## Supreme Court Rulings Greater Threat To National Security Than Enemy's Missiles

### Senators Get Trapped In A Dead-End Tunnel

Members of the United States Senate, like prairie dogs, seem to prefer to circulate through underground tunnels.

The only difference is that the prairie dogs dig their own holes and know what they're doing.

Recently the Senators spent three million dollars in having an underground subway built for themselves only to find that, like practically every other project which they launch, they had gummed up the works.

When the unfortunate venture was halted, it was discovered that they had a nice cozy tunnel which reduced travel time by a wide margin but the catch was that it only had one opening and the only place it led to was nowhere. So the project had fizzled and the hard-earned taxpayers' money was flushed down the sewer.

The affair caused the Daily Oklahoman to remark editorially: "In digging a brand new three million-dollar subway that didn't go anywhere, the Senate ended up about par for the hole."

The big idea in the first place was to save the valuable time of the statesmen by enabling them to rush from their offices into the senate chamber to vote without ever having to come up for air.

We are sure that they were sincere in their belief that this intended time-saving device was in the public interest and that it is important for them to arrive at their seats in double-quick time when the moment for balloting on an important national issue has arrived.

But from their past voting record, it is our considered opinion that if a majority of them got lost and never arrived there at all, it would be too soon.

### WE DIDN'T RAISE ANY RICE EITHER AND WE DEMAND THAT WE GET PAID FOR IT

All over the country the people are becoming thoroughly aroused and are shocked and amazed to learn that millions of their tax dollars are being paid by a Washington government agency to phony "farmers" for not planting any crops or doing any work.

Personally, we are not only shocked, we are downright furious because we feel that we are the victim of a type of injustice which makes all this "discrimination" we hear so much about seem like preferred treatment and special favor.

Recently the Agricultural Adjustment Agency in Washington was reported in the press as having paid a citizen in Arkansas and one in Mississippi one million dollars each. This money was not paid to them for growing rice but for NOT growing rice.

Well, we didn't grow any rice either — not one single grain — and they didn't pay us a cockeyed cent.

Not only did we not grow any rice, but we don't even own any land on which we could have not grown any rice and this should entitle us to an extra bonus in addition to the one million dollars which is rightfully due us for not growing any rice.

For if they are morally and legally justified in paying a citizen for not growing rice, why in the name of Karl Marx can't they pay that same citizen for not owning any land on which to not grow any rice?

This line of reasoning is clearly in accord with the new law of economics as practiced by our modern statesmen and obviously we are the recipient of a dirty deal.

We want our money and we intend to contact the cashier of the Soil Bank and demand payment.

It was not by chance that the Constitution of the United States provided for life tenure for justices of the Supreme Court. And it was by design that their selection is through appointment by the President rather than by a vote of the people as in the case of those who serve in the Executive and Legislative branches of the Federal government. The decision to have members of the Judiciary chosen in this manner stemmed from the firm determination of founders of the Republic to lift those who administer final human justice to a lofty level of service where partisan considerations would not sway their judgment nor political, economic and social whims of the moment soil, debase and contaminate their legal opinions. In carefully erecting these safeguards around the nation's highest tribunal, early day patriots confidently believed that they were insuring the purity and incorruptibility of the Bench. Within their hearts was the solemn conviction that the Court would be forever stacked with men possessed of a deep and profound knowledge of organic law, endowed with a full measure of personal integrity and committed, without reservation, to the preservation of the institutions, traditions and internal security of the United States. There was no way for them to pierce the impenetrable veil of the future and envision a day when these exalted posts would be filled by men of Lilliputian stature who would hold in contempt the Constitutional rights of law-abiding citizens but regard as sacred the Civil Rights of Communist saboteurs and Negro rapists.

The President of the United States is tentatively planning to hold a "summit conference" with a murderous dictator within the next few months in the hope of saving this country from some future attack.

Meantime, fearful Americans are wondering what it shall profit us to avoid having our physical structures leveled by lethal bombs dropped on us by the Communists so long as our basic institutions are being razed by deadly decisions hurled down by the Supreme Court of the United States.

