## "COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS" SELECTED AS THE MEDIUM FOR PUTTING WORLD COMMUNISM INTO EFFECT

### How Many Americans Know That Their Right to Own Property Is Questioned

We suggest that our readers grab on to their chair or some other solid object before going any further into this editorial for we promise that, if it can be done, this will jar loose their uppers.

What we are going to quote is not the babblings of a fugitive from the booby hatch but the actual, printed words of Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt who "represents" the people of the United States on the Commissions of Human Rights of the United Nations.

The words are lifted from her column written from Geneva where the world's prize collection of professional reformers from downright vicious Communists to harmless idealistic Pinks recently went into action and shot the works. Mrs. Roosevelt said and we quote:

"We had an interesting day and a half on the article dealing with the right to own property which was suggested by us for inclusion in the covenant in the economic and social section. It was certainly accepted by all that there must be a right to own property, but serious doubts arose as to whether in this part of the covenant this should include whether it is an absolute right, whether it had to be qualified, and whether property had to be defined. Finally, after a day and a half of discussion, for many different reasons the commission voted not to include this right in this part of the covenant at the present."

In the name of all that's sacred, including our deed to the South Forty Acres, what have we got here?

A bunch of international jerks from every back-alley of civilization, including the totalitarian countries behind the Iron Curtain putting their addle-brained heads together and actually spending a day and a half seriously debating whether or not American citizens shall have the right to own property in the brave new world they are planning.

And, after a day and a half of deliberation on the subject failing "for many different reasons" to include this right in the covenant "at the present time."

Out of consideration for our blood pressure and in deference to our libel-conscious attorneys, we will not express our opinion of one calling herself an American who would not only take part in discussing such treasonable tripe but who would feed it back to the American public in the form of a column.

### Dancing Diplomat Admits His Attempts At Thought Control

The testimony of Dean Acheson before the Senate Investigating Committee probing the facts behind the removal of General Douglas MacArthur from his Eastern Command, revealed an attempt at government control of mind and speech not usually encountered outside of Russia and other dominions dominated by dictators.

With his back to the wall and fighting to maintain his fast-crumbling official reputation, the gopher-foother Secretary with the beaver mustache, admitted responsibility for instructing State Department attaches to spread propaganda for the deception of Americans to the effect that Formosa was of no strategic importance to the United States and that its loss would not seriously damage the interests of this country.

At the same time, this great diplomat who is a far more expert performer when shaking a leg on the dance floor, manipulating a teacup in a drawing room and bending an elbow at a cocktail party than he is when operating as a statesman in the field of foreign relations, conceded that this was the opposite of the truth as the value of the island base from a military standpoint has long been recognized in Washington.

But it seems that the Administration was convinced that, as a result of the earlier blundering policies of the State Department and the America gang in the Far East which resulted in building up the Chinese "agrarians" into a position of strength and power, the Communists were going to take over Formosa any way. This propaganda to influence the utterances of the Department's staff and the thinking of American taxpayers was designed as an alibi for his treasonable stupidity.

In view of this kind of thinking and procedure on the part of policy-makers in Washington it is easy to see why an honorable and patriotic American like MacArthur who, understandably, could not become a mental stooge and suppress the truth and subvert military traditions and ethics in deference to face-saving tactics of small-bore politicians, should be summarily removed from the set-up.

### World Planners Have Taken Over United Nations Which Was Originally Set Up To Fight Aggression and Insure Peace

After years of observing the operation of highly-organized propaganda in this country, any American of adult understanding and perception realizes that behind it is a Master Plan and that behind this Master Plan are those dedicated to the task of putting it into effect.

It is not for us to say what group, class or race comprises this coterie of world planners who evolved this Master Plan.

Any intelligent and thoughtful citizen's reasoning on the subject is as good as ours but the pattern is there for all to see.

We shall merely face the fact that there is definitely a World Plan of more or less mysterious origin with World Communism as its goal.

