A New Angle Is Added to U. S. Squandering Program

When England, France and Israel barged into Egypt last Fall and started the brawl which resulted in the blowing up of the Suez Canal, Americans realized that somebody would have to pay for the damage but they didn't dream that this responsibility would fall on them.

This country was not involved in any way in wrecking the Canal, none of our troops were present and just about all the officials of this country knew about it apparently, was what they read in the papers.

We are now informed, however, that officials of the White House and State Department have, without the "consent of the governed," agreed to put up \$18,330,000 of the \$26,500,000 which is being spent to clear the Canal and to pay for the United Nations Emergency Forces which were sent to the area.

Other nations who are chipping in to pay for this foray by England, France and Israel are Canada, Australia, Western Germany, Sweden, Denmark, Italy and the Netherlands. Belgium was asked to contribute but her officials had the courage and common sense to say "no".

Britain, France and Israel who caused the damage are not paying a dime. The above information was revealed in a United Press release from Washington on April 15.

Maybe there are those who can see the logic and the justice in this proceeding but our feeble intellect fails to comprehend this latest act of "international diplomacy" on the part of "Modern Republicanism."

Texas Senator Proves Roosevelt Was A Piker in Squandering Tax Money

The estimated figure for the coming fiscal year, under President Eisenhower, is \$71.8 billion with 2,400,000 Federal employees . . ."

Brucker's Bangtail Junket Is Called Off

Secretary of the Army Wilbur Brucker ran into a hornet's nest in Congress in connection with his plan to take a party of Congressmen to Kentucky to "inspect Fort Knox" at the same time the Kentucky Derby was on. The opposition was so vocal that the Secretary called the whole thing off. It is not clear whether Fort Knox will remain "uninspected" or a later date will be selected.

There was no particular harm in the Congressmen seeing the Derby after their duties were over. In fact, it would be far less harmful than what many of them do every day, and certainly less expensive to the taxpayers than to be back in their seats appropriating money for foreign countries.

While they were betting on the ponies, they at least would be using their own money.

But the fact that their colleagues objected to this jaunt is a wholesome thing and shows that the prod pole which voters have been applying to their representatives in Washington is having some effect.

"While I would be the very last to say I do not trust the judgment and discretion of the President of the United States, I would like to declare that I trust more the collective judgment and discretion of the 96 members of the Senate and that of the 435 members of the House of Representatives."—The Honorable Herman Talmadge, Senator from Georgia.

Because the American people have been so thoroughly brainwashed by the experts in their respective fields, they have developed a sort of sheep-like quality which impels them to follow the leader even if they plunge over a cliff and break their fool necks and crack every bone in their carcass. First, we want to emphasize the vast difference between ethical psychiatrists in the medical profession who are dedicated to the study and cure of actual mental illness and whose ministrations to the mentally diseased are vital to human happiness and well-being, as compared to the political psychiatrists who are prostituting their noble profession by alignment with the worldwide conspiracy which seeks to destroy not only the sovereignty of the United States but all things in which civilized Christian humanity believes.

The professional behavior of these international political psychiatrists who are lending their talents to low and ignoble political ends; is unethical, unprofessional and dishonorable. It is opposed to every lofty aim and principle commonly ascribed to those who enter any sector of the medical profession and who subscribe to the Hippocratic Oath that embodies only a code of medical ethics and makes no provision for extraneous subversive activities.

One of the foremost figures in the promotion of the international campaign to influence human thought toward One-World Government is Dr. Brock Chisholm of Canada who says frankly in his lecture series "The Re-Establishment of Peacetime Society":

"With the other human sciences, psychiatry must now decide what is to be the immediate future of the human race. No one else can. And this is the prime responsibility of psychiatry".

Having established that the "prime responsibility" of psychiatry is not the treatment and cure of the mentally ill but to direct the "future of the human race", Chisholm designated some "personality disturbances" which the political psychiatrists of the world must look into and correct.

The great trouble with the world in this Canadian psychopath's opinion is that heretofore "parents have had a perfect right to impose any points of view, any lies, fears, superstitions, prejudices, hates or faiths on their defenseless children" which he says have caused "neuroses, behavior disorders, emotional disabilities and failure to develop a state of emotional maturity which fits one to be a citizen of a democracy able to take one's part in making a world fit to live in".

Morality in its age-old sense is a dirty word in the lexicon of the political psychiatrists and Chisholm warns that "freedom from moralities means freedom to observe, to think and behave sensibly to the advantage of the person and the group, free from outmoded types of loyalties and from the magic fears of our ancestors". He adds: "If the race is to be freed from its crippling burden of good and evil, it must be psychiatrists who take the original responsibility . . . It is therefore necessary that, for so long as it may take to change the bringing up of children in enough of the world, our close watch on each other and every one in the world should not be relaxed for a moment". So how do we like that prospect? Keeping watch on every one without relaxing for a moment is one of the responsibilities of the brainwashers in Moscow.

When the International Congress on Mental Health met in London July 24 to August 8, 1948, to discuss "psychiatric problems" the assumption would naturally be that experts in the profession from various countries of the world would pool their knowledge and dis-

cuss with each other and on the platform the latest discoveries for curing mental illness and the newest scientific treatment of disease in that field.