Of all the hostile forces which have conspired to liquidate Constitutional Government in the American Republic and make it impotent in resisting those who seek its overthrow, no element has done a more devastating demolition job than those who compose the nation's Court of Last Resort.

One by one the rulings of these judicial vultures have stripped the Constitution bare of its priceless guarantees, denuded it of its basic authority over cherished concepts and have left this immortal document flapping in the wind as a gaunt and forbidding specter of the vital, living symbol of human freedom which it was designed to embody.

The Supreme Court was created by the Federal Judiciary Act of September 24, 1789 and for the first century and a half thereafter its justices represented the cream of the nation's legal minds.

Being human, not all of them were infallible in their conclusions but they were honest, able and experienced jurists who would have contemplated in sheer horror the handing down by the Court of a rigged ruling or the deliberate perversion of the Constitution to make it bolster an ignoble purpose. Their loyalty to the American governing system was beyond question and their personal integrity unchallenged.

## American People Will Forget Statesmanship And Settle for A Little Plain Horse Sense

If there is any consistency in the actions of our so-called leaders, we are totally unable to see it.

At this time, our diplomats are in Geneva holding conferences which may, or may not, wind up in having American soldiers fight to protect the Germans from the Russians while a few years back, it was the other way around and American soldiers were dying while protecting the Russians from the Germans.

There are many responsible citizens in this country who think that in World War II we should have let the Nazi Germans and the Communist Russians kill off each other and should have stayed out of it.

But, of course, we sided with the Communists, gave them lend lease (which they never paid back) and otherwise aided them when they were attacked by Germany. And when we had the Japanese whipped we let them come in to take the spoils of war. Now we are paying the penalty for our folly.

All of which proves beyond any shadow of doubt that early American patriots knew exactly what they were talking about when they warned against entangling foreign alliances.

We have spent nobody knows how many billions of dollars to protect foreign countries from Communism with no results whatever except to help impoverish our own treasury and plunge the nation in debt which may never be paid.

Scheming and unprincipled world politicians deliberately set out to make "Isolationism" a dirty word, and those who direct the destiny of the American Republic fell for it with the result that we are hopelessly involved with so many alien brawls that our own security has been seriously endangered.

For years the American people have been desperately crying out for some evidence of statesmanship on the part of our national leaders which would put an end to the insane policy of supporting foreign governments at the expense of the American economy, but to no avail.

Now they would settle for just a little plain, common horse sense and a realization on the part of those who frame our policies of government that self-protection is the primary instinct of civilized human beings and that national suicide will inevitably follow in the case of a country whose leaders flaunt this universal impulse for survival.

A couple of Houston men have announced that they are going into the "foreign aid" business on their own. They plan to go to Okinawa to seek out young men who are capable and set them up in business, and lend them money to run it. If we were in their place, we would have looked up some deserving young Americans and set them up in business instead of journeying half way across the world to find subjects for our philanthropy projects. Their action seems cockeyed to us.

## Fired School Official Tells Only Half of Story

It is perhaps only natural that when a person is fired off the job, he should feel resentful toward those who discharged him and want to discredit them.

This apparently was the reaction of Mr. Virgil Blossom who was asked to resign as head of the public school system in Little Rock. His chagrin is understandable.

It seems rather unusual, however, for a reputable publication to provide such a person with the medium for venting his spleen against those who offended him.

In his series of articles on Little Rock in the Saturday Evening Post, Blossom devotes half his offering to proving how right he was and the other half to presenting the viewpoint of Negroes in the Little Rock school integration squabble.

It is assumed that later the Post will grant equal space to some reputable citizen of Little Rock who is able to give an honest, unbiased and truthful version of the unhappy situation there. It would seem to be due the overwhelming number of white persons who compose Little Rock's population that this consideration be shown them.

*This excerpt is from a bulletin just issued by the State Department titled "Background" which gives what it calls "Highlights of Foreign Policy Developments—1958." "The interests of the United States, which our foreign policy would safeguard and promote, include the lives and homes of our people, their confidence and peace of mind, their economic well-being and their ideals." By common consent they lived and labored in a rarefied judicial atmosphere far above the storm, strife and dissension which attend the discussions in councils of State where men must face and resolve bitter partisan and controversial issues.

