


HYATT REGENCY HOUSTON!



Hyatt Regency Houston has launched a new era in superior convention and meeting facilities. Hyatt Regency is Houston's great new space center, the largest hotel in the Southwest. Its thirty-three stories rise from the center of downtown Houston; a brilliant architectural statement anticipating the future.

Inside, the lobby soars 300 feet upward through the open atrium. Constant motion characterizes one angular corner of the atrium with a bank of flashing crystal elevators. Four of the glass-fronted elevators glide up through the atrium with a view of all the hotel excitement, and three capsules travel up the outer space of Hyatt Regency Houston offering spectacular views of the South's largest city.


Grande Suite Guest Room

The Imperial Ballroom

This is truly a ballroom in the regal tradition. It's magnificent. Enormous. A clear span space of 15,000 square feet of inviting red warmth dazzled by tapered strips of crystal beads glittering from cylindrical lighting fixtures.

The Imperial Ballroom is the center for Houston's social and business events. Meetings for 2,100. Banquets for 1,600. Grand balls and parties and receptions with the receiving line in the elegant Esplanade Foyer overlooking the Park in the Lobby.

The Imperial Ballroom has closed circuit television and stage facilities available, as well as the latest audiovisual equipment and multiple projection booths. The Ballroom divides into three separate and soundproof function rooms.




The Market Place Exhibit Hall

This 30,000 gross square foot air-conditioned area can accommodate 170 8' x 10' booths or 213 8' x 8' booths, with our Hyatt Hostesses directing traffic flow pattern from Ballroom via escalators to lobby elevators and stairwell.

Multi-purpose spaces may be used for additional booths, meeting rooms, registration, food and beverage bars, offices or lounges. Ceiling

height 12' 0" unless otherwise indicated. Full service outlets with easy freight access. Room may be subdivided into sections. Minimum 8' aisles. Good flow patterns. Floor load unlimited. Public address system.







Convention and Meeting Facilities

The Arboretum balcony overlooks the lobby from the second level and is ideal for receptions. The Arboretum serves as one large room, or easily divides into as many as five conference rooms.

The Imperial Ballroom, on the third level, is easily reached by elevators and double escalators. The Ballroom is serviced by its own kitchen, an autolift, and the gracious Esplanade Foyer for registration, displays, receiving lines and cocktail parties. There are eight additional meeting or function rooms on the third level.

Eleven meeting and banquet rooms are located on the fourth level, easily accessible by elevators or extra-wide staircases from the third level. Third and fourth level meeting rooms are distinguished by attractively colored carpets and wall coverings, and by a graphic mural symbolizing the tree for which each room is named.

The sixth level of Hyatt Regency Houston has 26 additional convertible meeting and display Executive Studio rooms.



The Market Place Exhibit Hall

The lower level 30,000 square foot Market Place Exhibit Hall accommodates 170 8' x 10' or 213 8' x 8' booths. All meeting facilities are equipped for public address, projection, and rheostat lighting. In addition, conference rooms have instant access walls containing a movie screen, chalk and tack board.



The top floor of Hyatt Regency Houston is devoted to lavish suites. Houston, Texas
