CANDIDATES VOICE

The Alumni Office recently polled the Primary Candidates for Governor of Texas on their views regarding "the appointment of qualified Alumni to the Boards of Regents of their respective universities". Every effort was made to talk with each of the candidates and nine of the thirteen expressed an opinion. Democratic Primary Candidate, with Alumni President, C. F. **Dolph Briscoe**, during a visit Kendall, indicated he "could see no reason why qualified Alumni should not serve as Regents of their institutions, and many reasons why they should".

Democratic Primary Candidate, **Ben Barnes**, stated "The Alumni of colleges and universities obviously have an understanding of the aims and programs of those institutions and I would certainly give Alumni top consideration for appointment to governing Boards. I do believe it is necessary for higher education to have the input of other qualified individuals. My main purpose would be to select the best available men and women for these positions".

Democratic Primary Candidate, Frances Farenthold, in her Position Paper on Higher Education, expresses the opinion that "citizens who represent a cross-section of the population, including educators and students", should be appointed to a Board of Regents for each college.

Republican Primary Candidate, **Albert Fay,** stated, "I favor, when practical, the appointment of qualified Alumni to the Boards of their respective universities. I have always favored this".

Republican Primary Candidate and University of Houston Alumnus, **Henry C. Grover**, believes the logical place for a Governor to look for prospective Regents is to the Alumni Organization of an institution".

Republican Primary Candidate, Joseph Alton Jenkins, states, "qualified Alumni should be on the Board of the university from which they graduated. They have a special interest in serving and I think they should be given every consideration".

Democratic Primary Candidate, **Robert E. Looney**, expressed the view, "the fact that they are Alumni should not disqualify them to serve as Regents of their universities. All persons should be considered equally".

Democratic Primary Candidate, William H. Posey, indicated he is "in favor of appointing qualified Alumni to the Board of Regents of their respective universities".

Democratic Primary Candidate, Governor Preston Smith's position on the question was given by his Press Secretary, Carlton Carl. Mr. Carl stated that Governor Simth "believes in having a good representation of the entire state on the Boards of universities ... but he does believe the people most familiar with a given school should be adequately represented on the Boards".

The Alumni Office was unable to contact Candidates John A. Hall, Thomas McElroy, David R. Reagan, and Gordon F. Wells to obtain their views on the question.

NEW ALUMNI SEASON TICKET PROGRAM

It would seem there are two factors that explain the increase in the number of season tickets being ordered by Cougar Fans since the University of Houston accepted an invitation to join the Southwest Conference last May. One is the growing speculation that we will need a season ticket just to get in the Astrodome to see the Cougars play any of their SWC rivals. The other factor is the realization that we will probably have to be season ticket holders to get a seat for our Southwest Conference games played in our opponent's stadium, because season ticket holders get an option on those tickets too.

Currently, a majority of the 50,000 seats in the Dome are committed to season ticket holders, who have an option to renew their seats each year, or they are committed to the University of Houston Student Body or the opposing school as required by NCAA rules.



Realizing that a shortage of seats will soon occur the University of Houston Athletic Department has set aside the best of the remaining season ticket seats to be offered to The Alumni before they are placed on sale to the general public. Beginning this year Active Alumni Members will have an opportunity to order season tickets through the Alumni Office and to renew those tickets each year.

Season tickets in the group set aside are located in the following sections; from the west 40 yard line to beyond the west end zone in the Field Boxes, from the east goal line to beyond the east end zone in the Mezanine Boxes, from the east 40 yard line to beyond the east end zone and from the west 10 yard line to beyond the west end zone in the Loge, and from the east 10 yard line to the west 20 yard line in the Upper (yellow) Section. This group of tickets set aside for The Alumni will be sold on a first come first served basis until all the tickets are gone or the deadline for sale to the general public arrives.

If you presently hold season tickets your seats will not be effected by this program. If you do not have season tickets the statement "every seat in the Dome is a good seat" may soon become especially meaningful. May we urge that you contact the Alumni Office as soon as possbile for information about ordering season tickets in this special group set aside for The Alumni. Information is also available on joining the Astrodome Club during football season.

(3) Receive the ALUMNI DIRECTORY of all UH alumni of record with business listings (4) Use of Alumni offices, services, and facilities (5) Assistance of Alumni staff in Uni-versity related matters (6) Use of University library, swimming pool, tennis courts, University Chapel. (7) Parties and social events that include Homecoming Barbecue, the Distinguished Alumnus Awards Banquet, pre-game cocktail parties, the All Sports Dinner for UH athletes in the Spring, and invitations to parties in Southwest Conference cities before and/or after the games (8) special trips and tour programs (9) travel arrangements to out of town games.