Their functions were specifically laid out for them in the Constitution and this they understood and respected. To discharge their lofty obligation required their full time, talent and attention and they held aloof from participation in extraneous activities in which lesser public servants might consistently engage.

The American people expected them to perform in a manner befitting the dignity and prestige of their exalted positions and their irreproachable personal and official conduct was taken for granted.

If one of them had stepped down from the Bench to address and bestow praise on a radical labor group, to testify as a character witness for a traitor accused of giving top-secret government documents to the enemy or used the treatise of an alien Marxist on which to base a ruling affecting the lives and freedoms of the American people, he would have had impeachment charges preferred against him before sun-down.

It was during the Roosevelt administration when the evangels of International Socialism first gained the ear of a few members of the Court and convinced them that in a "changing world" their decisions should be geared to the New Order so as to establish social trends, promote the interests of minority groups and influence public opinion in favor of the Liberal cause.

Three Internationalist Presidents in a row — Roosevelt, Truman and Eisenhower — contributed to the total disintegration of the Court as a judicial body and its emergence as a social-legislative agency by naming as justices one low-grade political hack after another until today it is completely swamped with miserable incompetents who are brimming over with "social consciousness" but whose combined legal knowledge, with one or two exceptions, would not far surpass that required of the average Justice of the Peace.

Until recently, perhaps the most vicious assault on the Constitution by these judicial imposters occurred in May of 1954 when they ruthlessly struck down the Tenth Amendment and made the sovereign States the wards of the Federal government. But this deed of infamy was recently tied, if not exceeded, when they made their repudiation of the Constitution complete by ripping out that cherished provision which guarantees that a man's home is his castle which no officer of the law may enter without benefit of an official search warrant.

In the interim between these two major attacks on organic American principles, they have handed down rulings which have emptied our prisons of Communist saboteurs thereby implying legal sanction to plots for overthrowing the American government; they have tacitly given assurance to Negro criminals that their heinous crimes against White women of the South do not necessarily subject them to the terrors of the gas chamber or a dangling rope; they have taken away from local school officials the right to fire teachers who are infecting the minds of American youth with the poison of Communism; they have taken away from State courts the right to bring seditionists to trial; have hampered the Federal Bureau of Investigation in its war on criminals and curtailed the power of Congressional committees to investigate Soviet spies.

By bringing down on itself almost universal criticism for the unethical behavior of its members, including the condemnation of the American Bar Association, the Court has practically destroyed its capacity to longer serve the American people in the role of a fair and unbiased judicial body commissioned to administer justice without fear or favor.

At this time when the basic principles of the American Republic are under attack from many fronts throughout the world, the Supreme Court should be our first line of defense against our enemies and the nation's bulwark of strength in the fight to maintain the freedom which millions of Americans have fought and died to preserve.

Instead of going to Geneva to fight a losing battle of words with Khrushchev, the President could make the American people feel safer and enable them to sleep better at night if he would take vital action in the fight against Communism here at home.

This he could do by asking for the resignations of all members of the Court and replacing them with nine able and impeccable jurists who have a deep and abiding respect for the Constitution and a proper regard for the basic rights of all Americans — rather than those of a selected few — and who would restore that great judicial body to the high place it once held in public esteem.

## Texas Lawmakers Act to Preserve Solvency of Federal Government

A Resolution was passed by both the House and Senate of the Texas Legislature recently which could become a vital instrument for preserving the financial solvency of the United States if a sufficient number of other State lawmaking bodies take similar action.

The Resolution provides that the Federal government shall discontinue engaging in any business except that specified in the Constitution and calls for the repeal of the ratification of the Sixteenth Amendment to the Constitution after a period of three years.

Following is the text of the Resolution:

"Section 1. The Government of the United States shall not engage in any business, professional, commercial, financial or industrial enterprise except as specified in the Constitution.

"Section 2. The Constitution or laws of any State, or the laws of the United States shall not be subject to the terms of any foreign or domestic agreement which would abrogate this amendment.

