In going over the above grounds with Mr. J. S. Cullinan December 22nd, he suggested that we make an entrance at the dead end of Francis Street which abuts the property on the west side.

The purpose of this entrance is to permit teams hauling dirt for filling the south portion of the lot, to enter without crossing the gravel walks recently constructed on the north end of the property.

The entrance is to conform with the other four entrances to the property, viz:

Two brick stuccoed columns
filled with concrete, 10'
apart, with cypress wood
gates hung with 30" gate
hinges.

Estimated cost.....\$150.00

I understand that the City will have some dirt available for this lot within the next few weeks.

In accordance with Mr. Cullinan's verbal instructions, the work will now proceed.
