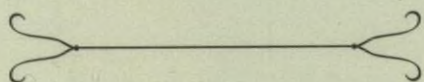

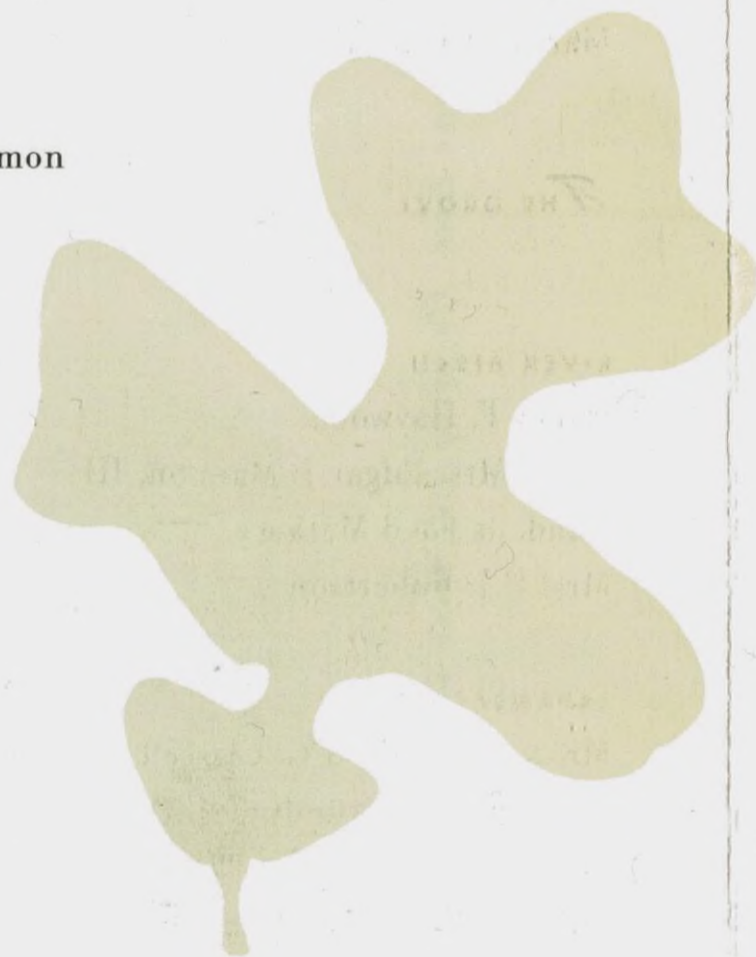
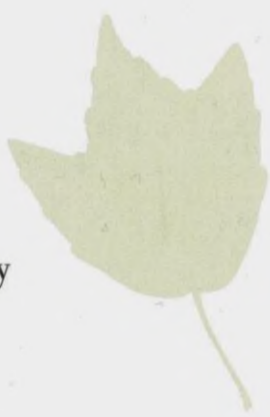

MISSION STATEMENT

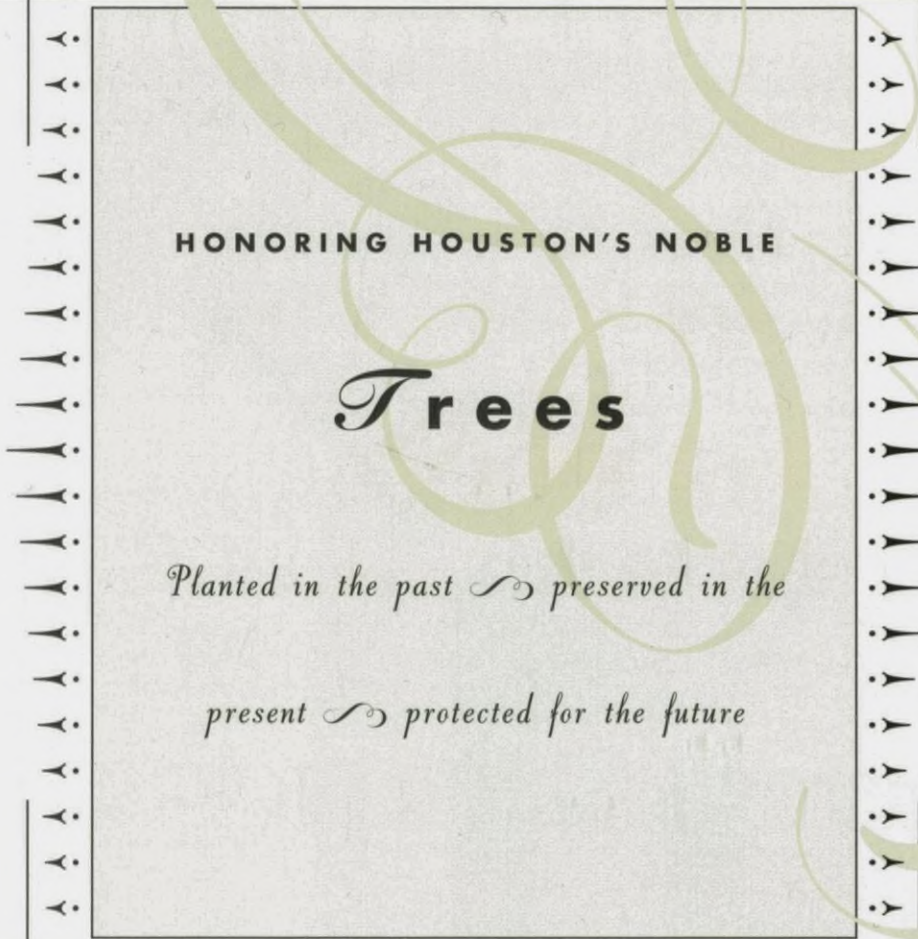
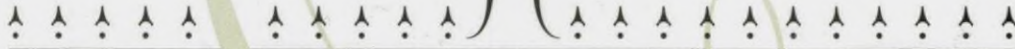
