HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

MINUTES

Nominations for Secretary were called. A motion was made by Bill Hensley to suspend the House Rules on the qualifications. A vote of members carried the motion. Nancy Coffman and Marilyn Holub were nominated and gave speeches of their qualifications. Marilyn Holub was elected.
