Dear Sir:

1st - A meeting of the Advisory Committee is being called to be held in my office Friday, December 7th.

2nd - Under date of November 21st a number of negro doctors of Houston practicing in the hospital presented certain complaints and charges to Mr. J. S. Cullinan, who suggested that they file their charges in writing. On inquiry Mr. Cullinan advises that nothing has been filed with him so far. If these charges are to be followed up, I request that they be filed in time for consideration at the meeting of the Advisory Committee.

3rd - Under date of November 26th I received a letter from Dr. H. E. Lee in which he furnished me with a printed copy of "Constitution and By-Laws of the Medical and Surgical Staff of the Houston Negro Hospital". This is the first knowledge that has come to me as Chairman of the Advisory Committee, or to Dr. Slaughter, that these by-laws have been adopted by the staff. They are not subject to recognition until they have been adopted by the Board under the advice and approval of the Advisory Committee.

I suggest that the physicians and surgeons practicing in the hospital submit for consideration by the Board and Advisory Committee their recommendations as to rules and regulations governing the admission of patients into the hospital. This, too, in time for consideration at the Advisory Committee meeting.

4th - I also request that the present Board of Directors submit a list of names for consideration by the Advisory Committee from whom they recommend that the Board of Directors for the ensuing year be selected.
