The first regular meeting of the University Student Senate was called to order by Maury Corp, President of the Senate. The invocation was given by Penny Dunham, Secretary of the Senate. Each senator received a roll sheet of information on the senators.

The oath of office was administered to the senators, except the senators from Law, Optometry, and Arts and Sciences, by the President of the Senate.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

The election of all Senate officers will be conducted at the next scheduled meeting. The officers are President Pro-Tempore and the Reporter.

The following committees were named:

Appropriations: Joe Chiaramonte-temporary chairman, Kirby Boston, Van Roll, Jay Kirk, and Robert Peterson.
Investigations: Mike Abbey-temporary chairman, Frank Lupo, Kenneth Mobley, James Parkhurst, and Rick Harral.
Legislative: Milton Sowa-temporary chairman, Taffy Lamping, and Otto Crenwelge.

Appointments for the remainder of the committees will be named at the next scheduled meeting of the Senate.

The next meeting of the Student Senate was set for November 5, 1962 at 8:00 P.M. in 104 Ezekiel Cullen building.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Senate Procedure Rules were explained to the Senate by Maury Corp. The President also explained that the Senate appointments to the Supreme Court would be made at the next meeting of the Senate. Mr. Corp reported that all financial bills should be given to him or the Secretary of the Senate seven days before each Senate meeting.

Rick Harral, Senator from Technology, moved that the Senate suspend the previous rule concerning the passage of bills and representation in the House of Representatives and amend the bill to read that the Senate will not consider a bill unless its sponsors are represented in the University of Houston House of Representatives. Kirby Boston seconded. It was moved that the motion be tabled. It was seconded. Motion to table passed. The bill, as amended, was placed on the table. It was moved that the Senate Procedure Rules be adopted. It was seconded. Motion to adopt the Senate Procedure Rules passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Kirby Boston, President of the Graduate Class, moved that the Senate change its meeting time from 8:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.. Frank Lupo seconded the motion. Motion passed. Thus, the Senate will meet on November 5, 1962 at 7:00 P.M..

The President of the Senate read over the major parts of the 1961-62 amended budget. There was discussion on the budget. Kirby Boston moved that the Senate table the budget. Frank Lupo seconded the motion. After continued discussion, Kirby Boston withdrew his motion to table the budget, and then moved that the budget have an expiration date of November 19, 1962 added to its contents. It was seconded. Motion passed.

Kirby Boston moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Mike Abbey. The President of the Senate adjourned the first meeting of the Student Senate.