One of its objectives and the one which is of the most deadly concern to Americans is the dissolution of the United States as a sovereign nation and its incorporation into a World Government and, ultimately, the disintegration of the Anglo-Saxon race and its absorption by a mongrel breed of international hybrids.

The methods of procedure on the part of these World Planners are as clear as a blueprint for the construction of a building and the failure or refusal of any American to recognize its design is a confession of blind stupidity which is beyond human understanding.

This Master Plan was formulated and propaganda for carrying it out set up in a city across the ocean more than thirty years ago but it was only recently that the mechanics for putting it into effect have been perfected.

The medium through which its mission is proposed to be accomplished is that barbaric and insidious body known as the "Commission on Human Rights" of the United Nations.

The original intent behind the United Nations was world peace through organized resistance to aggression by predator nations and this conception of its mission captured the imagination and inspired hope in the hearts of many worthy, but, in our opinion, misguided, Americans to whom the idea of war is abhorrent.

But the United Nations was no sooner set in motion than the representatives of the World Planners stepped in, took it over and set up the "Commission on Human Rights" as the instrument by which their proposals for World Communism could be carried out.

This bastard offspring of an organization originally intended to be dedicated solely to the cause of peace provided for a delegate to be named to represent each of the various countries including Russia and its satellites behind the iron curtain and the person selected to speak for the one hundred and forty million people of the United States was—God help us—Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt.

If any American who has not done so will take the trouble to read the vile document known as the "Declaration of Human Rights" he will find that nowhere within its pages, from beginning to end, is there any reference, either direct or implied, to a Supreme Being.

It is the first instance in the history of the Republic when the United States government has associated itself with any "Declaration" in which divine guidance and the blessings of the Almighty God were not implored and the first official proceedings to which it has been a party where the Man of Galilee was denied admission.

This virtual repudiation of a Higher Authority was dictated by the atheistic member nations who look to Joseph Stalin as God.

The whole infamous document is devoted to the promotion of Socialistic schemes and the advancement of a "social program" and not one line or paragraph is committed to any principle having the slightest relation to Americanism as enunciated in our own Constitution or other instruments on which the Republic was founded.

After declaring for an "international social order", equal rights and freedoms for everybody, universal security, pensions, freedom from fear for all, a plug for labor unions, and asserting that no State or group "may engage in any activity contrary to the aims set forth in this Declaration" this gang of international screwballs and dope-heads tip their hand with this little gimmick:

"Men and women of full age, without any limitation due to race, nationality or religion, have the right to marry and to found a family".

So the "Commission on Human Rights" makes its pitch on the proposition that men and women of all races, white, black, red and yellow have the right to marry regardless of State legislation on the subject which fits in nicely with the World Planners' program for mongrelization of the Anglo-Saxon race.

Preliminary work by the World Planners over the years has been so thorough and efficient that large and important segments of our society have been taken in and

## GOD HATES A COWARD

### GOD HATES A COWARD

That's gospel truth. If any witness were needed to attest it the Republican party of 1936-1948 would more than suffice.

For 12 years the Republican party has been a coward; the worst kind of coward—a moral coward. In consequence it begins to take on the appearance of something the cat dragged in.

It is hard to define as an entity the Republican Party or any other large group of people, since however closely banded together all cannot think alike in all respects. But, speaking broadly, the Republican Party consists of men and women who in firm conviction are opposed to the swift trend toward the omnipotent state that is sweeping over every section of the earth. Whether it be defined as communism, fascism, socialism, totalitarianism, statism, the New Deal, the Insurance State, these men and women regard it as a thing of infinite menace, however, cunningly disguised, and however ardently supported by good but misguided people.