Instead, a 48-page booklet issued by the Congress titled "Mental Health and World Citizenship" giving a report of the London proceedings, fails to mention one single address, discussion or paper devoted to subjects relating to the ethical practice of psychiatry.

As delegates arrived from 27 countries of the world, each was asked to write a statement on "What is Mental Health?", "What Constitutes a Good Society?" and "What is World Citizenship?"

Whereupon they all fell to and for two long weeks they struggled with the framework of a new social structure in which all citizens of the world might abide free of "racial prejudice"; released from "unhealthy family relationships"; unrestricted by "pre-conceived notions of morality"; unhampered by "narrow nationalism"; released from "unwholesome parental influence" and "free from outmoded ideas of loyalty to Country or Flag"; in short, where all conventional human thinking will be reversed and headed in an opposite direction and all mortal minds blended into universal accord.

The full import of that World Conference for Mental Health—which of course had nothing whatever to do with mental health—is now being felt in full force in this country and the propaganda initiated at that time is seeping down into the grass roots and finding lodgment in frail minds who are suckers for anything new and untried.

Groups and organizations of women whose fidelity to the herd instinct insures that they will follow the bell-cow without knowing where they are going, have taken up the challenge and are out in full cry. They will urge upon lawmakers the passage of any "mental health" bill put in their little hot hands without any more knowledge of its origin and objectives than a bull moose has of nuclear fission.

For the next few years, we may look for "Mental Health" propaganda to equal or maybe exceed that which has attended the Mongrelization program which caused good women of the church to go ginning and spinning all over the lot in their pathetic blind frenzy to carry out instructions which they didn't quite understand or approve but which they didn't dare disobey. Somebody might think they didn't have the proper "Christian attitude" or didn't understand the full meaning of "Brotherhood". Both "Mental Health" and mongrelization propaganda are part and parcel of the international levelling-off process in preparation for a One-World Government.

While holding in respect which borders on reverence the ethical psychiatrists whose God-given talents help to brighten the dark path of the mentally ill and guide them back to reason and light, we shall always maintain a wholesome contempt for political psychiatrists who seek to bring about a unified humanity in a One-World Government through the practice of their profession.

Personally, we prefer to hold on to any bats that may be running loose in our belfry if this means freedom to think and to act and to sound off about any corrupt principle of government or odious social practice which we abhor, rather than to reach out for the bright and shining mental apparatus offered by political psychiatrists who demand, in payment, that we must surrender our convictions, conform to a uniform pattern of behavior and sit back and smile as our inalienable rights and freedoms are gently clipped away.

As far as we are concerned, they can go wash their own brains, take their own tranquilizer pills, and shrink their own heads.

Female Communist From Moscow Appointed Head of UNESCO Group

To keep the infamous UNESCO literature out of the public schools of this country requires eternal vigilance on the part of parents and school boards and, even so, there are schools all over the nation who do use in some form this poisonous propaganda in their curriculum.

Scores of phony "educators" have defended this anti-American and subversive propaganda dished out by UNESCO for the benefit of adolescent American students and have heatedly denied its Communist affiliations.

On the floor of Congress on March 20, Congressman H. R. Gross of Iowa tossed a small bomb into the midst of UNESCO defenders in the House when he read from one of UNESCO's own bulletins a list of new staff appointments which said:

Mrs. A. Jegalova (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) who was formerly Chief of the Inspection Division in the Soviet Ministry of Education and more recently Chief of the Division of International Literature in the Publishing House of Foreign Literature, Moscow, has been appointed Chief of the Secondary Education Division (of UNESCO)."

"In considering the implications of a Communist occupying such an important position" Congressman Gross continued "bear in mind that UNESCO is the organization which has referred in its 'educational' publications to children 'breathing the poisoned air of nationalism' and has called for children to be educated 'to prepare themselves for citizenship in a world society'".

Mr. Gross read from another UNESCO publication, the UNESCO Chronicle of December, 1956, this interesting tidbit of information concerning that outfit which is largely financed by American taxpayers:

"UNESCO gave financial and technical assistance to the Yugoslav (Communist) National Commission for the organization of an international seminar on the economic education of workers". Among the countries represented at this seminar was Red China, Mr. Gross added.

Now that this organization has come out in its true colors any educator who uses their literature and any school board which permits it, will do so with their eyes open and with full knowledge that it is Communist dominated, (a fact that informed persons have always known) and that the Chief of one of its "education" divisions is a Moscow Communist.

Attack on U. S. Security Relentless and Eternal

When Chauncey Depew, American statesman, unveiled the Statue of Liberty, he delivered a warning which, had it been heeded, would have made us more alert to danger and perhaps prevented this great Republic from becoming a mere Socialist arm of the One-World government of the United Nations which it is today. Depew said: "The rays from this beacon, lighting this gateway to the continent, will welcome the poor and the persecuted with the hope and promise of homes and citizenship. It will teach them that there is room and brotherhood for all who will support our institutions and aid in our development; but that those who come to disturb our peace and dethrone our laws are aliens and enemies forever."

In the Interest of Self-Preservation Surely This Treaty Will Be Rejected

Legislation, executive proposals, treaties and secret agreements which are detrimental to the interests of the United States are constantly bobbing up in Washington but what we believe is the most dangerous measure ever proposed for enactment by any law-making body in the history of the world is the suggested treaty which the U. S. Senate is asked to ratify whereby an International Atomic Agency will be established.

