MEMORANDUM TO J.Y.POWELL:

This morning Miss Kennedy (Dr. Slaughter's secretary) 'phoned and said the City had definitely refused the proposition in the above matter, and that Dr. Slaughter wishes you to renew the matter with the County, seeing Judge Ward. I told her you were still tied up in Court all the time every day, and probably would be over into next week.

Later, Miss Kennedy 'phoned again, and said that Dr. Slaughter just wanted to impress upon you that he had gone as far in this matter as he can, and suggested that inasmuch as you are tied up in the trial of a lawsuit, and the matter being urgent, that you see Judge Ward at night. I informed her that you were also working on the lawsuit at night, but that I would see that you got the message.
