

March 11, 1963

The meeting was called to order by the Speaker, George Harris. The invocation was given by Jerry Monroe. The minutes were read and approved as corrected.

Upon the request Marilyn Holub, Allan Segal said his next meeting would be next Monday at 7:30 in the student government office.

A motion was made to elect the vacated offices. It was seconded and passed.

Nominations for Speaker Pro Tempore Marilyn Holub and Johnny Odem. A motion was made to cease nominations, it was seconded and passed. 38 - 17- Johnny new Speaker Pro Tempore.

Karl O Quinn read resolution No. 4. He moved that we pass it and it was seconded and passed by a vote of 31 - 25.

Jerry Monroe read resolution No. 5. He moved that it pass, it was seconded and passed 55-0. *motion to adjourn*