It was Dr. J. Robert Oppenheimer, former head of the Atomic Energy Commission at Los Alamos and who was later removed from that position because of security risk and because of his constant association with Communists, who first suggested that we share our atomic secrets with the rest of the world. Such Americans as are not shock-proof were amazed and infuriated at this proposal for placing this frightening weapon in the hands of those who might use it to blast us off the face of the earth.

But meantime the soft-soap has been used freely and propaganda has flowed copiously in all channels of communication until a large segment of the people have come to think it's not such a bad idea after all.

So now the United States Senate is being asked to ratify a treaty whereby an International Atomic Agency will be set up and, on the same Marxian basis that we have shared the wealth of the United

States with the hobos, the bums and the hoodlums of the world, we now propose to share with them a dangerous and lethal weapon that can blow us into so many pieces we would have to be picked up with a blotter.

Under this treaty, we will have one vote out of the 70 or 80 members of this International Atomic Agency and all members of the United Nations will automatically become members. Nonmembers of the United Nations may become members by a majority vote and there is to be no veto.

The President has approved this treaty and has promised that this country will furnish a certain quantity of uranium 235 which, according to scientists, can be enriched and pepped up to the point where it will provide the makings of 2,200 atomic bombs.

The American people are finally, and at long last, up to the boiling point over the unconscionable squandering of their tax money and, before their wrath cools, they had better let their two senators know just what they think about this latest, and perhaps fatal, booby trap into which we are about to fall.

Only the Senate can vote on ratification of treaties and the matter will not come before the House of representatives until it is time to fork over the funds to put this international infernal machine into operation. So concentrate on the Senate.

Three Americans Murdered in Iran Should Never Have Been Sent There

The murder of Kevin M. Carroll, his wife and Brewster Wilson, American citizens, who were shot down in cold blood by bandits last month in a remote Iranian community carried more tragic implications than ordinarily attends the loss of three human lives. It was all so unnecessary.

The first tragedy is that Americans should be sent to such outlandish places to attempt the ridiculous task of trying to "spread knowledge, education and culture" in an area of the world that is so wild that even camels cannot penetrate the denseness of the jungles where these Americans were shot down, and where political pirates in the American Congress had already squandered \$1,593,647 which they had first pilfered from American taxpayers. The inane objective of this colossal expenditure was to "raise the literacy level" of obscure mountain tribes who don't even know what "literacy" is and care less. Their principal occupation is fighting and killing each other and any hapless stranger who wanders into the domain of these gun-happy barbarians does so at his own risk.

Dr. Nicholas A. Berzel, Beverly Hills psychiatrist, in an interview in the Los Angeles Examiner, listed as a great advancement the new method of inducing mental illness in a normal person by the injection of lysergic acid diethylamide for the purpose of studying the results. Texas Gets A New United States Senator—and How!

The Southern Conservative, as our readers know, never endorses any candidate for any office but we always like to take a post-mortem glance at the performance of the electorate after a binge at the polls where, in the past two decades, human ineptitude and stupidity seem always to be attaining new peaks.

Texans have just gone through the rigors of a hectic special election in which twenty-one candidates gallantly offered to make a great sacrifice and go to Washington to render brilliant service during the balance of the term of Price Daniel who resigned to make a successful race for Governor of the State.

Two or three of the candidates actually had some faint hope of winning and entered the contest with the serious intention of conducting an intensive campaign. The rest merely got in — or were put in—to divert votes from some other contestant or to see how their names looked in public print. The result — to put it somewhat less than mildly— was startling. Not that Texas has distinguished itself in recent years by sending mental giants to represent us in the Upper House of the Congress of the United States but this latest deal was surprising — probably to the candidate himself, who has spent a large portion of his adult life running for office and having no luck.

On the morning after the election, there were many who felt perhaps that such early-day champions of States Rights and Constitutional Government as John H. Reagan, Charlie Culberson and Joseph Weldon Bailey must be weeping in their celestial beards over the potential fate of those revered principles when committed to the custody of Texas' current spokesmen in the nation's legislative chamber of last resort.

The Chinese Communists 'Are in God's Hands for Good' Says Episcopal Bishop

The Overseas Mission Society, Inc., with headquarters in Washington, D.C., describes itself in its literature as "A society for the promotion of the Overseas Mission of the Episcopal Church". It publishes the Overseas Mission Review of which William A. Klebsch at 606 Rathervue Place, Austin, Texas, is the editor.

The Rt. Rev. Ronald O. Hall is the Anglican Bishop of Hongkong and he writes a column in this Overseas Mission Review which gives lay Episcopalians a sort of report of his work and impressions as a missionary in China.

In Vol. 11, No. 11 of the Review, on page 23, appears a column by the good Bishop which would tend to indicate that we grossly understated the situation in the March Southern Conservative when we tried to point out how many churches have become infiltrated with the Soviet philosophy and how some ministers have discarded the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the Social Gospel of the Soviets.

Rev. Hall pulls out all the stops and really goes to town in his praise of the type of "Christianity" as practiced by the Chinese Communists. His column is titled "In God's Hands for Good" and he says in part:

"Now these children of the mission are convinced that they can do more and greater things for their country by a close integration with their fellow countrymen in their new way of life, rather than by retaining international contacts on the old pattern . . .

