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## Unless Freedom-Loving Americans Organize And Start Fighting It Won't Be Long Now

### Naked Federal Tyranny Is Exercised Against Sovereign State Of Louisiana

As we go to press, the American people are witnessing one of the most disgraceful examples of naked tyranny and the most flagrant abuse of power on the part of a strong central government that the citizens of any country have been called on to attest in the history of civilized man.

High-handed and arrogant Federal judges, backed by the Attorney General of the United States, are bearing down on the Sovereign State of Louisiana with all the weight and force of usurped authority to whip that great Commonwealth down to its knees in the matter of conducting its public schools as the overwhelming majority of Louisiana citizens desire them to be conducted.

Under the American form of government, State authority is paramount to that of the Federal Government since the States created the Federal Government and delegated to it limited powers and such powers did not include the right to impose its will on the sources of its creation.

Because Governors of the various States have degenerated into spineless, meek and lowly beggars who trudge to Washington, hat in hand, imploring alms bought with their own money, the idea has grown in Washington that all power is vested in bloated bureaucrats who clog up the atmosphere of that degenerate stronghold of entrenched power like rotting carrion.

Louisiana's able and courageous Governor Jimmy Davis is throwing every resource at his command into the effort to stem this invasion of Federal interlopers into his Constitutional Domain, but the odds are against him and against his chances of exercising his rightful authority granted him in the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution.

The Federal Machine, fed by inexhaustible tax dollars and bolstered by usurped authority, is a powerful and dangerous monster which can roll roughshod over the Rights of the States and of the people and there is no reason to think it won't flatten out all opposition to Federal dictatorship, by officials of the Sovereign State of Louisiana.

Perhaps one of the by-products of this tyrannical exhibition of swollen Federal power will be to lessen the apprehension of the people about what may happen to them after January 20th since this is occurring under the present, and not the incoming, administration and represents "Modern Republicanism" in action.

Kennedy would have to go some to equal this exhibition of brute force exerted against American citizens by a power-mad and despotic Federal State.

### Late Senator Gives Timely Warning To His Colleagues

We wish we were able to buy one hundred plaques with this statement from the late Senator Joseph R. McCarthy of Wisconsin printed in gold thereon so we could give one to each member of the United States Senate:

"A Senator who is aware of treason but who refuses to expose the dangerous unpleasant facts for fear that he will be politically scarred and bloodied if he does, is actually guiltier of a greater treason than the traitors themselves. Every Senator has the duty to use the means provided by the Constitution to protect the people who have entrusted him with the task of manning the watch-towers of this nation."

It was in fearlessly exposing these "dangerous unpleasant facts" that Senator McCarthy forfeited his own life, and for his great courage is surely entitled to deliver this warning to those of his former colleagues who have shown no such conception of their responsibility to the people who elected them.

The Presidential election is over and the American people have had it. With two evils to choose from, a confused and slap-happy electorate has picked the worst. While the Republican platform was a notch above that of the Democrats — in that it at least gave token recognition to a few established American principles — there are many who feel it is just as well that the worst has happened and that we have the show-down now. They reason that we now know beyond doubt where we stand and that from now on there is nowhere to go but up. We know that we have reached the bottom rung of the ladder by our action in deliberately voting in the interest of a total Welfare State with which we have been flirting for the past twenty-five years. During the days of the New Deal, this nation was saved from complete dissolution and emergence into the orbit of World Socialist States through the steady influence and political action of a Coalition of Southern Democrats and Conservative Republicans in the United States Senate. While the Southern half of this Coalition is now in disrepute for having helped to bring about the present debacle, it is possible that they may want to make atonement to the American people. In that event, if the Coalition can again unite its forces and function to prevent utter collapse of the national economy and if, in the meantime, Conservative voters will organize under strong and determined leadership, there is some hope that, four years hence, the American governing system may be wrested from its custodians who are committed to pervert and destroy it.

Millions of thoughtful Americans are understandably frightened out of their wits over the outcome of the November election and the terrifying implications which it portends.

But the Invisible Rulers or World Planners, under our current one-party-two-name system, largely direct the selection of both candidates for President of the United States and they couldn't care less which one was elected.

In either event, it was a case of heads they win and tails we lose.

The Invisible Rulers or World Planners have but one ultimate and determined objective for the United States and that is to project us into One-World Government through the medium of the United Nations. It matters little to them which unit of our one-party-two-name system is employed to undermine our Republic and construct a Global Slave State on its ruins. That was up to the electorate.

The prerequisite to this impending plunge into One-World Government is that the American people be stripped of their freedom through Socialistic legislative enactments and robbed of their substance through extortionate and outrageous tax levies and we can be dead sure that a bang-up job would have been done in this regard no matter which candidate had won the election.

Neither candidate faced up to this threat to our national existence, or even admitted that there was such a threat. Neither gave any warning of danger on this score nor promised any help in preserving the Republic as "one nation, indivisible, under God" against eventual inclusion into the Godless cabal of a One-World State.

The coldblooded truth is that we are merely paying the price in this election year of 1960 for a quarter century's collective folly on the part of the leaders and the people of the United States, both of whom are equally guilty.

For twenty-five years an overwhelming majority of the American people have calmly stood by and looked on with smug complacency as the White House, the Supreme Court and the Congress have slowly but relentlessly whittled down the inherent freedoms of the citizen, hacked away at the Constitutional rights of the States and slashed property rights, one by one, with the result that we have finally been paid off in the accepted political coin of the realm.

So, if we have a red-hot disciple of Marx, Lenin and Laski as the Executive head of the nation for the next four years, this can only be credited to the eternal verity of the ages which firmly decrees that when erring humanity sows the wind, it must inevitably reap the whirlwind.