But the Republican party has lacked the courage to say what its rank and file believe. Out of hunger for the flesh pots it has lacked the patriotism, the loyalty, to stand up for the free Republic of the founding fathers and to fight for it. Due to that lack of moral courage, of loyalty to the American creed, the United States, almost the sole remaining bulwark against the advancing tide, finds itself without a spokesman, without a champion to proclaim and battle for its traditional, glorious creed. Here, too, in our own America, the State is taking control and ownership of the people. It is using the power to tax to destroy their independence and self-reliance. It is converting free men into vassals and dependents. It is devouring the substance of self-supporting people to render them self-supporting, no longer, and to establish a condition of universal reliance upon the biased paternalism of a Great White Father—a "Father" corrupted and corrupting, since great power does corrupt and absolute power corrupts absolutely.

And the Republican Party has not dared resist the tide; it has gone along with it. Not out of conviction, but out of cowardice. It has not dared to be a Daniel; to have a purpose and to make it known. Its plea for votes has been the shameful one; Give us the offices, the power, and we'll give you as much of what we believe to be wrong as will the Democrats themselves.

Americans do not respond to any such appeal. They too, hate a coward. They despise hypocrisy. They hunger for a leadership of good faith. They will accept a brave and fighting leadership tainted even with Pendergastism and absolutism rather than a leadership that crawls—and trails its flag.

are working as assiduously for the completion of this World Plan as those who gave the idea birth.

These include government officials, members of Congress, churchmen, educators, columnists, radio commentators, publishers, women's club leaders, motion picture producers, stage and screen personalities and other moulders of public thought including even fiction writers who adhere to the general Socialistic theme and who see to it that the villain is always the capitalist's son who loses out in the end when the heroine marries the scion of the garbage collector.

The stranglehold which these World Planners have on the Federal government was begun in 1933 when Roosevelt opened the door to Russian outlaws and hundreds of thousands of propagandists flooded in to begin the infiltration of all sectors of American life with ideal of World Communism.

They swarmed all over the White House and many of them ate and slept there as guests of the occupants.

From that vantage point and while enjoying hospitality paid for by the taxpayers of the United States, they beamed their barrage of propaganda to all forty-eight States of the Union which has now reached full flower, as attested by the Socialistic activities of various civic, charitable, religious, educational, governmental, cultural and related groups throughout the land.

The fact that the majority of the members of these groups did not know they were being "taken" and haven't the vaguest idea of the traitorous forces who are directing them makes the situation no less deplorable for a fool is as dangerous as a knave.

The penetration of the World Planners into the church and their grip on religious institutions was accomplished by selling World Communism to a clique of sleek, pot-bellied bishops whose religious faith and national patriotism was of such weak fibre that they readily fell in with the new philosophy which denied the Divinity of God and denounced the Free Enterprise system of their country.

Like the scheming female politicians who were recently exposed for selling the members of women's clubs on world government and other Socialistic proposals, these unscrupulous church politicians committed church members by the millions to the same policy and gathered them into Federal and world church groups whose announced tenets of faith have no relation to religion or the teachings of Jesus Christ, but portray with complete fidelity the ideologies of the World Planners.

Their hold on educational institutions and school systems is perhaps more deeply grounded in years of work toward this end than in any other group for, like Hitler and Stalin, the World Planners are playing for big stakes and have a long-range program based on the infiltration of youthful minds of this generation.

This indoctrination is directed by educators from universities in this country who went to Russia in the thirties and took courses of instruction and returned with their schemes of "progressive education" which they have set up in many schools and which they are now trying with increased activity and energy to install in all schools in the various States.

The infiltration of other groups and the minds of individuals with this propaganda of the World Planners was made easier by the fact that the brain of many people is a vestigial organ like their tonsils or appendix and when they hear this new philosophy expounded in the pulpit, over the radio, in the press and on the screen, they fall in line like stupid sheep and follow the leader. The World Planners recognized and relied on this weakness in human nature.

During the years of the "softening up" process of the American people by World Planners, they have placed heavy emphasis on certain words and terms and have perverted their original meaning.

They have changed the form of the American government—for their purposes—from a Republic to a "Democracy", and have invested the word "Capitalism" with sinister implication even though the fruits of "Capitalism" make it possible for this country to support the world.

They have smeared Americans who place the interests of their own country first as "isolationists" and have endowed the term with such infamy that this patriotic attitude has been given a rank just a notch above treason.