China was so hopelessly broken and discouraged economically, morally and politically, it needed new men with new courage and a new technique to restore the damage . . . The new men with the new technique have a story like the story of Moses and Joshua . . . They do not ask you to like the form of government now being so successful in establishing order and prosperity in their broken land. They DO want you to know that for the first time for several centuries, China has a government of which China's Christian people thank God . . .

"I know that when they say this they are not brainwashed puppets repeating what their masters tell them but HONEST AND DEVOTED CHRISTIAN MEN AND WOMEN TRYING TO INTERPRET AND UNDERSTAND THEIR OWN EXPERIENCE.

"Let us with God's help, adjust our thick skulls and eager hearts to the fact that the Chinese Church has come of age. Their country has been rescued from moral corruption by a new technique as yet not forty years old . . .

"Let us accept these two facts as the Chinese Church accepts them and try to share radiant confidence that both China and the Chinese Church are in God's hands for good, try to share their gratitude for what has happened."

Those who find it all but impossible to believe that the heathenish philosophy of the Soviet is worming its way into Christian churches should read and re-read the above in order that they may "adjust their thick skulls" to the facts about what is happening in what was formerly the holiest and most sanctified circles of human society.

"Hang One Spy, Another Steps in His Shoes"

Thanks to the Honorable Lawrence H. Smith, Congressman from Wisconsin, who included in the appendix of the Congressional Record on February 22, page A-1410, an address by Major General Charles A. Willoughby, the American people are given an understanding of Soviet espionage that is probably not available from any other source.

General Willoughby was MacArthur's Chief of Intelligence for eleven years and in this capacity acquired first-hand information of the disgraceful events and conspiracies against this country transpiring before, during and after World War II.

Only brief highlights of the address can be given here for lack of space but the reading of the entire address in the Record will provide valuable information to those who attempt to trace the black record of treason against this country by both foreign and domestic enemies in times of peace and of national crises.

General Willoughby's intelligence found international Communists including Americans, operating from Shanghai to San Francisco, during the war, in a recognizable global pattern.

Under the Potsdam conference, MacArthur was compelled to open up the Japanese jails at war's end to liberate "political prisoners" which included a Russian espionage ring, headed by Richard Sorge. One of Sorge's collaborators was Prince Saionji, a high-born Japanese who was during the war, and is still, associated with the Institute of Pacific Relations.

Since a Japanese-American war would benefit Russia by releasing Soviet forces for the European theater, the American Institute of Pacific Relations' conspiracy was directed toward bringing on this war. As early as October 1941, two months before Pearl Harbor, master-spy Sorge relayed to Moscow the information that this attack would be made although American forces at Pearl Harbor had no such warning in order to prepare for the invasion.

One of the principal traitors in the betrayal of China to the Communists is pictured in the person of Agnes Smedley who was part of Sorge's spy ring, as well as a protegee of Harold Ickes, Secretary of the Interior under Roosevelt.

A million-word report with complete documentation was furnished to Washington concerning the operations of the spy-ring of which Smedley was a part but was suppressed. When the un-American Activities Committee tried to subpoena her for questioning, she skipped to England where she died mysteriously. She left her estate to General Chu-Teh, the Chinese Communist Commander, and her will ordered that her body be cremated and her ashes laid to rest at any place the Chinese Communist should direct. The ashes of Smedley were flown to China and placed in a magnificent marble shrine "at a time when United States troops were piling up their dead on the dismal battlefields of North Korea", General Willoughby pointed out. Smedley was endowed by a large American Foundation the name of which was not given in the General's speech.

The General touches on scores of other events which, together, weave a pattern of betrayal of American interests that is unbelievable except that they are now a part of recorded history.

"Like It or not We'll Trade With Red China" Says Britain

'Crusade' Is A Fighting Word in Our Book

We think that as long as we live we shall always gag slightly when we hear the world "crusade."

There are innumerable reasons for our nauseous reaction to the term, but the following is a fair illustration of what we mean.

During the campaign of 1952, Mr. Eisenhower said at Fargo, North Dakota, on October 4th:

"If you have the kind of government that this Crusade is determined to offer you, you will have a government that will examine with a critical eye, all of these crazy spending programs of the National Government. It (this Crusade) will eliminate deficits as its first step toward bringing down taxes and making your dollar sound". (applause) Ye gods and little fishes!

There is no one step that could be taken that would cure all the ills that plague this country at this time, but there is one thing that could be done that would go further than anything else toward achieving this result and that would be repeal of the Sixteenth amendment, the most vicious provision ever inflicted on any nation. This is the income tax amendment which makes the sky the limit in the amount which the government can confiscate from the citizens. It has made thieves and extortionists of representatives in the Congress and has enabled them to spend money all over the world like drunken sailors. When attempts toward its repeal or limitation are made, these representatives scream like banshees.

The claim of bleeding hearts that Negroes become first class citizens on becoming "integrated" has been torn to tatters by John Bell Williams of Mississippi who produces the FBI record in the case of Washington, D.C. which is so "integrated" that white people must use a burnt cork on their face in order to get recognition. Congressman Williams shows that during the "integration" year of 1955, according to the FBI, 84% of Washington's murders, 90 percent of Washington rape cases, 86 per cent of Washington robberies and 73 per cent of Washington's cases of theft were committed by Negroes. This is the city, remember, which the President held up as a "model of integration" for all States to follow?