"Section 3. The activities of the United States Government which violate the intent and purposes of this amendment shall, within a period of three years from the date of ratification of this amendment, be liquidated and the properties and facilities affected shall be sold.

"Section 4. Three years after the ratification of this amendment the sixteenth article of amendments to the Constitution of the United States shall stand repealed and thereafter Congress shall not levy taxes on personal incomes, estates, and/or gifts."

A similar Resolution was recently passed in Wyoming and it is pending in several States where legislatures are in session. Action by 34 States will be necessary to compel Congress to submit the Resolution back to the States for ratification. Approval by three-fourths of the States will be necessary to make it effective.

The passage of the Resolution in the Texas Legislature was masterminded by the Honorable Jerry Sadler, East Texas lawmaker, who is widely recognized as one of the ablest members of the Texas House of Representatives.

Texans who are properly critical of their representatives who vote for unsound measures should be equally vigilant in this case and highly commend their lawmakers for this act of statesmanship.

## Presbyterians Leave Religious Matters Out of Assembly Talks

How the tenets of Christian faith have been destroyed in some Protestant churches of this country by the forces of International Communism, both at home and abroad, was forcefully illustrated at the recent Presbyterian Assembly held in Indianapolis.

The candidate for the Presidency of the denomination's theological seminary at San Francisco was openly accused by a small segment of those in attendance of having publicly expressed disbelief in the Virgin Birth of Christ. The minister in question, Rev. Theodore A. Gill of California, did not deny the charge. Editorials were read which he had written when he was associate editor of the Christian Century, a publication frequently referred to as the theological edition of the Daily Worker, which confirmed the charges made against the Rev. Mr. Gill.

The matter was laughed off by the majority in attendance and Rev. Gill was elected.

Anti-Christian forces in this country have repeatedly boasted that they are breaking down such "superstitions" as this and that they furnish much of the literature used in study courses of Protestant Sunday Schools and Churches.

Some of the extremely peculiar subjects which were discussed at Indianapolis and which, incidentally, did not include any matters touching on religion, were Birth Control, Sex, NAACP, Federal grants to education, right to work laws, abolishment of capital punishment, Federal housing, and the admission of Communist China into the United Nations.

## How Free Is This 'Home of the Free?'

Recently when a Protestant congregation in a Western State attempted to build a church, they were asked by church officials authorized to grant permission for the building whether or not they were members of the National Council of Churches.

In California, where they have a "fair trade" law, a druggist sold a bottle of Alka-Seltzer for fourteen cents, which was less than the price asked by other dealers. For this "offense" the druggist was thrown in jail for twenty days.

In Minnesota, the chairman of the Governor's Human Rights Commission demanded that the mayors of five cities in that State where a respected Oklahoma Evangelist was scheduled to hold meetings, cancel his speaking dates and not allow him to use "tax supported buildings" for his sermons. The Oklahoma minister has been guilty of the heinous crime of preaching from the Bible instead of from the Communist Manifesto and of making a vigorous fight against Communism in the pulpit. His name is the Rev. Billy James Hargis.

Perhaps in a gesture of atonement to a good American who was driven from his country through persecution of agents of the Department of Agriculture, the Senate has voted to eliminate the provision in the Agricultural Adjustment Act which limited the acreage which American farmers are entitled to plant in wheat in the event it is raised for non-market purposes.

It was in administering this Act that agents of the Federal government confiscated the bank account and farm machinery of Stanley Yankus, Michigan farmer who in heartbreak, discouragement and disgust left his home and moved to Australia.

This is one small step in the right direction on the part of the Senate but only by the elimination of the whole sorry statute will they be able to clear their record of Socialist leanings in the passage of this legislation.

And the chances are that the House will never concur even in eliminating the wheat acreage provision. It is too thickly cluttered with Socialists.