At any rate, we find ourselves saddled with a bold and unabashed champion of the total Welfare State who will act as President of our once free Republic and who, from his own statements, plans during his administration to convert the Federal government into a vast philanthropic and charitable agency and to transform the national Treasury into a glorified Community Chest.

Not that great strides have not already been made in this direction for, in all honesty, they have, but the frequent violent assaults heretofore aimed at the American governing system may be expected, under a full-fledged Collectivist administration, to burgeon into an incessant bombardment which could level our State and National institutions to the ground and shatter every concept of limited government which the founding fathers so faithfully fashioned.

Unless restrained by the powerful force of the United States Senate which, after all, is our legislative Court of Last Resort, the economic policies of the next administration will be laid down by dangerous and fanatical economists from Red-tinged universities and by Moscow-trained leaders from the field of Union Labor.

Every crack-brained theory ever dreamed up by wild-eyed revolutionaries will be hauled out and offered as the basis for legislative action and the Marxist platform adopted at Los Angeles will serve as the blueprint for administration leaders who will see even in the close election returns a mandate for severing the last remaining ties with Constitutional Government and for officially proclaiming National Socialism as our accepted form of government and way of life.

There's a lot of weeping and wailing over the fact that the "worst" of two evils was elected instead of the "least" but their lamentations will be silenced and their tears will soon dry if they will only think back and remember that the American people tried that in 1952 and again in 1956 and it didn't work.

For, let them not forget that there is little in the way of lost freedom that the American citizen didn't suffer at the hands of "Modern Republicanism" through increased spending and giving away of their money to foreign countries, seeing their beloved Republic shoved closer and closer to the horrible abyss of One-World Government; watching the inherent Rights of the States taken away and having bayonets rammed in their backs by Federal tyrants when they sought to exercise their Constitutional authority to run their own affairs.

There is a prevalent and widely held belief, in fact — whose soundness we are not prepared to challenge — that this nation had to hit the bottom before it could bounce back up. Very few responsible Americans will deny that with the adoption of a Welfare State in prospect, we've just about hit bottom.

There are even those who feel that if we had elected Stevenson in 1952, the American people would have been shocked into such revulsion that we would now be far back on the way to a return of Constitutional Government.

Surely in the dark hours which loom ahead the American people will take careful stock of their splendid heritage of freedom and of their God-given right to shape their own destiny rather than trusting this sacred responsibility to Washington bureaucrats.

Surely there are no honorable means under God's great canopy that they wouldn't employ to protect and preserve these rights.

If that is true, their first job is to get to work on their two United States senators and warn them that they must live up to their oath of office and stop dead in its tracks any Socialistic proposal by soft-headed intellectuals and starry-eyed dreamers who will blossom out like wild buttercups all over Washington in the years immediately ahead.

Don't write them just once and then go back to sleep. Keep in constant touch with them through letters, telegrams or even telephone conversations when the occasion justifies.

After all, no person in his right mind would hire domestic servants and turn the house and the kitchen over to them with no direction or supervision whatever. Why should they trust a public servant whom they have employed to protect their freedom to do the job with no instruction or advice on their part when the issues involved in the latter position may mean the difference between the survival of the Republic or its total collapse?

The men who wrote the Constitution of the United States not only went back to the beginning of history in their search for a pattern of government on which to construct a model for our own, but they also looked ahead and anticipated the danger from power-mad politicians who would seek to amend, undermine and subvert the instrument which they had wrought. Because of this they tried to form a government which, through proper balances and limitations, would provide a structure which would endure long after others had toppled throughout the world, and to do this they made freedom of the citizen their first consideration and held government power to the minimum.

Their apprehensions will come nearer to fulfillment in the days to come than at any other time in history and the governing system which they left us will be subjected to constant and deadly attack by undesirable elements of our society who value human freedom lightly and who are without respect or regard for our limited Constitutional system.

In our humble opinion the challenge must be met first by a unified demand that the United States Senate perform the function for which it exists and serve as a checkrein on the unwise, unsound and destructive legislative proposals and, second, that Conservative Americans begin now to search out a national leader whose stature as a statesman is unquestioned and unite behind him in an all-out fight to restore their inalienable rights and freedoms to the people of the American Republic.

## Only Congress Can Halt Teaching Of Communism In American Schools

### A New Intimidating Device Is 'Government By Threat'

Traditionally the United States is a free Republic governed by the Constitution and the laws passed thereunder by the American Congress.

"Government by Threat" is a new conception and one of the many sinister devices which have sprung up in recent years to supplant the orderly governing processes as originally set up by the nation's founders.

Before and during the National Democratic Convention at Los Angeles in July, Senate Majority Leader Lyndon B. Johnson and Speaker of the House of Representatives Sam Rayburn were prolific in their innuendoes and even direct warnings that, regardless of whom the delegates selected as the nominee for President, these two would still control the Senate and the House of the American Congress.

The inference was plain that if Johnson failed to get the nomination on the ticket as a candidate for President, the wrath of these two leaders would be visited on those States whose delegates were responsible for his defeat, through the manipulation of legislation in the two Houses of Congress.

Now, the jobs of Minority Leader of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives are strictly party designations conferred on the holders of these titles by the political party temporarily in control of Congress.

It was never intended that the holders of these two offices were to be vested with the authority to use the lawmaking body of the United States as a weapon to punish their personal or political enemies or to clobber their opponents over the head for political action which they disapproved and yet that is exactly what the Senate Majority Leader and the Speaker of the House of Representatives tacitly threatened by their public utterances last July.