Referred to also is a petition imploring the Court to repeal the internal security act, a petition signed by veteran Communists of the card-holding variety, an episcopal clergyman, an educator of New York University and more than 300 others which were supplemented by a personal letter from Eleanor Roosevelt to the President.

According to an article from Washington appearing in the Houston Post April 15, the United States is going to back up and not say a word in protest of the British announcement that England is "going to relax trade relations with Red China whether this country goes along or not."

Declaring that the process of relaxation is already under way by England, the article says:

"And although President Eisenhower indicated at his press conference last week that the American position was not yet final, his advisers are ready to tell him that the question of agreeing to liberalize the ban on shipments to Red China is largely academic. Faced with what is in great part an accomplished fact, it is the opinion of officials that it is better for Anglo-American relations not to make an issue of it."

The article says further: "At the same time efforts are being made to prepare Congressional opinion for the inevitable. In recent days top legislators have been flatly told by State Department officials that since Britain is already sending goods that are barred on the agreed strategic list, the United States might as well face the facts and legalize the shipments.

"What the British have done is simply turn their backs on the stricter rules of the agreed Allied list of banned items to China . . . According to officials here, the United States already has positive evidence of contracts for the sale (by England) to Red China of strategic goods banned on the China list."

Translated from diplomatic to plain language this means that we ship strategic war material to England with a written agreement that such material is not to be re-sold to Communist Countries but that England has notified us, in effect, to go jump in the lake; that she will ship what she pleases to Communists.

And such is our current status among nations of the world that all we can do is say: "Jolly! Go right ahead old dear."

From this it is not only clear who is giving advice to the "advisers" but the pathetic fact is revealed that Congress is no longer "consulted" about what goes on but is "told" by the Pro-Reds in the State Department what is going to be done and they can either like it or lump it.

The biggest swindle, the biggest steal in human history was when the Senate of the United States voted away the freedom and the sovereignty of the American Republic by joining the United Nations. Only two members of the Senate had the manhood and the courage to vote against it—Shipstead of Minnesota and Langer of North Dakota.

"Can the President of the United States, under this precedent, (Eisenhower Doctrine) act within the strict limits of the Constitution when he takes off his American hat, puts on an international hat, and operates without any restrictions prescribed by the Constitution?"—Honorable William E. Diplomacy by Trickery

(Indianapolis Star)

President Eisenhower is seeking by trickery to circumvent the Constitution of the United States and the laws made by the United States Congress. No other conclusion is possible from the announcement of the agreement made at the Bermuda conference.

The President has unilaterally, and without the advice or consent of the Senate, announced that he intends to join the military alliance of the Bagdad Pact. He has no constitutional right to do so. This is a treaty to which he has no power to bind the people of the United States without the approval of the United States Senate. For if this country joins the military part of this pact, we automatically become obligated to defend the Middle Eastern interests of Britain, Turkey, Iraq, Iran and Pakistan. Yet no alliance can, under the Constitution, be binding on this country without senatorial approval.

Mr. Eisenhower says that he is acting under the "Middle East Joint Resolution." That is not so. He did not ask Congress for authority to join the Bagdad Pact when he proposed his Middle Eastern policy. He did not inform Congress that he intended to make a military alliance with some of the nations in this area and not with others. Yet now he has simply taken matters into his own hands in an attempt to avoid having to ask approval by the Senate which is his constitutional duty.

Would the Senate approve American entry into the Bagdad Pact if asked? We do not believe it would. But whether it would or not, the Senate has not even been asked. This is the very sort of "back door" diplomacy that Republicans have been bitterly criticizing Democratic Presidents for doing at Yalta and in Korea. The President himself has repeatedly stated that he will never seek to circumvent his responsibilities to Congress in foreign affairs—particularly when he was opposing the Bricker Amendment which would prevent such evasion. Now he himself has proved the necessity for limiting still further the power of the President to make treaties singlehandedly and without responsibility to either Congress or the people.

This agreement to enter the military alliance with Bagdad Pact nations is an example of presidential duplicity that needs to be repudiated by Congress. If the President wants to put the United States into this Middle Eastern military alliance let him do it legally. Let him come before Congress and ask for approval in the proper manner instead of trying to sneak it in through the back door.

We did not think the President would stoop to this sort of obvious trickery. Because he has done so, we suggest that Congress by resolution repudiate this illegal alliance. At the same time we suggest that Congress also ask the President to explain why he has agreed to give guided missiles—with atomic warheads located nearby to be supplied in case of war—in violation of the law passed by Congress prohibiting him from sharing atomic missiles with anyone.

Georgian Gives Facts About 'Bombings' in the South

The series of "bombings" of Negro homes and churches in the States of Mississippi, Alabama and other sections of the South which, miraculously, always seemed to take place when there was nobody home, thereby avoiding injury to any one, have been pretty well exposed for the propaganda plays they are.