*In Texas where a proposal was made to investigate the expenditure of \$685,000 by the Texas State Teachers' Association, the executive secretary of that organization, a man named Tennyson broke into the press with the startling announcement that it was none of the public's business what the association did with its money. ## Federated Clubwomen Are Given Some Facts of Life

The delegates to the convention of the General Federation of Women's Clubs in Los Angeles were told by one of their speakers that an appalling number of American high school students believe that Socialism is a better form of government than our American system.

He said that a recent survey revealed that fifty-five per cent of the students contacted believed in the Socialist slogan "From each according to his ability and to each according to his needs."

Why shouldn't these particular students, and all others, be Socialists? It was "planned that way" wasn't it?

For twenty-five years educationists have drummed it into the heads of young persons that Marxism is the ideal economic pattern. Through subtle propaganda, learned from the National Education Association, they have influenced the minds of students against the American system of Free Enterprise with the deliberate intention of converting them into One-World Socialists. And on Sunday these same students have heard Marxism preached from the pulpit in a tragic number of cases. How could they be anything but Socialists?

And since Socialism and Communism are identical, where does that leave this country in the matter of its citizens of tomorrow?

Most Americans have remained passive while this infiltration of their children's minds was taking place and those of us who have shouted a warning about the situation for years have largely been regarded as some strange specimen from another planet who was speaking in an unknown tongue.

For that matter what have the women's clubs, by and large, done in the fight against the horrible menace of Marxism? They have the facilities and the organization but lesser subjects have taken precedence.

We wonder if they came away from Los Angeles with a feeling of guilt and a determination to enlist in the fight being waged by hopelessly outnumbered American patriots.

*To us, it is regrettable that a minister who has been a member of nine organizations cited by official investigating committees of Congress as Communist fronts, should have been selected to officiate at the funeral services of John Foster Dulles. That is the record of Rev. Roswell P. Barnes, Secretary of the World Council of Churches. Of course if it was felt that it was necessary to have some one from the World Council, it would have been difficult to get one from that group who did not have similar affiliations. But since Mr. Dulles was held up as a vigorous opponent of Communism, it seems incongruous that a Communist Fronter should have been permitted to participate in his funeral rites.*

## Is District of Columbia About to Go on the Rocks?

The District of Columbia is in a bad way and the situation there is getting no better fast, according to a two-column press release from Washington recently.

In the first place, the District is fresh out of money and they don't know where any more is coming from. The reason for this is that with the removal of so many white people from downtown Washington, tax sources are drying up since a heavy percentage of the Negroes who have replaced White people are on relief and are not potential taxpayers. The majority of Washington residents now are colored.

The District of Columbia Commissioners who run the city are weeping and wailing and gnashing their teeth because Washington is lagging behind the rest of the country in growth of income, employment and retail sales.

The Commissioners who have already imposed an income tax and a sales tax are considering the levying of a payroll tax and there is a prospect that they will have to invent new forms of taxation which will bring in revenue and yet not scare the rest of the White revenue-producing citizens away from the city.

The financial angle, bad as it is, is only part of the sad story of the city on the Potomac.

Serious health and welfare needs have arisen in the wake of the heavy influx of colored people from the South, trainloads of whom are arriving each day. The high rate of illegitimacy "constitutes not only a moral threat to this community but also a significant financial drain." In 1957, for instance there were 3,732 illegitimate births in the District, all except 345 being Negroes and since the Socialistic custom of paying women to have illegitimate babies has been incorporated in government policies in this country, it takes a mint of money to subsidize the surplus production of this human crop.

Tuberculosis and alcoholism are mounting problems and unemployment, especially among Negroes, is terrific. The heavy majority of Negroes who flock into Washington have practically no money, no job and no prospect of getting one. But hotels, restaurants, theaters and schools are de-segregated and when the poor black people get hungry they can tighten their belts and take consolation in that.

Meantime, politicians who have been playing a game with Negroes as the pawns are learning fast. They are finding out that the colored race is largely non-productive in everything except children and that as potential taxpayers, on the whole, they must be counted out.

They come in handy as bait for politicians to use when fishing for votes or plugging for a social cause but when the chips are down, they must rely largely on the White race for support.