"Government by Threat" was also apparently resorted to by Attorney General of the United States, William P. Rogers, in dealing with the sitdown strikes by Negroes demanding service at White lunch counters in department stores in the south.

Repeatedly the heads of the companies operating these department stores asserted their rights as private property owners to serve whom they pleased and to refuse service at their own discretion.

Then the owners or their representatives were summoned to the office of the Attorney General of the United States in Washington for a "conference" and while the proceedings at that "conference" have remained top-secret, following it many of the owners suddenly changed their minds and their lunch counters in the South integrated, even though such stores are reported as suffering financially as a result of the loss of White patronage.

The only way, in our opinion, that the teaching of Communism in the educational institutions of this country can be stopped is for the Congress, in the interest of our national security, to pass a law prohibiting the teaching of any doctrine or ideology in the schools, colleges and universities of the United States which is contrary or in opposition to the American Free Enterprise System and attaching thereto a heavy penalty in the form of a fine and penitentiary sentence.

Efforts of groups and individuals to halt this subversive practice are not sufficient to accomplish the results desired. After many attempts along this line there are today so many Communist slanted text books in the various institutions of learning that if they were suddenly withdrawn there would not be enough left to conduct classes.

Also State laws along this line would not be effective under the present Federal set-up. While the desirable method of handling all educational matters is by the individual States, no State law is any longer held Constitutional by the Supreme Court which bears on education or the conduct of schools and any such State legislation would no doubt be thrown out by that legal body.

Therefore, national legislation on the subject would seem to be the only effective way to check the infiltration of our schools by Soviet propaganda which is causing hundreds of thousands of young Communist sympathizers to be turned out each year.

Any American who does not believe that this is true is invited to have a heart-to-heart talk with college-age members of his family and find out for himself what these young people's views are on our magnificent system of Constitutional Government as opposed to a Socialist Welfare State such as that which prevails in Russia.

If you live in a city of a hundred thousand population or over, you should visit your library some day and learn what type of books are in the majority there. If you are familiar with subversive writers, you will probably find enough of this type of books to infiltrate the whole city. The works of very few patriotic Americans are on library shelves as a rule.

The duties of the Attorney General are clearly defined by statute and limited to his responsibility as prosecutor or defender in law suits involving the Federal government. Certainly he is nowhere authorized to intimidate sovereign citizens into indulging in social practices personally repulsive to them or to the area of the Republic in which they reside or operate.

We submit that the employment of high office in any agency of the government as a means of punishment of political enemies or coercion in reversing social customs is a vicious perversion of the intents of the American governing process and a practice which can only result in eventual anarchy, chaos and disorder.

## As Gertrude Stein Would Say 'A Law Is A Law Is A Law'

The Attorney General of Texas, Mr. Will Wilson, recently handed down a ruling which has caused some raised eyebrows along with amused smiles throughout the State.

Texas has a law which prevents the payment of State funds to school districts which integrate without approval of the people. So far as we can learn, there is nothing in the law about "voluntary integration" or "enforced integration." It merely provides that in case of integration not authorized by a vote of the people, State funds will be withheld from such district.

The people of Houston voted almost four to one sometime ago against integration of the schools but in spite of this a Federal judge with typical disregard for anything except the wishes of the NAACP, ruled that Houston schools must integrate anyway.

Caught between the Federal ruling and a State law, the Houston school board appealed to the Attorney General for a decision on the legality of the State law.

The request came at an embarrassing time for the Attorney General since he was busy campaigning for the national Democratic ticket which demands total and complete integration of Negroes and Whites at all levels.

What to do?

Instead of making the obvious legal ruling that the law stated that any school which integrated without first being approved in an election called for the purpose would be denied State funds and since Houston citizens had repudiated integration by a large majority, State funds would be denied to the Houston school board, Mr.

Wilson made a novel interpretation of the law.

Since the Houston schools were not "voluntarily" integrating but were being "forced" to do so by Federal authorities, the Attorney General held, the law did not apply to them and they were entitled to the same State aid under integration they had been receiving as segregated schools.

What Mr. Wilson apparently forgot or conveniently overlooked is that when any school is integrated in Texas or the South, for that matter, it is "forced integration" by the Federal government. There is no such thing as "voluntary integration" in any Southern State.

The lawmakers who passed the bill knew this and they apparently provided that State school funds would be withheld in order to spur Texas officials to fight all the harder against dictatorship from Washington in matters which are purely local. There is no doubt that money talks and if a few large school districts in the State were deprived of millions of dollars in State funds, the people would be inspired to organized resistance against Federal tyranny which might eventually result in a reversal of Washington domination over the States and a return to Constitutional government.

At any rate the Attorney General took himself off the hot seat and was enabled to return to the serious business of campaigning for Kennedy and Johnson.

But after all, the law is being juggled around to mean anything social-minded judges want it to mean, so why shouldn't the highest legal authority of a Sovereign State do a little juggling himself?

## Dead Men Again Prove Handy In Campaign Involving Johnson

One of the most explosive incidents in connection with the Presidential campaign in Texas was the publishing of a list of approximately 3500 in a Dallas newspaper purporting to be friends and supporters of the Johnson-Kennedy ticket just a few days before election.

The paper had no sooner than hit the streets until denials started popping like firecrackers. The protests were from citizens who said they not only had not authorized their names to be put on the list but that they were supporting the opposition. Reports variously estimated the number of those on the list without authority as from 800 to 2000.

One Dallas citizen filed suit for a half million dollars damage according to the press and others were expected to follow suit.

It seems that the enthusiastic Kennedy-Johnson partisans who compiled the list employed the joint campaign tactics of Kansas City's Pendergast and those of Boss Parr of Texas' notorious Jim Wells County, both of whom found dead men of great value in a hot political contest.

