

House of Representatives

The speaker called for committee reports:

Certification and Installation - Barri Boden. The names of newly accepted members were read and sworn into membership by the chairman of the certification and installation committee.

Monetary and Fiscal - Jerry Monroe. He announced Donnie Harris as a new member of his committee. They will meet on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month in the Student Government office. The committee had their first meeting on October 29. It was decided that the money allowed per person for conventions would be appropriated as follows:

meals	\$1.00 per meal, per day
lodging	\$3.50 per night
registration	\$25.00 each, up to 4 persons
transportation	according to distance
	100 - 250 miles - auto at 5 cents a mile. Four persons will be considered a full car.
	250 - 600 miles - train
	600 miles and over - plane

Transportation must be in accordance with the cheapest rate. When speaking of miles, mileage is one way. The amount the organization will receive is strictly up to the House of Representatives.

Process and Procedure - Allan Segal - no report.
Social Education, and Development - Charles La Monte appointed Linda Knapp as chairman.