They have played up for all they are worth the words "intolerance" and "brotherhood" in their contemptible and revolting fight for the breakdown of segregation in the South which is a definite and vital part of the Master Plan.

They have emphasized such terms and expressions as "Humanities," "progressive education" "human rights" "brotherhood of man" and other disarming catch-phrases and have played them over and over like a record of a popular tune until the American people have completely assimilated them without any conception of their sinister import.

And although there is no such word in the English language or any other language as "Genocide" they coined it and threw it in for good measure to be used later in forcing their racial views on the South.

And so completely have the representatives of World Planners in this country done the work assigned them by their masters that only the American people themselves can reverse their "packaged thinking" and save this nation from the fate of others who have fallen into the trap.

## Secret of Sex Perverts in Government Traced Directly To The White House

Since the subject of sex perverts in the employ of government in Washington is constantly bobbing up and in view of the apparent inability of various government heads to get rid of them, we have sought some clarification of the subject for our readers.

After diligent study, and some tips from alert readers, we have found by reading the Congressional Record, which daily prints all official proceedings of both Houses of Congress, where the trouble lies.

On Tuesday, March 28, 1950, Congressman William S. Hill of Colorado, caused to be inserted in the Congressional Record, Page A-2413, certain documents including testimony of agency officials to a Committee, which explains why homosexuals are fired from one branch of the government, only to turn up in some other equally responsible Federal job.

The Record shows that soon after the discharge of 91 homosexuals by the State Department, a sub-committee of the House, of which Congressman John J. Rooney of New York was chairman, held an investigation of agency officials to learn why sex perverts did not stay fired but bobbed up in some other Federal position in almost every case.

Agency officials were reluctant to disclose the reason but under the harsh questioning of Congressman Cliff Clevenger of Ohio, they admitted that a presidential directive had been issued instructing department heads not to advise other agency heads when a homosexual was fired and not to warn other agencies against employing them.

The result seems to have been that when these degenerates were fired, they tossed their curls, put their hands on their girlish hips and marched right into another job. So there!

We do not know, of course, what the president's reason is for covering up for this particular type of vermin for the vote of a normal person would count just as much.

Of course he has always consorted with Pendergast underworld characters, labor union thugs and other various and sundry crooks but even we thought he drew the line somewhere.

## Soap Box Socialists Are Now Lecturers for World Government

Scarcely a big convention is held anywhere in the United States these days that some world planner does not appear on the program to dish out his slimy propaganda against the United States and in favor of world government.

In Miami Beach, Florida, recently at the annual meeting of the National Congress of Parents and Teachers which has turned out to be a fertile field for such propaganda, a character by the name of Stringfellow Barr appeared to hand out the Party Line for world government and the dissolution of our government in favor of this Socialistic set-up.

He told delegates that babies born today and eight or ten years ago need to know a human geography "not much like the geography adults learned but a geography that includes such miracles as the Tennessee Valley Authority and the ghastly fact that well over half the human beings in our planetary neighborhood are hungry, ill and wretchedly fed".

Why the minds of babies should be burdened with matters like this was not explained and apparently the adult delegates felt that this was a proper discussion for an organization that was originally intended to concern itself with school curricula and the problems of the school room.

There was a time, before 1933, when a Socialistic creep like this would not have dared propose this type of propaganda unless he was holding forth from a soapbox in New York's East Side and if he had, he would have been very properly grabbed by his long hair and thrown from the platform.

## He Didn't Plan It That Way, Just Obeyed Orders

Willis E. Stone columnist in the Van Nuys, California, News, credits General George Marshall with having lost World War II and the peace for us while he was Chief of Staff by stopping our forces short of the victory they had earned.

He gave Russia the fruits of war, Mr. Stone writes, and insured her control of the Baltics, the Balkans, Poland and East Germany which has since involved us, in all sorts of international incidents, leading to war and threats of war.

