Campaign Suggestions.

Petition Round-up.

Depend upon your canvass to secure full petition quota. In the closing days of the campaign, in order to have an overwhelming number of signatures, station workers in the department stores of the large towns of the county, and instruct them to distribute literature and obtain petition signatures. Also station workers in the lobby of moving picture shows, to secure signatures. Arrange to cover all meetings. Remember that your quota should be secured thru the canvass, and these emergency methods are to be used in going over the top.

Mothers' Day.

May 11 is Mothers' Day. Ask ministers to mention woman suffrage in their sermons.

Victory Petition Celebration.

Get vacant store window and display petitions, with posters telling how many signatures you have. This display may be made in several of the large towns of the county, one week or ten days before election. Decorate window lavishly with yellow. Have a tea, with speakers.

Have automobile parade with cars decorated, displaying posters giving number of signatures, and other appeals to men voters.

Get printer to strike off leaflets giving the news of your wonderful petition, urging the men of the county to heed the appeal of their own women. Distribute these the last week of the campaign.

Have posters printed giving number of signers with an appeal to the voters, and post at every election booth in county the day before election.

Literature Distribution.

Take every opportunity to distribute literature. Study your community and get the kind that will be most effective. Always fold before distributing.

Election Day Work.

Have decorated automobiles on the street all day.

Have telephone squads reminding voters to go to the polls.

Station workers 100 yards from the polling places to distribute literature, cautioning them not to argue or plead. It is too late to convert opponents.

Miscellaneous Suggestions.

Fly the suffrage colors whenever possible, on your house or auto.

Put suffrage posters in empty store windows, and decorate.

Open a headquarters in a vacant building.

Get local men and women speakers to appear before all meetings, fetes and gatherings, to present question.

Remember:

That we are depending upon the giant petition to win the election.

Remember to tell every man and woman that the woman suffrage amendment contains a citizenship clause, which, after its adoption, will make the qualification for voting in Texas, for both men and women, full American citizenship, either by birth or naturalization.
