBI told of his frequent associations with Dr. Rubenstein in connection with party matters. The Committee's investigation into this Robert Louis Stevenson school covered the period from the time the school was approved until June of 1952 when Dr. Rubenstein sold the school.

During this period from 1946 until 1952, this Communist School owned by Dr. Annette T. Rubenstein was paid Federal tax money in the amount of \$2,081,397.96 as tuition and expense of GI's attending such Communist School, according to the report, page 5.

The California Labor School was approved under GI law in 1945, and also approved by the California State Board of Education at the time. In 1947 the California State Board of Education withdrew its approval of the school and later it was put on the Attorney General's list of subversive organizations.

But during the time this school was teaching GI's, it received a total amount of taxpayers funds of \$196,947 for both subsistence and tuition of American GI's.

The Cartoonist and Illustrators School of New York, jointly owned by Burne Hogarth and Silas Rhodes both of whom were identified as Communist Party members on sworn oath of witnesses who had attended party meetings with them, was licensed by the New York State Board of Education in September, 1952, after having been approved under the GI bill in 1947.

During this period the school received from the Federal government through the Veterans Administration, \$1,176,712.76 of taxpayers money. The school is still being operated and 278 GI's are being trained there, or were when the committee closed its investigation in 1955.

The Radio Television and Technical School of Allentown, Pennsylvania, was shown as being owned by a 4-way partnership—Michael Freedland, Albert Gerber, Raymond Freudberg and Harry Galfand. Freedland, who admitted to owning fifty per cent of the school was put on the witness stand after having been identified by witnesses under oath as a Communist party member, and as having had a "subversion closet" in his home, so designated because Communist literature was stored in it for distribution, refused time and again to answer questions concerning his affiliations and took the Fifth amendment.

He admitted that 596 GI's had been "educated" in his school since July 1, 1949, and that he had received \$215,523.26 in government funds from the Veterans Administration for the schooling of these GI's.

Perhaps, the thing that stands out clearest from these reports, is the lack of supervision in expending the American taxpayers money and these Communist schools operating under a law passed by the Congress which provides for no such supervision.

In other words, the Federal government is charged by the admin-

White House Attempt to Take Over Nation's Public Schools Defeated

Like every right-thinking American, we are delighted that the so-called "Federal Aid to Education" bill in Congress has been killed, although we are sorry and ashamed that it had to be disposed of by a subterfuge.

The bill should have been voted down because it was merely another device through which the Reds in education and in government hoped to get control of the nation's public schools and dictate the courses of study for American school children.

Aside from this, there is no clause in the Constitution of the United States which provides that the Federal government shall have any responsibility whatever in the building or operation of the various school systems of the States and this should have been all any responsible lawmaker needed to know to induce him to vote against the bill.

Being an election year, the temptation to play politics, and cheap politics at that, was irresistible and this opportunity to sound off and do a lot of loud-talking for the benefit of the National Education Association Pinkos was utilized to the fullest.

It was the amendment by the Negro congressman from New York barring aid to any State failing to comply with the ruling of the Swedish Marxist, Gunnar Myrdal, through the medium of the American Supreme Court, that served to kill the bill which should have been voted down quickly and with little argument simply because it was un-Constitutional, un-American and a cheap trick of Washington bureaucrats to further encroach on the rights of the States.

The unfortunate aspect of a measure like this which is sponsored only by the most radically left-wing and irresponsible element of the nation's citizenship is that, once it is killed, it does not stay dead but, like the legendary jointed snake, snaps back together and grows again.

The nefarious lobby of the National Education Association will redouble its efforts at the next session of Congress to muster support for similar legislation but, of course, there is always hope in the meantime that some of the deadwood will be cleared out of Congress through the Fall elections and men and women of understanding and with respect for the Constitution chosen to supplant them.

Those who opposed the measure, with or without amendments, deserve the hearty approbation of every American who is concerned in the perpetuation of Constitutional government.

President Again Displays Utter Contempt for White Southerners

One of the most outstandingly unfitted and unsuited appointees for a Federal job which the United States Senate has been called on to confirm in recent years—during which time they have had some odd specimens of humanity flung at them for approval—is one Simon Sobeloff whom the White House has named as Judge of the Fourth U. S. Circuit Court of Appeals.

This Court comprises Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland, North Carolina, and South Carolina and the appointment of a pronounced South-hater to preside over a Dixie Court is generally regarded as merely another of the studied insults which the White House seems to take delight in showering on the white people of the South.