The same Chief of Staff arranged that Russia should have the spoils of war in Asia and take over Manchuria, Mongolia and other islands, Mr. Stone claims, and adds that under the infamous Marshall plan, the former Chief of Staff has caused Americans to be taxed more each year for the support of European governments than the cost of our own government in any peace time year prior to 1932.

While all Mr. Stone's assertions as to such actions are true, we think he is complimenting General Marshall beyond his just deserts, in taking the position that he manipulated these events of history.

To assume that he is responsible is to credit him with a Machiavellian cunning which, in our opinion, he simply does not possess.

His major role in history has been as a glorified errand boy for Roosevelt, Truman and Acheson and we believe that he carried out commands from Washington without ever knowing what he was doing or why.

He may not be the least mentally alert person in the Administration but he is crowding the ones at the top of the list for first place.

It would be interesting to know which one of the swivel chair warriors threw the monkey wrench.

Fortunately, among the cheering millions of plain people who paid tribute to the great military figure, the army salute was not needed nor was it missed.

## The Government Also "Profiteers in Sorrow"

In a national weekly magazine recently appeared an article giving the shocking story on graft on the part of many undertakers and burial associations who have accumulated millions by "profiteering in sorrow".

It is pointed out that while the cost of living has risen 347 per cent in a little over a century, the cost of dying has advanced as much as 10,000 per cent.

While we agree that there are no more degenerate human beings than those who take advantage of their fellowmen in the darkest hour of their life, we cannot but admit that these harpies have nothing on the Federal government in their evil practices.

After taking practically everything a citizen possesses while he is living, through confiscatory tax levies, government ghouls poke their long slimy hands down into the pockets of his shroud after he is dead and rob widows and orphans of what is left, through inheritance taxes.

It is a system which is evil and it does not matter who practices it.

## Texas Baptists Vote To Discontinue State Aid

Taking a consistent and practical attitude in the matter of separation of church and State, the Baptists of Texas have announced that thereafter their far-flung organizations in Texas, including schools and orphan homes will be privately financed by members of that denomination and that no further State aid will be accepted.

It was pointed out that by assuming full costs of operation it will be possible in future to teach bible courses denied them under public school regulations.

Texas Baptists have presented an almost solid front in the fight against Communism in the churches and, with few exceptions, have not fallen for the Party-line propaganda against segregation of the races in the South.

The Supreme Court has refused to disturb a lower court ruling outlawing Jim Crow cars on railroads, thus maintaining its almost consistent record for "Party line decisions".

## THE RIGHT TO WORK

We have seen considerable work stoppage recently in a certain group of textile plants in the South. This is nothing new, either in the textile industry or in industry generally. We have seen strikes for many years in the past; we shall no doubt see strikes for many years in the future.

But it is not my purpose to discuss here the right to quit work. What I want to consider with you is the right to work.

If there is any one principle fundamental to the American way of life that is more important than all others, it is the right of the individual to make a living. It is part of the individual freedom that is the basis of our constitutional republican form of government. To deny the individual that right is to deny him his rights as an American citizen, is to thrust upon him an insidious form of slavery.

The people of the South are familiar with slavery. They suffered a terrible defeat in a war fought some eighty years ago over this question. That slavery was open and aboveboard. It was known for what it was—the ownership by purchase of members of a backward race brought from Africa. It was slavery that was doomed to eventual condemnation by all right-thinking persons and it was tragic that it had to be settled by force.

The slavery involved in the denial to the individual of his right to work is not so apparent—and perhaps for that reason is even more dangerous. But anything that denies a man his individual freedom, his right to carve out his own destiny, his right to plan his own career and provide for the welfare of himself and his family, is slavery just the same—and no amount of camouflage behind the intricacies of labor-management disputes will change it.

As a matter of fact, any thinking American who places freedom above special privilege realizes that the closed shop violates all the principles of liberty on which our American way of life is based. And this applies to the employer as well as to the employee. There are employers who accept the closed shop because it makes labor negotiations easier and more convenient for them. They are just as guilty of violating the principles of individual freedom as the labor union that attempts to enforce the closed shop.