More than forty of the names on the list are reported to have belonged to those who departed this life as far back as three or four years ago thus neutralizing somewhat their opportunity for active participation in the Kennedy-Johnson campaign.

Public pleas to Johnson to express regret for the affair met with silence on his part. After all, what could he say in the face of the Box 13 incident in 1948 when the ballots of 87 dead Mexicans had to be requisitioned to save his skin in the Senate race.

The close victory of the Kennedy-Johnson ticket in Texas is regarded as indication that the day of the two-party system in the Lone Star State may not be too far away. But first there will actually have to be two parties in the nation and not just one party with two divisions, before a two-party system can prevail in any State. As it is now, the American electorate must vote according to party labels without regard to what is in the can.

At their recent meeting they passed a resolution which called for the reversal of this country's destructive trade policies which have been in effect for 25 years or since the United States, under Roosevelt, first embraced Socialism. The Southern chief executives at long last realized that foreign-made goods are destroying the American market.

## Luckily The Supreme Court Can't Change Human Nature

While the Supreme Court of the United States has in many instances been able to use the machinery of government in forcing its vile social theories on helpless people of the South, there is no power on earth which can compel self-respecting white people to accept its dictation to mix with those who are obnoxious.

The following letter which recently appeared in the Charleston, South Carolina, News and Courier, written by O. M. Hays of Baltimore, Maryland, makes this point:

En route to New York on one of the Pennsylvania's swank trains, there was an episode that seems to clearly point up what the integrationists are up against in their effort to "mix the races."

The smoking lounge was fairly well filled with white passengers, men and women, whose dress and manners spoke of "better class" status. There was a general air of contentment, of calm ease, in the lounge.

Presently a Negro man entered and took one of the seats. He was unobtrusive in his movements. He did nothing more than take a chair, light a cigar and seek enjoyment in it.

But the atmosphere of the lounge changed, not abruptly, but by a gradual feeling that those who had been so contented, so satisfied, with a pleasant journey were becoming restless.

Presently, one by one, the passengers drifted out, until only the Negro was left in the lounge. For the next half hour he had the lounge almost to himself. Only a few men entered it, and each in turn hastily lighted a cigarette, puffed it briefly and returned to his seat in the coach.

The Supreme Court has said the Negro has a right to be in the lounge, to be in the same coach as the white passengers. But so long as men and women, whether on trains or in residential neighborhoods, or other places of contact, quietly remove themselves when the Negro moves in, integration will never become a fact.

The above incident occurred between Philadelphia and New York, and it is a safe bet that I was the only Southerner in the lounge at the time.

## A Type Of 'Sharing' The Do-Gooders Hadn't Planned

A report by the director of Houston's Social Hygiene Center, Dr. E. M. Vanderstoep, just issued, reveals that there is an increase of 1000 per cent in that city's venereal cases over those of 1955 and that 90 per cent of such cases are Negroes.

Coming as it did on the heels of the forced integration of two schools in Houston as a result of the ruling of a Federal judge, the report was said to have caused apprehension on the part of white parents in that city since it is known that such diseases are largely prevalent among colored children as well as adults, in the South.

The do-gooders and Reds who started the agitation for racial mixing in the schools probably forgot or overlooked this vital fact when they instituted their propaganda campaign for forced integration.

Now, in addition to their Socialistic program which advocates "sharing the wealth" it looks like we are now faced with a situation in which the children of the South will be forced to "share the venereal diseases" of a race which, unfortunately, looks on such afflictions as no more of a calamity than being visited by a common cold.

## So They Think They Are 'Soaking The Rich'?

If the Marxists who frame our tax laws in Washington think they are "soaking the rich" with their Socialistic legislation, they have another thought coming.

There are 43,697,608 taxpayers under the \$20,000 income bracket who pay 80 per cent of all income taxes collected, or a total of \$22,889,000,000.00.

There are only 490,774 taxpayers in the income bracket above \$20,000 who pay a total tax of \$6,374,000,000.00 or 20 per cent of all income taxes collected.

These figures were recently made public by Congressman Noah Mason of Illinois, sponsor of the 23rd amendment before Congress for repeal of the Sixteenth Amendment which provides for the levying of an income tax, and were published by Human Events.

When this income tax amendment was adopted in 1913, it was claimed by its Marxist sponsors that rich people would pay the greatest proportion of the tax but it has turned out just the opposite. And the smaller taxpayers are "soaked" more heavily than those in the higher bracket.

The Sixteenth amendment is perhaps the greatest incentive to governmental corruption in the history of civilization and is responsible for most of the economic, financial and social ills from which the nation is now suffering.

Congressman H. R. Gross of Iowa has caused a lot of people to do a double-take. He has called attention to an item in the foreign aid program which provides \$100,000 to the government of Israel for the purpose of teaching the people of that country to operate banks and loan companies.

## Repeal Of Connaly Amendment Now Poses Direct Threat To Our Internal Security

The well-founded reasons why the Connaly Amendment to our acceptance of the jurisdiction of the World Court should not be repealed have been multiplied a thousand times by a recent event.

Dr. Philip C. Jessup, notorious liberal who leans so far to the left he has to walk in a circle to get where he's going, has been nominated as the United States member of that Court.

Dr. Jessup was one of those who huddled with Alger Hiss, Harry Dexter White and others of their ilk at San Francisco in the Spring of 1945 when the tragic formation of the United Nations was under way.

Efforts were made to get this former Columbia law professor named as a delegate to the 1951 session of the United Nations but the late Senator Joseph R. McCarthy of Wisconsin bitterly opposed this appointment and the Senate refused to confirm him. In spite of that Truman gave him an interim appointment after Congress had adjourned.