In this connection R. Carter Pittman of Dalton, Georgia, president of the Georgia States Rights Council, addressed a letter to the President of the United States which we think so correctly and forcefully deals with the subject that we are reproducing it below:

Dear Mr. President:

"It is becoming increasingly clear to intelligent and upright people everywhere that the bombing of Negro churches and parsonages in certain areas of the South exactly fits the pattern used by communist conspirators for many years, in their efforts to stir up class antagonisms, and to create sympathy and support for communist causes. The so-called "victim" was then and most often now is the perpetrator shrouded in a cloak of sanctity, operating in accordance with a plan devised by co-conspirators. Since Marx, wolves no longer come in sheep's clothing—they come in robes.

Is it a mere accident that the bombs recently exploded should have affected only churches and Negro preachers and should have been timed so as to hurt no one, yet timed so as to coincide with the meeting of the Congress to consider proposals to confer unconstitutional, despotic and repressive powers on a group of dogooders to be named by the President?

Is it mere accident that the bombs should explode at a time when proposals are before the Congress to destroy the means of preserving and to hasten the destruction of Anglo-Saxon liberty and the race that produced it?

Is it a mere accident that the objects selected for bombing in each instance were such as were calculated to excite and inflame the emotions of unthinking people who are being led thereby to associate communist causes with God and associate those who oppose integration and communism with the Goddess?

Is it a mere accident that bombs were timed to explode at the very time when the Congress is being importuned to continue its expenditure of billions of dollars for the specious purpose of containing communism abroad when nothing is requested or used to contain or arrest the march of communism at home?

As revelations of corruption of unbelievable proportions are given the American people almost daily, it is becoming evident that when it comes to "messes" the ones in the Truman administration were minor league stuff. We thought "the mess" was horrible, but boy, oh boy, we've really got one now, which is so widespread and all-inclusive that it's hard to know where to start cleaning up.

The Houston School Board recently rejected two economic textbooks for use in their public high schools. These were "Applied Economics" by J. H. Dodd and "Economics and You" by Sol. Holt. The Board members voted, instead, to re-adopt the textbook currently in use "Economics For Our Times" by Patterson and Smith, published by the McGraw-Hill Company of New York, Toronto and London.

All three textbooks had been offered to the Board after selection by a local teacher committee. Previously, they had been selected and approved by a State textbook committee which was appointed by the State Board of Education.

Giving as their reasons for declining to accept the first two texts, the Houston School Board said that the authors were inclined to play up the need for government control and regulation. They also objected to the inclusion in the References of books by certain authors reported as having Communist-front affiliations.

Conservative board member, Mrs. Earl Maughmer, Jr., who led the opposition to the rejected books, also voted against the re-adoption of the Patterson-Smith book claiming that, although more cleverly concealed and slyly projected, "Economics For Our Times" contained propaganda which also approved government planning and control.

Below are some of the "loaded" debate questions that appear in this economics text which Houston students will continue to use for the next five years:

1. Resolved that all corporations engaged in interstate commerce should be chartered by Federal law.
2. Resolved that wage rates in the different groups should be fixed by Federal law.
3. Resolved that a Central Banking System would be more efficient and more stable than our present system.
4. Resolved that all banking should be a government function.
5. Resolved that Federal control of prices and wages should become permanent.
6. Resolved that all natural resources should be owned and controlled by the Federal government.
7. Resolved that immigration restrictions should be removed in order to provide a supply of cheap labor.
8. Resolved that production should be for use and not for profit.

Some of the authors of References recommended in this State-approved textbook will be found to be objectionable. For instance, "Sweden—The Middle Way" by Marquis Childs is included. Marquis Childs is listed in Appendix IX as having been affiliated with the Coordinating Committee To Lift the (Spanish) Embargo and The Washington Friends of Spanish Democracy. These were two of a network of front organizations set up by the Communist Party in the United States to agitate during the Spanish Civil War at a time when many churches in that country were being destroyed and Catholic Nuns murdered.

The inclusion of any author who was affiliated with these multifarious interlocking Communist-front organizations would be unpalatable to a large segment of people

and it is felt that tax money should not be spent for texts including them. That the committee who selects the textbooks on the State level does not have some way of checking them is, to say the least, unfortunate.

Other References include books by Mark Starr, reported in Who's Who in America as having taught economics at Brookwood Labor College. This Communist College was banned by the American Federation of Labor. Starr is also reported as having been affiliated with the Communist-front, Film Audiences for Democracy. Others include:

Marshall E. Dimock, reported as having been affiliated with the subversive American Committee for Protection of Foreign-Born and the Communist-fronts, Progressive Citizens of America, Cultural and Scientific Conference for World Peace and Citizens Committee for Harry Bridges.

Thurman Arnold, reported as having been affiliated with the subversive League of American Writers and the Communist-front Films for Democracy; also, the Communist-lobby, National Committee to Defeat the Mundt Bill.

Paul F. Gemmill, reported as having been affiliated with the subversive National Federation for Constitutional Liberties; the Communist-fronts American Committee for Democracy and Intellectual Freedom and The National Emergency Conference. He is also listed as having signed a statement in defense of the Communist Party.

George W. Stocking of the University of Texas, reported as having been affiliated with the Communist-front, American Committee for Democracy and Intellectual Freedom which defended Communist teachers.

Stuart Chase, whose citations in government files are too numerous to list here.

Other Reference materials which many would find objectionable are the Public Affairs Pamphlets edited by Maxwell S. Stewart whose record as having been affiliated with subversive and Communist organizations is also too long to list. Stewart was identified in sworn testimony by Louis Budenz as a Communist.