And the worker should realize, too, that the closed shop is even more dangerous to him than to the employer. If freedom in a democratic country means anything, it means that a man has the right to join a union if he so desires, but it also means that he cannot be forced to join a union before he can get a job and make a living.

It is not to be believed that the majority of the American people would ever vote their approval of such an undemocratic practice as the closed shop. We may be sure the people of the South do not believe in it. Why, then, should small organized minority groups, taking advantage of particular situations, be allowed to force their will on the free individual citizen of America? Those who do not want to work have no right to deny employment to those who do want to work.

If the worker can have his rights taken away from him in this manner, then he had just as well live under a dictatorship or a communistic form of government, neither of which does more than deny him the same rights.

The American people cannot submit to the closed shop and have their country remain America as they have known it. It is therefore the duty of local government and responsible public officials in all communities in this land to preserve law and order in their localities, to maintain inviolate the right to work with perfect safety to all concerned. To do otherwise is to fail in their duty—and the result is anarchy and the destruction of freedom.

### TIDELANDS STEAL COULD HAVE BEEN PREVENTED

The Steal of the Tidelands could have been prevented if the members of Congress from the three affected States had put the interests of their constituency before that of party and had gone to bat over the issue.

Texas has twenty-one members in the Lower House of Congress. California has twenty-three and Louisiana eight.

An opposition bloc of fifty-two members could have prevented the passage of any bill which Truman proposed if these representatives had done a little teamwork and made a solemn vow between themselves to oppose every administration measure until Truman came to terms on the Tidelands matter.

That is the only language the president understands and the law of force is the only consideration he respects. He learned that from the Pendergast organization and the tactics of that underworld political machine should have been employed and used against him when he first started plotting the Big Steal.

Added to this House bloc could have been the six senators from the three States.

Of course Knowland and Nixon of California work overtime any way trying to upset Truman's applecart and in otherwise upholding the dignity of their office and of the Republic but while the Texas senators, of course, were opposed to him in the Tidelands matter, the FEPC and some other proposals which they would not dare champion, they are hump-shouldered from carrying the ball for Roosevelt and Truman, throughout the years.

Naturally when they help Truman put over his legislative proposals regardless of his lawless acts against their constituency, he will go just as far as he can and will have no fear of reprisals from that source.

It was the opportunity of a lifetime for the Congressmen and senators from these three States to get together and form a coalition bloc to operate in the protection of property rights of all citizens of this Republic and would have placed their names among the list of immortals in the annals of statesmanship.

But they fumbled the chance to render service and preferred, instead, to keep their party record straight and the fact that billions of dollars may be lost to their respective States is probably regarded by them as a minor consideration compared to the momentous responsibility of party regularity.

### Texas Governor Vetoed Bill For "Progressive Education"

Governor Allan Shivers of Texas is to be commended for his action in vetoing a textbook bill which passed the Legislature and which would have authorized the State Board of Education to combine subjects on recommendation of the textbook Committee of that group and the State Commissioner of Education.

The left-wing National Educational Association is constantly fostering legislation, through State educational groups, for "progressive education" and it was a lucky break for the people of Texas that the Governor was on the job and spotted this one and killed it off.

### Voters Reduce Membership Of "Permanent Committee"

On June 30, 1946, the Daily Worker, official Communist paper in this country, listed a permanent Congressional Committee of the "Win-the-Peace" organization, successor to the American Peace Mobilization classified by the then Attorney General Francis Biddle as a Communist Front. The organization was allegedly financed largely by Frederick Vanderbilt Field.