Jessup also testified at both trials of Alger Hiss and each time spoke in behalf of Hiss, and later declared he saw no reason to change his testimony.

Jessup was Chairman of the Pacific and American Councils of the Institute of Pacific Relations, an organization charged by Senator McCarthy as "accepting Communist money to support its projects and also employing Communist writers and research workers." The Wisconsin senator charged that there were 60 officials and writers of the Institute of Pacific Relations at the time Jessup was connected with it "who have been named as Communists or espionage agents in sworn testimony before various Congressional committees."

Since the United States Senate does not have to confirm the appointment and the matter rests with the United Nations entirely, Jessup's selection as the representative of the United States on the World Court is a foregone conclusion and may have been announced by the time this appears in print.

Patriotic Americans will need to renew their fight against repeal of the Connaly Amendment immediately following the reconvening of the next session of Congress on January 3rd. The forces backing Jessup will move Heaven and earth to bring about this repeal and good Americans must be on guard.

So far as we know there has been no organized protest against the selection of Jessup to the American delegation in the United Nations who will have to vote on the matter, but that probably would do no good anyway as they will no doubt be strongly in favor of a person with his record for the job.

## Constitution Specifically Limits The Duties Of The Vice President

The left-wing columnist, Mr. Roscoe Drummond, suggests that Mr. Kennedy will need the "powerful and indispensable" figure of Mr. Lyndon Johnson as a legislative leader if he is to "avoid a recalcitrant and balky Congress" in getting his program through.

Perhaps Mr. Drummond will tell his readers how the newly elected vice president is going to perform as a "powerful and indispensable" figure in the Senate and, at the same time, function as vice president in view of the fact that the Constitution of the United States in Article one, section three, strictly limits him to the following activities during his term of office:

"The Vice President of the United States shall be President of the Senate, but shall have no vote, unless they be equally divided."

That is what the Constitution says the Vice President shall do and that's all it says he shall do. If it had been intended that a "powerful and indispensable" Vice President should go around mixing with the members of that body, advising them how to vote; buttonholing them in cloak rooms in favor of this measure or that or lobbying for a pet bill of the President it would have so stated in the Constitution.

As it is, his sole duty is to preside over the Senate and vote only in the case of a tie.

Of course we realize that the Constitution is no longer regarded as having much weight with the liberals and left-wingers who are in the majority in Washington but, even so, if they are going to delegate new and powerful authority to the Vice President, they should submit an amendment to the Constitution outlining these new responsibilities and prerogatives; thereby at least going through the motions of following Constitutional procedure.

## No Picketing Allowed If The Victim Is A Negro

In Los Angeles recently, according to press reports, a group of boys who were picketing the show of the Negro entertainer, Sammy Davis, were hastily dispersed by the police who threatened to send them to jail. They were picketing the place because of the Negro's impending marriage to a White female from Sweden, indicating that there are still some elements of decency in the nation's movie capital.

If these boys had been labor union goons picketing a business concern, or if they had been young Negro thugs picketing a white lunch-counter, the police would have looked the other way and would have done nothing.

In this case, they were picketing a Negro in protest against the basest act of degeneracy in which human beings can engage — miscegenation — but the heavy hand of the law clamped down on them in nothing flat.

According to a press dispatch from Paris, Pavel I. Erchov, former Communist Ambassador to Israel and Switzerland, has been named deputy director-general of UNESCO which should occasion no surprise for the pro-Communist leaning of this U. N. "cultural" organization has long been obvious from its actions.

Senator Barry Goldwater of Arizona attributes the loss of the election to Mr. Kennedy to the fact that the Republican candidate conducted a "me too" campaign. This is perhaps true and the sad part of it is that as long as that party continues to run a part-Conservative and part-Liberal candidate for the office of President, their campaigns will be on a "me too" basis. ## Senate Committee Charges Communist Party Member Organized Nuclear Group Meeting

Hundreds of similar cases could be cited but the following is a good illustration of the manner in which groups of prominent American citizens work diligently in promoting the Communist cause in this country.

On May 19, 1960, the Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy held a rally at Madison Square Garden in New York City. Among the speakers at the rally, according to the press, were Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, Mr. Walter Reuther, Governor G. Mennen Williams of Michigan, Dr. Harold Taylor, former president of Sarah Lawrence College and others. Mr. Norman Cousins is Chairman of the Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy.

Arrangements for the meeting were made by Henry H. Abrams according to a report of the Subcommittee to Investigate Internal Security, Committee of the Judiciary, United States Senate.

On May 13, 1960, Mr. Abrams was called before the above Committee regarding his alleged Communist affiliations, after Mr. J. G. Sourwine, chief counsel of the Committee had explained: "The Committee has received information that an important member of the Communist Party has been active in making arrangements for a mass meeting to be held at Madison Square Garden in New York City on Thursday, May 19."

For several hours the Committee questioned Mr. Abrams but practically the only questions he answered were those concerning his name and address. Answers to all others were refused on the grounds of the first and fifth amendments to the Constitution.

Here are samples of the questions propounded to Mr. Abrams for hours and hours together with his answer:

Mr. Sourwine: Are you now or have you ever been a member of the Upper West Side Section of the Communist Party of New York City?

Mr. Abrams: I must decline to answer that question on the grounds already given (Fifth Amendment).

Mr. Sourwine: Have you ever been a member of the Young Communist League?

Mr. Abrams: I must decline to answer that question on the grounds already given.

Mr. Sourwine: Have you ever contributed financially to the Communist Party, U.S.A.?

Mr. Abrams: I must decline to answer that question for the grounds already given.

