Dear Board Member:

At the special request of Mrs. John Davis, our Recording Secretary, I am hereby calling a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Texas Equal Suffrage Association, at Austin, on August 1, at the Driskill Hotel, at ten o'clock in the morning.

It is very unusual for us to try to have a board meeting in the summer, but a very unusual situation confronts us in the stand that Mrs. Davis has taken in vetoing certain accounts authorized by me as acting head of the organization, and I hope you will make an unusual effort to attend, as Mrs. Davis does not think the matter could or should be settled by correspondence. We will also, at this time, review and outline the plans for ratification of the Federal Amendment outlined by the National Association.