### Wrong in Principle

Chief counsel for the Communications Commission a few weeks back asked the FCC to close the three high-powered radio outlets owned by G. A. Richards of Los Angeles, KMPC at Los Angeles, WJR at Detroit and WGAR at Cleveland. The FCC attorneys contend that in news broadcasts under instructions there was discrimination against Democrats generally, the New Deal particularly, also against Jewish and other persons whom Richards disliked. ## Monumental Folly of the Experts Sets Taxpayers Back \$450,000,000

## Acheson Put Commies in State Department, Chicago Paper Says

The following excerpt from an article by Andrew Avery appeared in the Chicago Journal of Commerce on July 9, 1946, but is so timely now that it is well worth reproduction:

"... Matters have now reached such a point that the State Department says it is simply unable to get rid of Communists, because the civil service rules protect them. Consequently the Senate has voted authority to Secretary Byrnes to fire anybody he pleases.

This authority will be used very sparingly, however, if Undersecretary Dean Acheson has his way. Largely responsible for the strength of the Communists in the department, he has more than undone the good work of former Assistant Secretary Adolph A. Berle, in combatting them.

Apparently Acheson has been trying to show his totalitarian liberal friends in the New Republic, the Nation and the university faculties that a man can be a Wall Street lawyer and still adhere to their version of liberalism.

Cooperating with Freda Kichwey, editor of the Nation, he has applied prolonged pressure to the Spanish Loyalist Government in exile to force it to admit the Spanish Communists.

No wonder the proportion of Communists—or 'Progressives' as he calls them—in the State Department is even higher than elsewhere in the government . . ."

## Union Racketeers Thrive On Newspaper Publicity

In Houston and Fort Worth, loyal Americans appeared at their meetings and charged members of the group with distributing subversive literature and denounced them as undertaking to destroy our form of government, but in other places, they were accepted as reputable advocates of a great cause, thanks to the blind stupidity of those whom they seek to propagandize.

## Decision Points a New Low In Judicial Degredation

We do not share the fear of many people that Russia is likely to drop an atomic bomb on the United States.

There are two reasons for this lack of fear on our part.

First, we do not see why the Soviets would want to bomb us when they are making such remarkable ideological progress in this country, through their "bloodless revolution" carried on by their converts over here.

Second, it would be almost impossible for them to drop one of their "atomic pineapples" over the United States without hitting a Federal Judge and it's a cinch they would not want to conk out any of their buddies on the bench.

We feel that a spot that is especially free of danger from bombing is Washington, D. C., where a federal judge named Richmond B. Judge Keech fined Dr. Rumely \$1,000 and gave him a six-month suspended jail sentence for contempt of Congress.

It is one of the most dastardly outrages ever perpetrated against an American in not only his right, but his responsibility, to defend his country and its institutions against efforts to destroy it.

As surely as Sherman marched through Georgia, influences and ideas both openly and secretly, both brazenly and subtly, are being disseminated through every part of the ecclesiastical system to destroy segregation in the church.

This charge was made by the Methodist Voice, Clayton, Georgia, which claims also that colleges, universities, and theological seminaries are feeding young people with ideas which strike at the Southern way of life.

The matter promises to be a red hot issue in the general conference of the Methodist church which meets at Los Angeles in 1952.

Last month the only full and comprehensive report on Crime conditions in the United States relating to a connection between the underworld and politics which has yet been compiled, was made public.

This report makes that of the KeFauver Crime Investigating Committee of the Senate, appear as innocuous as a description of the back alley brawls of juvenile delinquents.

The two men conducting this investigation did so without benefit of television, radio or newspaper headlines and instead of spending hundreds of thousands of dollars travelling from coast to coast seeing the country, they concentrated their activities at the seat of criminal operations, remained in Washington and paid their own way.

Since neither of them are candidates for office, no punches were pulled and no efforts were made to cover up transactions which might reflect dishonor on a political party or discredit those seeking election under its banner.

The investigation was conducted by two reputable newspaper men, Fletcher Knebel and Jack Wilson, and their ple of the United States with the sordid story of graft and corruption one purpose was to acquaint the people with a network of underworld forces, resulting in an impregnable bulwark of protection for racketeers, influence-peddlers and political extortionists of all shades and blends. fat mouth and admits it.