After a hearing which consumed 27 pages of questions which he re-

fused to answer, the subcommittee informed officials of the Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy of the affiliations of Abrams whom they described as a "veteran member of the Communist Party." Accordingly, Abrams was fired by the Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy only a few days before the Madison Square Garden meeting.

In a speech concerning the affair delivered on the floor of the Senate, United States Senator Thomas J. Dodd of Connecticut and vice chairman of the Committee which investigated Abrams said that it was his "unpleasant duty to have to notify them (Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy) that the unpublicized chief organizer of the Madison Square Garden rally was a veteran member of the Communist Party; that there was also evidence of serious Communist infiltration at chapter level through the Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy; that the Communist Party and its front organizations had done their utmost to promote the meeting; that the Communists provided much of the organizing machinery for the meeting because they planned to use it as a pressure instrument in support of Soviet nuclear diplomacy."

The senator added that the "Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy is headed by a group of nationally prominent citizens about whose integrity and good faith there is no question."

If he intended to convey by this that those connected with the Committee for a Sane Nuclear Policy were unaware of the Communist infiltration, we very definitely disagree with him.

It is laughable, for instance, to assume that Eleanor Roosevelt, one of its chief ramrods, would object to Communists taking part in the movement. Her record is all to the contrary. She has been cited as belonging to so many Communist fronts that she probably has lost count of them herself. If she has ever denied such affiliation or expressed any public regret for her pro-Communist activity, we are unaware of it.

At any rate, this is just one instance of how so-called responsible organizations and movements are directed by Soviet forces and this could be multiplied by hundreds of similar cases. In fact, there are very few liberal groups in this country where Communist influence is not the dominating factor and until we clean out subversion in our own ranks, we fail to see where we are going to make a dent in Communism throughout the world.

### African Witches' Brew Concocted in Moscow

The following by Major George R. Jordan appeared in the Los Angeles Times sometime ago. Major Jordan of the United States Air Force, retired, was U.S. Lend-Lease expediter during World War II and was also U.N. Representative to the U.S.S.R.:

Much of the turmoil in today's Africa can be traced to the violent Red seasoning in a witches' brew concocted at Moscow, blended in Ethiopia and poured into a river of hate flooding the Dark Continent.

The Soviet Union has established a huge Communist staff at Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, where their facilities include a combination hospital-university. There, Russian-speaking nurses and witch doctors are trained before infiltrating every corner of Africa.

Long before the Kremlin succeeded in setting up this secret satellite in the Abyssinian jungle, Moscow was operating a witch doctors' school in which Black Magic and Red Doctrine were expertly mixed for the trainees.

The Communist-schooled witch doctors are now fanning out into every valley, and village, carrying the Kremlin's orders to the firesides of all the tribes.

"Rise up against the white oppressors!", the witch doctors shriek. "Recover the gold, copper, uranium, cobalt and diamonds needed for national development!"

Despite all the talk about an "enlightened" Africa striving for self-government, the savagery of ancient tribal customs lingers close to the surface in many areas of the vast continent.

A few months ago, Ghana's English-educated representative to the United Nations was called home for a celebration to be attended by tribal chiefs. There is evidence he was put into a "stew pot" so his wisdom could be divided among the chiefs.

Whatever the case, he has disappeared, and his disappearance is being ignored by the U.N. and by Ghana.

It seems unlikely that either Central or East Africa will really be ready for self-government for at least 50 years. If political power is turned over soon to the Soviet-trained and Mau Mau-dominated stooges now trying to grab control, the results may be even worse than those in the Congo.

The Congo army riots, with rape rampant, should teach the free world the danger of hothousing the kind of African "nationalism" now raising such a clamor. That kind of strident nationalism is actually confined to a small minority inspired and financed by Soviet agents.

Daniel Semonovich Solod, 56, who has a long and interesting record as Soviet ambassador to Syria and Lebanon, and as the man who convinced Nasser he should buy Czechoslovakian armament, is the

The latest weapon of the Communists for overthrowing governments throughout the world are students in universities and they are being used extensively for this purpose.

Irresponsible and emotional, they are easily influenced to engage in acts of violence against constituted authority in whatever country they reside without having the faintest idea of the cause in which their help is being utilized.

## One Of First Acts Of Communists Is To Destroy Independence Of Bench And Bar

On request of the Public Relations Department of the American Bar Association with headquarters in Chicago, we are glad to publish the following press release from that organization concerning an address by the new president, Mr. Whitney North Seymour made in Omaha recently:

Whitney North Seymour of New York, making his first address before a state bar organization as President of the American Bar Association, told the Nebraska State Bar Association that members of the legal profession have a great opportunity now to expose Communist duplicity. He called also for affirmative leadership by the nation's bar associations to improve international relations through the rule of law.

Pointing to the appearances of Soviet Premier Khrushchev and Cuba's Prime Minister Fidel Castro before the United Nations, Mr. Seymour said: "The recent blasts of Khrushchev and Castro in the U.N. about colonialism would be laughable if they did not show such contempt for the intelligence of their listeners. While England, France and other so-called colonial powers have been granting freedom to over 500 million people, many of whose countries now or soon will be new members of the U.N., the Communists have freed not one person. Freedom from Communist rule has only been achieved by escape or death."

One of the first things the Communists do in any country where they gain dominance is to destroy the independence of the bench and bar, President Seymour warned. He called for strong support of the bar for the United Nations, for the World Court and "every other institution which can aid in the peaceful settlements of disputes" and extend the rule of law in the world.

He also called attention to plans of the American Bar Association's Special Committee on World Peace Through Law to hold a series of international regional conferences of lawyers to consider means of strengthening international legal processes. Tentative plans are to hold such conferences starting in 1961 in Latin America, Asia, Africa and Europe.

