### TORONTO TRUCK THEATRE'S HISTORY

Toronto Truck Theatre was established in a natural setting in 1971 — as a touring company providing entertainment in the parks of the city. In 1973 a formal home was found in the Colonnade, and Toronto Truck Theatre became a professional, self-supporting repertory company: a rarity on the Canadian theatre scene of today.

The company returns to the Colonnade for a fourth season, and has also acquired a permanent home, now in its second season, at 94 Belmont Street. The contrasting stages in these two locations allow Toronto Truck Theatre the space and flexibility to provide entertainment for Toronto and area audiences from the best of both classical and contemporary works.