Writers sponsored by the Twentieth Century Fund recommended in the re-adopted textbook include Myron Webster Watkins and J. F. Dewhurst. The Twentieth Century Fund's executive director is Socialist Evans Clark, husband of Freda Kirchwey. He was affiliated with the American Council of the Institute of Pacific Relations and co-sponsored the Public Affairs Committee.

J. K. Galbraith's book is recommended. Galbraith is reported "to have resigned his post as deputy OPA administrator after he was accused before a Congressional investigating committee of being a radical theorist whose policies were seriously hurting business."

This then reflects the background of some of the Reference authors recommended in the State-approved textbook "Economics for Our Times" which Houston high school students must continue to use.

Also selected and approved by the Texas State Board of Education but not offered to the Houston School Board by the local teachers committee for approval or rejection were two other texts, "Economic Problems of Today" by Cline and Colvin and "Understanding Our Free Economy" by Fairchild and Shelly.

There Must Be an End And Maybe This Is It

It could be that the fantastic experience of Senator John Williams of Delaware with the Treasury Department as revealed in the press recently, might be the straw that breaks the camel's back. In other words, it might be that this revelation of practices by government agencies that are idiotic, immoral and indefensible might be ended because of his disclosures.

All senators get an allotment of \$1,800 annually for stationery. Delaware is a small state and Senator Williams only used \$291 of his allotment. When he tried to return the unused balance to the Treasury Department, he ran into a stone wall.

He was informed that he must either spend the money or be subject to payment of income tax on the unexpended balance even though he turned it back to the Treasury.

He was advised by a Treasury Department official that another, and perhaps easier, way to settle it would be to buy \$1,500 worth of stationery from the Senate Supply department and then have it sent to the city dump in Washington and burned.

Senator Williams has appealed to the Comptroller General for help in getting the Treasury Department to take back the money which he did not need, and could not use.

Meantime, it will be interesting to see if this instance of irresponsible handling of taxpayers money can be topped or even tied.

Although we know now that there is not going to be any let-up in the appeasement of Russia, kowtowing to England or any cessation of bumbling, fumbling and uncertain foreign policy for the next three years, there is some consolation in the fact that millions of Americans are now aware of what is going on and more taxpayers peeking over the shoulders of their public servants in Washington than at any other time in history.

Hon. Cliff Clevenger, Congressman from Ohio, says that the United States is being "brainwashed into bankruptcy" in order to save Europe from ruin. "I think the greatest brainwashing job in history has been done on the press, on the pulpit and in our educational institutions to justify this idea, and along with it, to put it over, has been an almost abject fear of Russia," Mr. Clevenger said. He had reference to the budget for 1958, of course, which is the largest in peacetime history. The Ohio Congressman expressed fear that this country cannot remain strong enough to protect itself if our spending policy is not restricted.

President's Aide Favors Red China's Recognition by U.S.

Meyer Kestnbaum of Chicago, on March 7 made a public statement in Honolulu to the effect that Communist China should be admitted to the United Nations and also should be recognized by the United States. Hawaii is the big Red Kingdom of Harry Bridges and the statement went over big.

As a private citizen, or as head of a clothing store in Chicago, Mr. Kestnbaum's remarks would carry no weight and occasion no surprise.

But Mr. Kestnbaum, it will be remembered, is a special assistant to the President of the United States and naturally his assertions are regarded as having the backing of the President, even though the White House was quick to repudiate his Honolulu remarks.

Kestnbaum is the man selected to replace Dean Clarence Manion to head the Presidential Committee on relations between the States and the Federal Government back in 1953 but Sherman Adams discovered that Manion was an advocate of Constitutional Government who could not be side-tracked and diverted from his course of duty by "Modern Republicans". So he was fired and Kestnbaum was given the assignment. Later developments have proved that Kestnbaum should have been given the job in the first place as the lay statesman from Indiana, with his definite and unyielding convictions concerning Constitutional Government would have been sadly out of place in any berth having to do with "Modern Republicanism".

It would be impossible to imagine, for instance, Clarence Manion giving vent to any such expression of sympathy with Communists as Kestnbaum was guilty of making in Honolulu.

We Should Run the World When We Can't Deliver Our Own Mail

(Editor's Note: Since this editorial was written Congress has given the Postmaster General \$41,000,000 of the \$47,000,000 demanded.)

It has always been our strong conviction that the Founding Fathers did a perfect job when they wrote the Constitution of the United States.

We have acclaimed them in season and out for their wisdom, understanding and foresight and for their capacity to look into the centuries ahead and anticipate human weakness, culpability and greed as they fashioned the greatest document in recorded history.

But now, at long last, we have changed our mind with respect to one provision of that great treatise on fundamental organic law.

We are now ready to admit that in one case — they goofed.

That was when, in specifying the limited authority and powers of the Federal government, they delegated to it the responsibility of transporting the mails. It has now been proved that this assignment was too heavy and that the Federal government is not capable of handling the job. It has all it can do to look after the welfare, the interests and the security of foreign countries over which it has assumed protective custody.

The Founding Fathers should have specified that the vast undertaking of transporting the mails be entrusted to private enterprise, with just enough Federal supervision to invest it with the force and effect of a national public service to all the people as distinguished from private performance for individual profit.