Colored folks in the South were doing all right until the Soviet propaganda campaign went into action and they always knew that, in a

## Puppets of International Communism Are Active in Many Areas of United States

In Minneapolis, on recent Sunday mornings, an astonishing type of "pledge card" was found in the pews by the worshippers in local churches who attended morning services. With a line for the signature this card said:

"I will welcome into my neighborhood any person of good character, regardless of race, color or national origin."

The sponsors of the cards, according to a press report, are the Greater Minneapolis Council of Churches, an affiliate of the National Council of Churches of Christ and it is frankly admitted that the objective is to break down the barriers of residential segregation in the desirable areas of the leading cities of the United States.

At the same time these cards appeared in Minneapolis, similar ones popped up in pews of Protestant churches in Palo Alto, Santa Clara and several other California cities. Also in Philadelphia, Hartford, Connecticut, Lincoln, Nebraska, and Champaign, Illinois local churches have helped to obtain hundreds of signatures for full-page newspaper advertisements proclaiming the willingness of the signers to have Negroes for neighbors.

And in order to break down restrictive real estate covenants which seek to keep property values up in exclusive neighborhoods, churches in Ann Arbor, Michigan, have asked their members to sign "open occupancy covenants" to permit Negroes to buy residences

## Twin Threats to the Internal Security of the United States

James R. What is needed is not new amendments but strict enforcement of those already in the Constitution.

Not one school in the South can legally be integrated under the Constitution and if State officials in the South had the integrity, courage and stamina they should have not one single school would be integrated.

The Tenth Amendment to the Constitution says: "The power not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people."

## Socialism Tightens Its Hold On American Government

The bill was rushed through the House in a few minutes with no opposition and all the brothers, sisters, cousins, uncles, aunts, step-fathers and mothers-in-law will continue to draw salaries which they could not hope for in any other job.

The technique used was that developed by the Communists and which is gaining increasing popularity in this country.

The Commies teach that if something to which the people are opposed is to be put over, do it quietly, quickly and with no fanfare.

The House demonstrated that this is the safest way.

## We Could Tell In Advance What This Ruling Will Be

The Supreme Court has agreed to review the "Constitutionality" of two Arkansas city ordinances which require the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People to file its membership list and make financial statements.

The decision to make this review came on the same day that foreign-born Court Justice Felix Frankfurter lectured his associates on the Court for "hearing too many cases that are important only to the litigants."

He urged that they stick to the "cases for the adjudication of which this Court exists."

But he didn't disagree when the Court decided to mix into the business of Little Rock citizens and review something which is of no concern to the Court whatever.

The reason for this is because Negroes were involved and when they play the tune Supreme Court Justices always go into their dance.

The Court was requested to review the matter by two Little Rock Negro women, one Daisy Bates and one Birdie Williams.

If the Court runs true to form, the "review" will be largely a formality and the findings will of course be in the interest of the colored race.

Recently, according to newspaper reports, Adlai Stevenson said that raising the standards of backward countries by sending them American dollars is more important to the United States than even our own defense. ## GOVERNMENT WHICH GIVES BILLIONS TO FOREIGNERS REFUSES PAYMENT OF DEBT

In our opinion the saga of R. B. DeWitt, a Dallas geophysicist, is one of the most side-splitting revelations ever committed to paper even though it tragically portrays the strange behavior of the American government toward one of its sovereign citizens.

Mr. DeWitt has a very real grievance against the powers that be in Washington who for more than forty years have refused to grant him redress for the wrongs he has suffered.

Having exhausted every resource short of direct appeal to the United Nations which could be employed to secure payment of money due him, Mr. DeWitt listed his woes in a 64-page brochure which he has addressed to "about Sixty-Four Per Cent of the United States Senators and Members of Congress" and mailed direct to them.

Apparently the only compensation he is going to get at this late day is the sheer joy of publishing the full story of the government's indebtedness to him and including therein some of the expenditures which have been made to alien countries even though his own rightful claim was denied.

The story goes back to World War I and the Spring of 1918 when, as Mr. DeWitt points out, "There was a speaker on practically every street corner in the United States either selling war bonds, asking for donations to the Red Cross or for volunteers for the Army. We were being told in no uncertain terms that if we did not raise money and men in a hurry, the Kaiser would get us for sure. In fact, we were in more of a tailspin than that we are now about the Sputnik."

