Maury Corp, President of the Senate, called the Senate to order. Penny Dunham, Secretary of the Senate, gave the invocation. The minutes were approved as read. There was no one reported absent. The committee reports were as follows:

Appropriations-Joe Chiaramonte stated that Senate bill number two had been approved in its original form, and that Senate bill number four was reduced to include only expenses for three individuals.

Club Constitutions-Kirby Boston recommended that the Senate approve the Jeffrey House Constitution and allow the group representation in the University of Houston House of Representatives.

Lecture Series-Frank Lupo stated that the Lecture Series had already been planned.

Supreme Court--Mike Abbey stated that the Supreme Court had had its first case and that they were now working on requirements for Student Government officers.

Campus Affairs-Maury Corp announced the appointments for this committee. The appointees were Bob Bryan, Taffy Lamping, and Rick Harral.

OLD BUSINESS:

Frank Lupo moved that Senate bill number two be removed from the table. It was seconded. Motion passed. Frank Lupo moved that the bill be passed. It was seconded. Motion passed.

Kirby Boston moved Senate bill number three be removed from the table. It was seconded by Joe Chiaramonte. Motion passed. Kirby Boston moved the Senate accept the bill. It was seconded. Motion failed.

Robert Peterson moved that Senate bill number four be removed from the table. It was seconded. Motion passed. Kirby Boston moved that the bill be amended to two members rather than three. Rick Harral seconded. The amendment passed. Kirby Boston moved that the bill be accepted as amended. It was seconded by Otto Crenwelge. Bill passed as amended.

NEW BUSINESS:

Kirby Boston moved that the application for Jeffrey House be accepted and that they have representation in the House of Representatives. Mike Abbey seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Kirby Boston moved that the Student Government funds be closed, as of tonight, until a new budget is submitted and approved. It was seconded by Kenneth Mobley. Kenneth Mobley moved that the motion be amended to read that the Senate would not consider any future monetary bills until a budget has been submitted and approved. It was seconded by Rick Harral. Amendment passed. Kirby Boston moved a secondary amendment allowing \$100.00 for operation purpose be left to Student Government be adopted. Rick Harral seconded the secondary amendment. The secondary amendment passed. Discussion followed on the motion as amended. Kirby Boston called for the question. It was seconded. Motion to call the question passed. The motion, as amended, failed.

Otto Crenwelge moved that the Senate not pass any future convention bills until a budget is submitted and approved. It was seconded by Joe Chiaramonte. Motion passed.

Frank Lupo moved that the Student Government treasury be closed on December 10, 1962 if a budget has not been submitted. It was seconded by Rick Harral. Motion passed.

Kenneth Mobley moved that an injunction be presented to the Supreme Court stating that the Student Government budget is invalid after November 26, 1962. It was seconded. Rick Harral moved that the motion be amended to include only freezing the funds for any future withdraws. It was seconded by Kenneth Mobley. Kenneth Mobley accepted the amendment. Motion, as amended, failed.

Frank Lupo moved expiration date on the temporary budget be extended to December 10, 1962. It was seconded by Robert Peterson. Motion passed.

Frank Lupo moved that the Senate adjourn. It was seconded. The President of the Senate adjourned the fourth Senate meeting.