President Seymour took office Sept. 2 as the American Bar Association's 84th president. His Omaha appearance, before a banquet meeting of the Nebraska State Bar Association was his first official speaking engagement before a state bar group.

Following are excerpts from Mr. Seymour's address:

"The present time affords a great opportunity for the bar to help provide needed leadership where it has special competence. As the Communists seek to impose their form of dictatorship on other countries,

under the guise of friendly cooperation, the lawyers should join in sounding a warning, and in advancing the banner of a great alternative. We should accentuate the positive and not the negative.

"The warning is to remind everyone of what the Communists have done wherever their bear hug has been applied. Hungary and Tibet are the most recent examples: the countries of Eastern Europe are earlier ones. Here the Rule of Law has been flouted, peoples have been enslaved, dissenters have been executed, sometimes with the aid of controlled courts and always without the protection of independent counsel. Indeed one of the first things the Communists do is to destroy the independence of the bench and bar. Through the International Commission of Jurists, the world has been informed about many of these outrages. Its reports on Hungary and Tibet are classic statements of what the Communists do to freedom. The American Bar Association has actively supported the work of the Commission since it was established.

"Against such a background, the recent blasts of Khrushchev and Castro in the U. N. about colonialism would be laughable if they did not show such contempt for the intelligence of their listeners. While England, France and other so-called colonial powers have been granting freedom to over 500,000,000 people, many of whose countries are now or soon will be new members of the U.N., the Communists have freed not one person. Freedom from Communist rule has only been achieved by escape or death. Instead of granting freedom from colonialism, they have reached far more and more people to subject to their special brand.

"But refutation and exposure is not enough; the bar can do much more. It is evident that strong support for the U. N. and its independent role is called for from all who believe in the rule of law. Furthermore, support for the World Court and every other institution which can aid in the peaceful settlements of disputes is in order. Thus, the Permanent Court of Arbitration, now a distinguished but pale shadow of its possibilities, should be reactivated. The program of international conferences of lawyers of our outstanding Committee on World Peace Through Law deserves wide support. And the modest but important programs which bring our lawyers and judges into intimate contact with those of other countries are of great importance. The visits of more than 1000 British and Commonwealth lawyers and judges and their families to the American Bar Association meeting in Washington in August and their subsequent official entertainment in ten other American cities were steps in the right direction.

"Chief Justice Simmons has, with the aid of others, made a notable contribution in the same direction by collecting American law books and sending them to many judges and lawyers abroad. Thus, our concept of the Rule of Law has been made available through imag-

inative private channels. More of this sort of thing should be encouraged.

"There is also room for a great expansion of the program for showing judges and lawyers of other countries our legal system at work. At the present time, they come over under the auspices of one of our great universities, as guests of our government or as individual visitors. Their visits around the country are generally not coordinated or geared to any particular program. An American Bar Association Committee, of which Judge Stephen S. Chandler, Chief Judge of the Western District of Oklahoma is Chairman, has that whole matter in charge. We hope that there will be a great expansion in the Committee's work. Visits to bar associations and courts in various parts of our country should be a regular part of the program.

"Among other things, it would be most desirable if lawyers among the delegates from new nations to the U. N. could participate in such visits. Of course, some of them may be critical of some things they see but they could be reminded that American visitors to their countries might engage in friendly criticism. We do not need to be self-righteous to establish that we are constantly striving to make our system conform to our ideals. The great thing is not to achieve a synthetic absence of criticism, but to have a common purpose to respect the dignity of man, to strive constantly to maintain liberty and to make sure that courts do justice with complete independence and integrity. It is that common denominator among the lawyers of the world which we ought to encourage and maintain. Those who believe in such things, whatever their background, are bound to oppose tyranny in whatever form it appears, whether in Communism or some home-grown variety."

Thereupon a whole session of the convention was reserved for a discussion of these "embarrassing incidents" and an apology was made "to all our Negro brethren for these incidents."

Furthermore, the gathering decided to make a list of the establishments which had refused service to the black delegates and widely publicize them for the purpose of discouraging patronage of these establishments by those attending the convention and by like-minded Louisville Disciples of Christ. The implication was that these local decent owners of hotels, restaurants and rooming houses who do not open their doors to Negroes should be boycotted.

Of course all this was done in the name of "Christian charity, racial tolerance and human brotherhood" but it was no such thing and in pretending that it was, the Disciples of Christ were adding hypocrisy to their other sins.

Their action in trying to effect a boycott against self-respecting, free Americans was nothing short of ecclesiastical blackmail and an attempt to use the power of the church in promoting Soviet ideology in the United States.

"Time plays tricks on old memories," said the Wall Street Journal on election day, November 8 "but in at least one respect it seems to us that this has been the poorest political campaign of many years. Rarely have two candidates talked so much and said so little . . ." There was much more to the editorial but in these few words, the Journal put its finger on the weakness of the campaign. Neither candidate said anything. Perhaps the day will come (we hope) when at least one of the candidates will be a statesman, will discuss fundamental issues and give the American voters something to hope for.

The man who kindles the fire on the hearthstone of an honest and righteous home, burns the best incense to liberty. He does not love mankind less who loves his neighbor most. Exalt the citizen. As the state is the unit of government, he is the unit of the state. Teach him that his home is his castle, and his sovereignty rests beneath his hat. Make him self-respecting, self-reliant and responsible. Let him lean on the state for nothing that his own arm can do, and on the government for nothing that his state can do. Let him cultivate independence to the point of sacrifice, and learn that humble things with unbartered liberty are better than splendors bought with its price.—Henry W. Grady

In 1902 Lenin made this pronouncement: "We must go among all classes of the people as theoreticians, as propagandists, as agitators, and as organizers . . . The principal thing of course is propaganda and agitation among all strata of the people . . ." Look around you and ask yourself, as an American, whether or not these injunctions have been faithfully carried out so far as the United States is concerned.