Mr. DeWitt was County Auditor at Groesbeck, Texas, at the time and since he knew practically everybody he was singled out for the distinction of raising and sponsoring a company of soldiers by a recruiting official who had breezed in from Washington to work up enthusiasm at the grass roots.

"The only catch was that the sponsor would have to pay all the expenses until the soldiers were inducted," Mr. DeWitt explains. Fired by the blaring of brass bands and by the patriotic slogans which had sprung up like mushrooms for "Saving the world for Democracy," Mr. DeWitt agreed to raise troops to fight for this desirable end. He didn't have the money himself but found someone who would advance it to him, so he borrowed it. Several pages of the brochure are devoted to his efforts to get men to enlist and to the trips he made to surrounding towns and crossroads stores until he had finally mustered up an imposing company of raw recruits all ready and eager to go forth and do battle for "Democracy."

The expense of feeding and sheltering the troops while enlisting amounted to \$4,100, Mr. DeWitt writes. He made arrangements for a local cafe to feed them at 33-1/3 cents per meal per man and got the courthouse janitor to do their washing. He rented a vacant building to

serve as quarters which they occupied until sent to training camps.

"In the meantime I decided to take some of my own medicine, so I resigned as County Auditor and enlisted myself," Mr. DeWitt says. After finishing officers training camp he was ordered to prepare for overseas duty. Then, out of a clear sky the Armistice was signed and Mr. DeWitt and his company were caught with their uniforms down.

It was at this point that the greatest badger game in history was played on an American citizen. Mr. DeWitt was left holding the sack and he's still holding it.

After being honorably discharged he got his job back as County Auditor of Limestone County and started paying back the \$4,100 he had borrowed to recruit a company for Uncle Sam's Army.

Meantime, he prepared an itemized statement and attached original receipts covering the \$4,100 and filed the claim for payment. Nothing happened.

The bill was kicked around from one department to another and became so enmeshed in red tape that it finally vanished altogether. When the statute of limitation was about to expire, Mr. DeWitt thought of filing suit for his claim but was discouraged by his advisors on the ground that such action would not be patriotic and that the government would certainly pay its just debt finally.

The years passed and the claim was not paid and as late as 1958 Mr. DeWitt was still working on it although the money was no longer important. He had spent more than the amount involved in expenses in trying to collect. No doubt he continued to press the subject as a matter of principle and possibly to find out for himself if his government, which distributes its money so prodigally to practically any foreign supplicant, would actually repudiate a debt of honor to a citizen of the United States.

The Secretary of the Army has approved Mr. DeWitt's claim as have several others high in the nation's armed forces and a House Resolution was introduced calling for payment of the debt. Nothing happened.

The Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Committee seemed to dispose of the matter on March 5 of last year when he wrote Mr. DeWitt that his committee had decided to postpone indefinitely action on the bill "by reason of the considerable number of years which have elapsed since the claim arose."

"Before I got too old to travel to Washington, I had hoped that you might call me to come before your Committee and explain this claim," Mr. DeWitt wrote, and added:

"I know it would have been a pleasure to have a citizen appear before you who had never taken the Fifth Amendment. I would have given you my name without even consulting an attorney. I would have even told you that I am not now a Communist, never have been a Communist and would want to

## Taxpayers Being Fleeced By Gang of Political Con Men

There is a fight raging in Congress over the provisions of the Marxist Federal Housing bill, but there is no movement in that body to put an end to this rotten Socialistic legislation and to prohibit the Federal government from continuing to engage in the real estate business.

Sending enough drugs, medical supplies and hypodermic needles to the little country of Laos to supply all Southeast Asia.

Sending boatloads of expensive electric equipment to localities in the Philippines where no electric power is available.

Spending \$18,000,000 on a hundred-mile strip of road in Thailand and \$45,000,000 for a road through a jungle which nobody wanted or will use.

Paying the High Commissioner of one little island in the Pacific \$61,500 per year to run his office, or an average of \$85 per native to be supervised.