Results of their investigation were published in Look Magazine on May 22 and the documented revelations are spine-chillers and blood curdlers to such Americans as still hold with the old-fashioned idea that taxpaying citizens are entitled to some small measure of honesty and integrity in the administration of their government.

Those who want an unexpurgated report of actual crime conditions in the United States and one which depicts the far-flung tie-in between underworld characters and Washington politicians should toss the KeFauver report in the waste basket and read the real McCoy as disclosed by these two fearless newspaper men.

One of the unsolved mysteries of the ages so far as we are concerned is why politicians constantly play up the "common people". Why is a common person any better or any more deserving of consideration than an uncommon one? We have lost lots of sleep wondering about this.

Parents who do not make it their business to acquaint themselves with the textbooks, programs and social activities of the schools which their children attend and who are indifferent to the things that are being taught them, may wake up some fine morning to find that they have a lot of little Soviets in their home.

### Investigating Committee Chairmen Are There To Get Facts And Not Headlines

Because of the disgraceful conduct of Frank Buchanan, Pennsylvania stooge for union labor bosses in Congress and chairman of the committee which "investigated" the Committee for Constitutional Government, and because of other similar groups which have performed for political effect, investigating committees are in rather low public esteem at the moment.

For this reason it is unfortunate that the Chairman of the Crime Investigating Committee of the Texas House of Representatives is apparently performing his task with his mind centered on headlines, rather than in concern for the serious business at hand.

While every responsible citizen is opposed to illegal acts of the underworld, at the same time, they also disapprove of unethical behavior of those investigating such acts.

In a statement given to the press in advance of a full investigation of an alleged Galveston gambling syndicate, the chairman of this committee promised that "when the notes of the investigation are transcribed and given out to the newspapers, there will be at least fifty sensational stories."

After all, in this country we do not presuppose the guilt of persons on trial and every man is presumed innocent until proved guilty and this applies to a gambler no less than to a banker, a lawyer, or a deep freeze salesman.

Men who are honored by appointment to the chairmanship of such committees are expected to perform with dignity and judicial fairness and to develop facts for evidence and not to uncover material for sensational stories.

If investigators, State and National, were compelled to conduct all investi-

gations behind closed doors without benefit of newspaper reporters, television, radio or other channels of vote-getting publicity, they would do a more creditable and effective job of developing pertinent and factual information. As it is, they can't resist the temptation to ham all over the place and to play up their findings in big headlines which—they hope—will be seen by the voters back home.

According to an article in the Christian Science Monitor the segregation of racial minorities is more pronounced in Chicago and New York than it is in the South. On-the-spot checks in ten widely separated cities, it was pointed out, disclosed that many Northern cities enforce segregation in housing more rigorously than they do South of the Mason and Dixon's line, the article continued. We have always known this to be true but we are glad to see the public admission. Segregation is not a matter of location. It is observed by the better element of citizenship in both the white and colored-races everywhere.

A Communist-inspired attack has been made on the Constitution of South Carolina which provides for segregation of the races in the public schools of that State. Suit has been brought by the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and those instituting the suit have made the usual threat to take it to their buddies on the Supreme Court in the event of an adverse decision by the South Carolina courts.

### Alabama Solon Proposes Share-The-Wealth Plan

Another illustration of how low the political morals of Fair Dealers have sunk and of their affinity for the Soviet Share-the-Wealth program as a basis of this country's policies was given in a recent proposal from Washington.

The plan which is said to have originated with ten members of the Senate, provides that the oil income from the Tidelands of Texas, Louisiana and California shall be distributed to all the States to be used for educational purposes.

Names of the senators sponsoring the plan were not made public in press dispatches with the exception of that of Senator Lister Hill of Alabama who has nothing to lose any way since he has long been recognized as one of the menials of the Fair Deal Party whose platform on social issues so nearly resembles that of the Communist Party that it is hard to distinguish between them.

As an example of the perverted thinking of the Alabama lawmaking genius, he actually advanced as one of the reasons for the proposed socializing of Tidelands oil, that it "would forestall nationalization as occurred in Iran."