## Did We Call This Shot On The Soviets Or Did We?

It does not require a touch of genius for an American to anticipate what the Soviets will do because they operate under a carefully planned program which to an informed person is easily predictable.

But we must refer to the fact that we called the shot on their action in regard to the payment of the expense of the United Nations meddling in the Congo.

Our October edition was off the press and in the mails on Tuesday, October 18th and on page 3 of that edition under the heading of the editorial "Savages From The Jungle Gradually Gaining Power in the United Nations" we said in part: " . . . It has been noted in the press that Khrushchev has refused to pay Russia's part of the money for the expense of sending troops into the Suez situation some years ago and it is logical to suppose that he will do likewise in the case of the terrific expense involved in sending troops into the Congo."

Three days later, October 21, an Associated Press article with a United Nations dateline said: "The Soviet Bloc countries served notice Friday they will refuse to pay for any part of what they called 'the dirty' U.N. operation in the Congo."

That fulfillment of our prediction came sooner than even we expected but at least we did not miss our guess.

We said further in our editorial in the paper released October 18 concerning the Soviets' probable refusal to pay the Congo expense: "This will shift a heavy financial burden on the shoulders of some respectable nation which does not repudiate its obligations and it requires no genius to figure out what nation that will be."

The Associated Press article with the United Nations dateline referred to above and which appeared three days after our prediction said on this subject: "It (the Soviet refusal) has implications for the United States which will ultimately pay for the major cost of the Congo operation, estimated to reach between \$150,000,000 and \$200,000,000 by the end of 1961."

We hit the bull's eye there, too.

There is only one silver lining to this dark cloud. The Associated Press article hinted that the United Nations is faced with "a long-threatened financial crisis" and indicated that "the total destruction of the United Nations" might be involved in this Soviet refusal to pay its part.

Both contingencies are encouraging — that the U. N. is running out of money and that it may be destroyed.

## Observations On The Recent Election Of A President

There has perhaps never been a Presidential campaign in this country before where practically no fundamental issues of government were discussed by either candidate and where only extraneous and vote-catching proposals and appeals to special groups and classes occupied almost the full time and attention of both nominees.

There were no clear-cut decisions for voters to make — no choice between a dedicated Conservative and an admitted Liberal. Both were committed to platforms stressing Marxist policies of government, in varying degrees, and it was largely a matter of method in execution rather than principle which was involved in either case.

There is little doubt that Mr. Nixon's capitulation to Nelson Rockefeller in regard to the Chicago platform, together with Mr. Lodge's crack about a Negro in the Cabinet, smothered any hope that the seven Southern States which went Republican in 1956 would land in Nixon's camp in 1960.

While both candidates had a heavy burden to carry in the matter of their running mates, Lodge was probably a greater handicap than Johnson since the latter's native State of Texas at least squeaked by for the Democratic ticket, while Lodge's pulling power in Massachusetts was practically non-existent.

There were many who saw a repetition of a Dewey-type campaign in the efforts of Richard Nixon to gain the White House. It is understood that he was urged to come out slugging by Conservative Republicans who wanted him to revert to the hard-hitting tactics which had won for him in other years. But he was touched by the blight of Modern Republicanism with which he had been associated for eight years and seemed to have lost the spirit to wage the kind of fight which once knocked his opponents out of the ring.

Undoubtedly there was enough religious prejudice in the South to have prevented a Kennedy victory in the majority of the Southern States but Protestant preachers overplayed their hand and a boomerang resulted. Catholics who would not have otherwise voted for Kennedy because of his left-wing views, laid aside all other considerations and flocked to his banner. This was especially true in the North and East where the Catholic faith is most predominant.

There is one lesson to be learned, if no other, from the results and that is that Mr. Kennedy now has assurance that he can insult the South with impunity and suffer little retaliation at the ballot box. He frankly implied before his nomination that he didn't need the support of the South and didn't particularly want it. His trips to that area during the campaign are believed to have been made largely to save face for his running mate and bolster the waning influence of the latter in Dixie.

Because of the brilliance, ability and resourcefulness of Mr. Robert Kennedy, most people figure that this young man will be the power behind the throne during the next administration and many see him as a crafty Rasputin at the Imperial Court of the New Frontier.

## The 'Great Debates' Missed Being Great By A Country Mile

We certainly hope that those chosen to make notes on human events for the benefit of posterity do not list the Nixon-Kennedy performance on television as "The Great Debates" for if they do it will be a direct perversion of the facts.

There was not only nothing "great" about the performances but they were not even "debates." They were merely glorified versions of the Meet the Press program.

In order to debate in the real meaning of the term, the two men would have had to possess divergent views on issues of government and to have defended them according to their earnest convictions.

As it was, they were merely two puppets dangling from the same Marxist string and both in thorough agreement that Socialism as a policy of government is preferable to the great Free Enterprise System on which the American Republic was founded.

The only disagreement between them was as to which was best qualified to give away the taxpayers' hard-earned money and to carry out the Welfare State program which each party platform set forth at their respective conventions.

How could any public discussion be termed "great" which hinged on such non-government subjects as civil rights, medical care for the aged, Federal aid to education, regulation of wages and related issues which have been thrust to the forefront to the exclusion of relevant problems by do-gooders and hairbrained reformers who provide the grist for the legislative mill under a Socialist government?