Paying \$4,000,000 for purchase of trees for States that had not asked for them or \$4,710 travel expenses in the city of Washington looking for a site for the location of a monument to Franklin D. Roosevelt.

Paying \$40,000 for listing historic points in Boston when such points had already been listed and were being distributed free by every bus, railroad and airline in the city.

Increasing travel expense of the Bureau of Foreign Commerce by 600 per cent.

Spending \$33,712,000 for a new museum "when all you can put in it is a history of how we became broke."

Spending \$60,000,000 for a new office building for members of Congress.

Spending \$30,000,000 in 1958 for "The Pursuit of Love of Undesignated Countries" which was stamped "Must" and "Secret."

## Look Who's Going to Teach American Youth Economics

## News of Race Riot Limited To Local Kansas City Papers

A race riot occurred in Kansas City on April 10th but news concerning it was limited to small mention in Kansas City papers and the affair was apparently suppressed in outside publications.

The riot followed an ROTC circus in the Municipal auditorium and while Kansas City residents declare that at least five hundred Negroes were involved, local officials undertook to dismiss the incident as "rowdyism" on the part of a few white and colored students, and brushed it off as "adolescent misbehavior."

Several were injured, windows were smashed in stores, motor cars were damaged and the melee which started in front of the auditorium "worked its way Eastward past Grand Avenue," according to the Kansas City Star.

There have been many similar incidents all over the country since the Supreme Court integration decision which shocked responsible Americans in 1954, but news of such affairs is suppressed whenever possible for fear that it will hinder continued efforts to integrate in the South.

## POWERFUL GROUP DEALS A KNOCK-OUT BLOW TO THE CAUSE OF CHRISTIANITY

Those who have sworn to destroy Christianity in the United States, an avowed Christian nation, have made such alarming headway that it was decided to offer an amendment to the Constitution re-affirming that ours is a Christian nation.

This amendment which is now before Congress reads: "This nation devoutly recognizes the authority and law of Jesus Christ, Saviour and Ruler of nations, through whom are bestowed the blessings of almighty God."

In view of the purpose and the wording of the proposed amendment, it was not expected that it would meet with any appreciable opposition.

But there was opposition — and from a very powerful source.

This opposition did not come from the Communist Party of the United States nor from Soviet agents who work feverishly to infiltrate all churches and religious activities in this country.

It did not come from any organization or group of atheists who would be expected to protest the adoption of such an amendment.

The opposition came from the National Council of Churches of Christ in the U.S.A.

On June 5, the Associated Press carried a story with a Seattle date-line stating that the General Board of the National Council of Churches of Christ meeting in that city went on record, 59 to 1, against this amendment which would proclaim the United States as a Christian Nation. The Board was quoted in the story as basing its opposition on the grounds that such a step would "embarrass the relations of American churches and the nation with the world majority of non-Christians."

If we are not mistaken, the Protestant churches of the United States have spent millions of dollars in the past century sending missionaries abroad to convert "non-Christians" to Christianity. Now the self-proclaimed representative of thirty-five to forty million American Protestants, the National Council of Churches, repudiates and discredits the work of all the good men and women who have spent their lives in heathen countries trying to convert natives to Christianity, by bowing to the "world majority of non-Christians" and refusing to admit that we are a Christian people.

What are the heathens in foreign lands who have been converted to Christianity to think about such action? That they have been gypped and that Christianity is a fraud if its own leaders are ashamed to confess their belief in it?

The Council's official action at Seattle is, we believe, the first time it has come out flat-footed against Christianity and in favor of Communism which of course also opposes the adoption of the amendment and no decent American can contemplate this action on the part of the Council without trembling in his boots over the future of Christianity in the United States.

If the Council's claim as to membership is accurate and if the Council speaks for its members, it means that between thirty-five and forty million good Protestants in the United States refuse to admit they are Christians for fear of embarrassing "non-Christians."

If this does not cause real bonafide Christians to demand that their denomination withdraw from the National Council of Churches, it means that the fight to destroy Christianity in the United States has largely been won.