In that way, it would have been divorced from political turmoil and considerations in either a so-called Republican or so-called Democratic national administration and forced to operate on a strict basis of uninterrupted and meritorious service to all the people alike. And the mail would have been delivered on time.

There is no call for the United States Postal system to operate at a profit, or even on a self-sustaining basis for the Federal government is not supposed to be in business of any kind, condition or character—profitable or otherwise. It was set up solely to transport the mails as efficiently and swiftly as humanly possible but it has not done that and we now face the fact that there is a complete break-down in the service which constitutes a national disgrace.

Of course the Founding Fathers could not possibly foresee that the day would come when those chosen to head this vital agency of government would be pinheaded politicians whose only claim to fame would lie in the fact that they had been able to snag the electoral vote of their State for the successful candidate for President.

Neither did they dream that such pinheaded politicians would publicly disgrace our whole governing system and cast doubt on our capacity for self-government by using the Postal Department as an instrument for publicly hammering members of Congress over the head or as a club for beating them into submission to their will.

In other than government circles, there is an ugly name for the performance when a man demands big money and makes a threat in connection with such demand. Postmaster General Summerfield has informed Congress that if \$47,000,000 is not placed on the barrel-head, the postal service will be greatly curtailed. In another and more honest era of history, this amount would have paid the entire expenses of government.

That the Postal Department has spent all its money and needs more probably goes without saying. It's a Federal agency, isn't it? And don't all Federal agencies constantly have their hand out?

Like all the rest of the bureaucratic units who, collectively, employ 2,400,000 people when 1,000,000 could do the actual work, the Postal Department is a vast feather-bed project which provides a soft berth for the political parasites of both parties and who, because of the pernicious civil service system, can't be discharged when the term of the one who appointed them has expired.

By this we do not refer to the men who go from house to house and building to building to deliver the mail for this is a case where those who do the walking have more brains in their feet than those who do the thinking have in their heads. There is seldom a complaint of postmen personally and if the upper echelons of the service performed with the same dedication to duty, the collapse of the service would not have been brought about to shock and shame the nation.

The whole point is that the American people are entitled, and demand, a steady and unceasing distribution of the mails, uninterrupted by brawls between the Department head and Congress during which period, they take time out to make faces and call each other names.

If the appropriation for the Postal Department is insufficient to maintain it for the fiscal year, it should be increased after an investigation is made of the agency to see how many deadheads are clogging up the machinery and after all the surplus termites have been flushed out of the wood work.

That should be the long-term objective of Congress. Meantime, they have come to the rescue with more money and bail the department out of its own stupidity and mismanagement problems. It's a hold-up pure and simple but Congress may have to come across.

This should not be too difficult a task for Congress which, in the past dozen years, has sloughed off \$40,000,000,000.00 in charitable grants to foreign Socialist States and for which we have received absolutely nothing of value in return, and for which stupidity we have earned the wholesome contempt of the recipients.

The whole affair boils down to the fact that the American people are entitled to efficient postal service, not four or five days a week, according to the mood of the Postmaster General, but to six days of prompt and efficient delivery of mail to every residence, shop, factory and office in the land.

If the Congress can't achieve this, then it is high time they lay off their jobs of trying to finance industrial projects of Afghanistan, Monrovia and French West Africa and buckle down until they get the American Postal System in operation again.

Time for Voters to Get Tough With Lawmakers

Here is just one out of many ways in which lawmakers in general double-cross their constituents by substituting their own opinion for the convictions of those who elected them. In this case, it is a State and not a Federal, offense.

On Sunday, April 7, a Houston newspaper carried an article with an Austin dateline from which we quote this interesting excerpt:

"The House went into a flurry of action on segregation bills, but backstage talk in the Senate is that the Upper Chamber will not exert itself too much on them. There is considerable indication that these measures may die in the Senate."

At the last election, the people of Texas voted approximately 4 to 1 in favor of strengthening segregation and related laws and if they believe like they voted, we predict that swellheaded members of the Texas Senate who may have an idea of giving them the run-around will hear from them by telegram, telephone, postcard or letter.

This, of course, is not an isolated case and lawmakers, State and National, all too frequently acquire delusions of their own importance and act accordingly. Some pea-picker who has been hard put to earn a living any other way will run for high office and get elected. His first official act is to out-grow his hatband and make the irrevocable decision that he is a hot shot and know all the answers. Who do his constituents think they are any way?

The American people have their hands full riding herd on those who misrepresent them in Washington without having to constantly case the legislative joint in their own State capitals.

If the time comes when American citizens begin to think for themselves, they will realize that every State in the Union is in better financial condition and more solvent than the Federal Government and that the State authorities have proved themselves much more capable of administering their State governments than Federal officials have in national affairs. And still they talk about "Federal Aid" to the schools. More arrant nonsense is hard to imagine.

When the publishers of two newspapers in Syracuse, New York, refused, out of a sense of decency, to accept paid advertising of the lewd and indecent motion picture Baby Doll, written by the noted purveyor of filth and obscenity, Tennessee Williams, they were bitterly attacked by a group of 30 persons in that city, according to information and newspaper clippings forwarded to us. These 30 persons were not motion picture operators or any one connected with that industry. They were ministers of local churches.
